**LAST OUTING:** Gasser last appeared on May 6 in St. Paul, taking over for starter Pedro Fernandez in the resumption of May 5's contest. Gasser sat down eight Saints via K over 3.1 innings, but otherwise gave up four runs (all earned) on five hits and three walks. He did not receive a decision in Nashville's 10-7 defeat. It was the young lefty's first career appearance out of the pen.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** This is Gasser's first career appearance against Gwinnett.
