RHP Stephen Nogosek Rehab: Mets' reliever **Stephen Nogosek** will make an MLB rehab appearance on Wednesday for the Rumble Ponies. Nogosek spent 2018 and part of 2019 with the Rumble Ponies. In 2019 he was dominant with Binghamton, going 0-0, with a 0.95 ERA in 11 appearances. He made his Major League Debut on June 19, 2019 in Atlanta against the Braves. Nogosek has made 23 appearances for the Mets over four seasons (2019, 2021, 2022, 2023) and in 2022 he carried just a 2.45 ERA in 12 games.

Last Time Out: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies exploded for seven runs across the middle innings and defeated the Akron RubberDucks 7-5 in the series opener on Tuesday morning, on Baseball in Education Day at Mirabito Stadium. Matt O'Neill smacked a go-ahead solo home run, which was his first hit of the season. Jose Peroza had a three-hit, three-RBI game. Luis Moreno tossed six innings of one-run baseball.

Middle Innings Explosion: The Rumble Ponies have scored 33 of their 66 runs (50%) in the middle three innings of games this season. Binghamton scored seven runs across the middle three innings on Tuesday and their most in the middle frames is nine runs scored against Somerset on April 12.

Closing Out: LHP Nate Lavender has built a role for himself as the Ponies' closer. Lavender has four saves this season, which is tied for the second-most in the Eastern League. In his last four outings, he has combined to throw four scoreless innings with just one hit allowed and seven strikeouts.

Last Start: Hamel allowed just one run over four innings, with two strikeouts and three walks against Hartford last week. The Ponies have yet to score a run in a game that Hamel started this year.

World Baseball Classic: Hamel represented Team Puerto Rico in the 2023 World Baseball Classic. He honored his late mother, who passed away 11 days before the Mets selected him in the 2021 MLB Draft. He was WBC teammates with current New York Mets, Francisco Lindor and Edwin Díaz.

2022: Was named the 2022 New York Mets Minor League Pitcher of the Year. He led all Mets minor leaguers with 10 wins and 145 strikeouts. Began the season with St. Lucie (A) and pitched to a 5-2 record with a 3.84 ERA in 14 appearances and 13 starts. He tossed 63.1 innings and struck out 71 batters, before he was assigned to Brooklyn (A+) on July 4. He went 5-1 on the mound with a 2.59 ERA in 11 starts for the Cyclones. He struck out 74 hitters over 55.2 innings and opponents hit just .180 against him.

BACKGROUND: Begins the 2023 season ranked as the Mets' No. 2 pitching prospect and No. 9 overall prospect by MLB Pipeline. He was drafted out of Dallas Baptist University in the 3rd round (81st overall) by the Mets in 2021. Hamel went 13-2 on the mound and racked up 136 strikeouts in his final year at DBU in 2021. He spent his first two years at Yavapai College in Arizona.

Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year. As a player, Brignac appeared in parts of nine seasons in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

AJ Sager - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization. Sager served in the same role for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) last season. Sager previously spent twenty seasons with the Detroit Tigers organization, including six seasons as the pitching coach with Triple-A Toledo. He pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Detroit Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career.
