Leading Off

The Fightin Phils continues a six-game series against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies, on Friday. It is the fourth of 18 matchups between the teams this season, and first of 12 in Reading. The Fightin Phils won the season-series over Hartford in 2023, going 14-10.

Putting the Fight in Fightins

The Fighin Phils earned their second-straight come-from-behind victory over the Yard Goats, with a 10-8 win on Thursday night. Carlos De La Cruz had two hits, and two home runs, Kendall Simmons had two hits, three runs, a double and home run in his first game back from the IL, and Ethan Wilson had three hits and his first RBI of the season. Reading put up six runs in the bottom of the 7th inning, which marked a season-high for runs and hits (6) in an inning. Reading; three home runs in the contest also matched a season best.

Rolling Again

After a very quiet start to the 2024 season, Carlos De La Cruz broke out in a big way the last two nights. After a double off the wall on Wednesday, he broke through with his first, and second, home runs of the season on Thursday night. Overall, De La Cruz had two runs scored and three driven in in the win. It marked the third multi-homer game of his career. It was also the first time a R-Phils hit a home run in back-to-back at-bats since Nick Ward did it on Aug. 10, 2023 at New Hampshire. Thursday night also marked the third instance this season where a Fightin Phil hit two home runs in a game.

Lee Sang Rolling

Marcus Lee Sang's recent hot-stretch continued with a hit and run scored on Thursday. Over his last 13 games, dating back to Apr. 23, Lee Sang is slashing .311/.367/.689, with a 1.056 OPS. Over that stretch, Lee Sang has three doubles, one triple and four home runs, with 10 RBI. The stretch has propelled Lee Sang to first on the team in home runs and second in RBI. He also is riding an 10-game on-base streak, his longest of the season. Lee Sang has also found much success in the bottom of the lineup. When batting ninth this year, Lee Sang is hitting .304. In all other spots of the lineup, he's hitting .183.

Welcome Back Kendall

Kendall Simmons made his return from the injured list in a big way on Thursday night. After being activated prior to the game, Simmons had two hits, three runs, a double, home run and two RBI. His two-run home run in the bottom of the fifth inning broke up a no-hitter from Hartford's Jarrod Cande.

A Look at the Numbers

Reading has found most of its success this season during the first half of series. On Tuesday-Thursday, the Fightin Phils hold a 9-4 record. But, on Friday-Sunday, Reading is just 5-12. Additionally, Wednesday night was Reading's second win of the season when scoring less than five runs. The Fightin Phils are 12-1 when scoring north of five runs, and 2-15 when failing to reach the five-run mark.

Rodriguez Rolling

Jose Rodriguez has been heating up as of late. After hitting .176 in April, Rodriguez is hitting .292 in May. He is also riding a five game hit streak, where he is slashing .350/.364/.550, with a .914 OPS, dating back to May 4. Rodriguez has also added two doubles, one triple and five RBI over that span. Rodriguez is the lone member of the Reading roster who is on the Phillies 40-man roster, after being acquired from the White Sox on Apr. 5 for cash consideration.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 10, 2015: At Erie, Aaron Nola has his best outing as a Fightin Phil, going 8.0 innings and allowing just 1 earned run on 4 hits while striking out a season-high 8 for his 4th victory, a 4-1 win over the SeaWolves.

The Goat

Hartford enters today with a 14-13 record, which is third in the Northeast Division. The Yard Gosts continue a two-week road trip after going 2-3 at Binghamton last week. They won the first two games, before dropping the last three, and Sunday was cancelled. After this week, Hartford returns home and welcomes New Hampshire. Last season, Hartford finished with an Eastern League-worst 57-76 record. The Yard Goats roster includes nine of the Rockies top-30 prospects, featuring No. 1 Adael Amador and No. 3 Yanquiel Fernandez. Hartford has now lost six-straight games after winning their previous five.

Goat on the Bump

Righty Andrew Quezada makes the start tonight for the Yard Goats. Quezada has had a strong start to the season, as he is 1-0, with a 1.64 ERA (22 IP, 15 H, 8 BB, 17 SO). At Binghamton on May 3, Quezada tossed six-shutout innings, but did not factor into the decision. Quezada spent all of 2023 with Hartford, going 4-8, with a 5.52 ERA over 25 games and 20 starts. He made four appearances and three starts against Reading last season, going 1-1 with a 3.26 ERA. Quezada spent all of 2022 with High-A Spokane, split 2021 between the ACL-Rockies and Hartford (one start), and began his pro career in 2019 with Rookie-Level Grand Junction. The Rockies drafted the 26-year old in the seventh round of the 2018 draft out of Cal State Fullerton.

2023: Made return to competitive baseball during winter of 2023-24 with Adelaide Giants of the Australian Baseball League. Made nine starts and was lockdown in the Giants rotation. Went 6-0 with a 0.94 ERA. Struck out 63 hitters across 47.2 innings pitched. Posted 11.9 strikeouts per nine innings and a 9.0 strikeout to walk ratio (63 SO, 7 BB). Collected multiple accolades for Adelaide and helped Giants to Australian Baseball League Championship. Strong season led him to sign with Phillies during the winter.

2020: Spent 2020-21 season with Sydney Blue Sox of Australian Baseball League. Made just three appearances and went 1-0 with 1.08 ERA. Struck out 15 across 8.1 innings pitched, which was good for 16.2 strikeouts per nine innings pitched.
