Today: It's a special Coors Light Margaritaville Thirsty Thursday featuring a beach towel giveaway and drink specials, as the Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the A's, play the third game in a six-game series against the Dayton Dragons, the High-A affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds. The two clubs have split the first two games of the series, trading routs, leaving Dayton with a 9-8 record in the 21-game season series. This is the 402nd all-time Lansing/Dayton matchup, coming in the Nuts' 3,806th all-time game; 10.6% of all of the regular season games the Lugnuts have ever played have come against Dayton.

Last Night: Dragons 12, Lugnuts 4. Dayton homered in the 7th, 8th and 9th innings to cruise to the Wednesday matinee victory behind five solid innings from Ryan Cardona. Ryan Lasko and Sahid Valenzuela each went 2-for-4 in the losing cause.

On the Air: Today's game is on MiLB TV and Bally Live, with a Lugnuts audio stream via StreamGuys, Adam Jaksa and Jesse Goldberg-Strassler on the call.

On Deck: Each of the next two nights will feature postgame LAFCU Fireworks, followed by a Capital City Market Kids Day on Sunday to close the homestand.

Heart & Hustle: 2021 Lugnuts utilityman **Max Schuemann** was named the A's nominee for the 2024 MLB Heart & Hustle Award today. From the Heart & Hustle website: "Created by the Major League Baseball Players Alumni Association in 2005, the Heart & Hustle Award is voted on by Alumni and active Major League players and is presented annually to an active player who demonstrates a passion for the game of baseball and best embodies the values, spirit and traditions of the game."

To the Show: 2017/2019 Lugnuts infielder **Luis De Los Santos** made his Major League debut for the Blue Jays last night, becoming the 6th Lugnut to debut this season (joining Max Schuemann, Brett Harris, Brady Basso, Leo Jimenez and Jacob Wilson) and the 190th all-time Nut to go from Lansing to the Majors.

Team Effort: The Nuts' offense is 1st in the Midwest League in batting average (.251), at-bats (3,261), base hits (820), total bases (1,256) and triples (35); 2nd in runs (491) and doubles (162); tied for 2nd in slugging percentage (.385); and 3rd in on-base percentage (.339) and OPS (.724).

Roll Call: The Lugnuts have utilized 44 players this year, with outfielder **Jared Dickey** (acquired as part of a three-player package from Kansas City for Lucas Erceg) debuting yesterday to become the 946th all-time Nut. Today, **T.J. Schofield-Sam** receives his first start; the Canadian opened the year on the roster before getting transferred to Stockton on April 13.

Prospecting: The Nuts have six Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects: pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Ryan Lasko** (No. 16), pitcher **Kade Morris** (No. 20), infielder **Will Simpson** (No. 26), pitcher **Will Johnston** (No. 27) and outfielder **Jared Dickey** (No. 28).

The Future is Here: 21-year-old Luis Morales, scheduled to start on Sunday, tossed 2/3 of an inning in the 2024 All-Star Futures Game at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas, striking out Jeral Pérez and Deyvison De Los Santos alongside an HBP and BB. Morales was the A's sole representative in the prospect showcase, and the fifth all-time current Lugnut to play in the game.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2010: 19-year-old Jake Marisnick made his Lugnuts debut, jumping up from the Gulf Coast Blue Jays. Marisnick, a 3rd-round selection in 2009, had slashed .287/.373/.459 in 35 games in the GCL. In his Lugnuts debut, he went 2-for-3 with a single, double and two RBIs, plus an HBP. Kevin Ahrens went 2-for-2 with two walks and two solo home runs, scoring four runs, but the Lugnuts lost at Bowling Green, 10-8. Lugnuts pitcher Egan Smith was ejected in the 9th from the first-base visitors dugout and made sure to take a sloooooow walk to the clubhouse out beyond the left-center field wall.

2013: How does a 21-hit barrage sound? Leadoff hitter Dwight Smith Jr. went 4-for-4, 3 runs, 2 RBIs, 1 walk; Christian Lopes 3-for-5, 2B, HR, 5 RBIs, and the Lugnuts squashed Kyle Schepel (who had no-hit them earlier in the year) and South Bend, 12-6, at Stanley Coveleski Regional Stadium.

