HIGHLIGHTS

MAD MAX: After his ninth inning grand slam on Wednesday, Max Burt finished the night with a career-high-tying 5 RBIs. He last accomplished the feat on May 7, 2021 vs. Dunedin (Single-A). Burt's 5 RBIs are the most in a game by any member of the Patriots this season and his 7 RBIs on the season rank third in the Eastern League.

BETTER LATE THAN NEVER: After their fiverun outburst between the 8th and 9th inning of Wednesday night's game, the Patriots now have posted five runs between the 8th and 9th innings in back-to-back games. More than a third of Somerset's total runs this season (9/26) have been scored in the 9th inning.

HOME RUN HAPPY: After amassing three total home runs in their opening weekend series vs. Harrisburg, the Patriots have now hit three home runs in back-to-back games to start their series in Binghamton. Somerset now ranks second in the Eastern League with nine home runs, trailing Altoona's 10.

KINGS OF K: The Patriots have struck out a combined total of 29 batters over the first two games of their series in Binghamton. Wednesday night's total of 15 strikeouts set a new season-high for the Patriots. Starter Richard Fitts set a new career-high mark with his 10-strikeout performance.

SEASON OF SWEENEY: On Wednesday night, Trey Sweeney became the first Patriot this season to accomplish a three-hit game, finishing a triple shy of the cycle. The performance marked Sweeney's first three-hit game at the Double-A level. He led off the game with a home run on the second pitch, also signaling Somerset's first leadoff home run of the season.

2023: This year at Yankees MLB Spring Training, Warren threw two scoreless IP vs. Atlanta, allowing one hit.

2022: Began his rookie season in 2022 by pitching to a 3.60 ERA with 42 strikeouts in 35 IP over eight starts in High-A Hudson Valley, before being promoted to Somerset on 5/29/22. Awarded his first career Pitcher of the Week honors on 7/10/22 with Somerset, after earning the win on 7/6 vs. Bowie, when he went a career-high 7.0 IP, 0 R, 3 H and 5 K. Warren began the season ranked by Baseball America as Yankees No. 27 prospect, before jumping to No. 8 in the publications's mid-season rankings. After being unranked on MLB Pipeline's list of top 30 Yankees prospects pre-season, Warren was ranked No. 25 in their first mid-season update and in the publication's August update, he jumped to their No. 8 ranked Yankees prospect.

2021: Did not pitch in 2021 season after being drafted--instead worked with the Yankees strength and conditioning department to gain 15 lbs. of muscle, also worked to add a slider and two-seam fastball to his repertoire.

College: Attended Southeastern Louisiana University, where he was named to the 2021 Southland All-Conference Team his senior year, going 7-2 with a 2.57 ERA and 95 strikeouts in 91 innings over 14 starts. Warren led the Southeastern staff in wins (7), innings pitched (91.0), strikeouts (95) and opponent batting average (.214). He ranked third, second, fourth and fifth in the conference in those same categories, respectively, while also finishing fourth in ERA (2.57). Threw a career-high 116 pitches in final collegiate start vs. Northwestern State. Finished his Southeastern Louisiana career with a 13-10 career record, four saves and a 3.90 ERA. He allowed only 178 hits in 205.0 career innings pitched, striking out 193 batters.

Personal Notes: No. 4 ranked RHP in Mississippi class of 2017 by Perfect Game, was state champion at Jackson Prep as a senior, when he went 7-0 with a 1.39 ERA.

Career Notes: Selected by the Yankees in the 8th round of the 2021 MLB Draft.