In a Nutshell: Pitched in 2023 with the Nuts, returning to the Midwest League this season... spent the offseason training in Alabama with Tyler Baum... opened the season in a tandem with Opening Day starter James González... González was promoted on May 8, so Myers made the next four starts without a piggybacker... has since pitched in tandems with Chen Zhang-Ao Zhuang, Grant Judkins and Wander Guante... notable splits:

Respect: Mitch posted the No. 3 score in the world in the video game *Monkey Ball...* he is also considered the top chess player in the Lugnuts' clubhouse.


Hometown Hero: Hometown of Lanett's motto is "The Gateway to Alabama," since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

The Buc Starts Here: Initially committed to University of Alabama, but coach instability led to Mitch joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, 35 BB, 62 K, 1 HR... as a sophomore: 7-2, 3.29, 3 CG, 79 1/3, 23 BB, 88 K, 3 HR... became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros).

Onward to Pitt: Upon transferring to Pittsburgh, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 BB, 30 K, 0 HR) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeouts in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt's Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, team-leading 83 K, 6 HR... tossed 9-IP CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five... the last Pitt Panther to appear in a game for the Nuts before Myers was also the only other Panther to play for the Nuts: T.J. Zeuch (pronounced "Zoyk"), the 21st pick in the 2016 draft, who made two starts in the Midwest League for Lansing in 2016.

2022 Professional Debut: After signing for \$125,000 as the Athletics' 12th-round selection in 2021, did not appear in a Minor League game until 2022, spent entirely with Stockton... led Ports in starts (22, six more than the closest teammate), innings (124 1/3, 28 1/3 more innings than the closest teammate), and double plays (10)... worked seven innings five times, 6 2/3 innings once, 6 1/3 innings twice, and six innings four times: 12 starts of 22 starts lasting at least six innings... struggled in 12 games, 11 starts, at home (7.11 ERA, .304 avg, 16 HR, in 57 innings) compared to 11 starts on the road (4.14 ERA, .269, 10 HR in 67 1/3 innings)... lefties and righties hit nearly identically: .286/.355/.536 for lefties, .285/.339/.525 for righties, though righties hit 17 of the 26 home runs allowed... struggled mightily in first innings, allowing .353/.402/.627 slash line and six home runs... opposing base stealers swiped 10 bases in 16 attempts.

2023 with the Lugnuts: Opened season as the Nuts' Wednesday starter... tossed first quality start of the year on April 27, allowing two runs (both in the 5th) in six innings vs. Quad Cities April 27... followed up with a second quality start on May 4 vs. Dayton, though he once again received a no-decision... struck on the back of the head by a line drive against Peoria on June 13 and spent two weeks on the Injured List, missing his scheduled start at Wisconsin before returning to action at Great Lakes on July 3... tossed another quality start (6 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 0 BB, 6 K) against Quad Cities on July 27.

In a Nutshell: Acquired straight up by the A's from the Mets for American League All-Star Paul Blackburn before the trade deadline, July 30, 2024... born in Modesto... hails from the same hometown as former Lugnut Tyler Soderstrom, Turlock, Calif., whom he is close to... attended John H. Pitman High School (which also produced Colin Kaepernick), while Soderstrom attended Turlock H.S. with Rockies 2023 2nd-rounder Cole Carrigg.

Prospecting: MLB Pipeline ranks Kade the A's No. 10 pitching prospect and No. 20 overall prospect, grading his pitches at Fastball - 50, Curve - 45, Slider - 50, Change - 50, Control - 50... they write, "The 6-foot-3 hurler can run his pair of fastballs up to 95-96 mph but will generally be in the 91-94 range. His sinker, with 17-18 inches of arm-side run, has been the better pitch of the two heaters, but he's continued to develop his four-seamer as well. Similarly, he'll throw three different slider varieties -- hard slider, cutter, sweeper -- with the first on that list the most reliable of the bunch at this stage.
