### FROM THE CROWS NEST

**DOMINATING BOTH SIDES OF THE BALL:** Despite Sunday's postponement, the Marauders took three of their five matchups versus the Flying Tigers last week. As a pitching staff, Bradenton punched out 52 hitters and allowed just two homers over 45 innings of work. In the process, they limited Lakeland bats to a just 30 hits and eight for extra bases (.186 BAA). Offensively, they slashed .291/.367/.448 with 17 extra-base hits (3.4 p/g) and 29 total runs (5.8 p/g). On Thursday, they notched a season-high 17 hits and 9 stolen bases in their 12-3 win.

**AGER TOES THE RUBBER:** Right hander **Matt Ager** will make his fifth start of the season tonight and first against Dunedin. Through 12 innings, he has punched out 16 hitters while only allowing four earned runs (3.00 ERA). Despite allowing three runs over three frames versus Lakeland last week, he fanned a career-high six hitters. His fastball averaged at 89 miles per hour. This year, his slider has generated a 42.9 percent whiff rate and has allowed just one hit.

**SCOUTING THE D-JAYS:** The Dunedin Blue Jays enter the week on a torrid run, having won five straight and eight of their last ten games to begin May. Entering play, they lead the Florida State League in runs scored (218), home runs (32), OPS (.788) and third in walks (174). Their 3.51 team ERA also leads the league. Last week they took five of six at Fort Myers. Throughout the series, they slashed .272/.344/.451 with nine homers. On the mound, they allowed just 14 earned runs over 55.1 innings. The Mussels batted just .204 and fanned 73 times.

**ROUND OF A. PLAZ:** While Pirates No. 28 prospect **Axiel Plaz** leads Bradenton in hitting (.310), RBI (20) and average exit velocity (93.3 mph), his increase in contact at the plate has turned heads. Through 27 games, his whiff rate is down four percent (28.4%) and his strikeout rate has dropped by 12 percent (17.2%) while maintaining elite batted-ball quality. This year he is batting .348 and slugging .659 on pitches in the zone.

**MARAUDERS MASHERS:** Bradenton's starting lineup features some of the highest ranked batted-ball quality in all of the Single-A level. Axiel Plaz's 58% Hard-Hit Rate (percent of batted balls with exit velocity of 95 mph+) ranks second among players to see at least 250 pitches in Single-A this season. **Braylon Bishop** ranks 7th (52.9%), **Konnor Griffin** ranks 13th, (46.6%), and **Derek Berg** slots in at 15th (45.9%). Moreover, Griffin's 114.2 mph single on April 8 vs PLM is the second hardest batted ball in Single-A this year. He's recorded 26 batted balls of 100 mph or harder.

**GETTING IT DONE ON THE BUMP:** Over their last 18 games (since April 20th), Bradenton's staff has been stellar, posting a 2.96 ERA - the second best mark in the FSL only behind Dunedin (2.84) in that span. Throughout the dominant stretch, they've limited opposing hitters to a .193 average, the lowest in the league by 30 percentage points. Bradenton's pen boasts a 2.56 ERA in that span as well. In their prior 14 outings to begin the year, the Marauders 5.57 ERA was the fourth highest in all of the FSL.

**MAKING HISTORY:** Pirates No. 30 ranked prospect **David Matoma** was promoted to Single-A Bradenton on 4/26, and made his team debut tossing 1.1 innings while allowing one earned run with one punchout. The 19-year-old right hander was born in Kasana, Uganda. If he makes it to the big leagues, he would become the first player from Uganda and second from Africa (Gift Ngoepe). On Saturday, he featured a fastball that sat between 96-98 miles per hour and touched 99 multiple times. Last year, he reached 101 mph in an FCL game. In 24 prior outings before 2025, Matoma allowed just two earned runs over 38.2 innings. Over that stretch, he fanned 42 and walked 17.

**FINISHING APRIL STRONG:** Despite a slow start to the month and a 9-14 finish, the Marauders generated momentum at the end of the month. They took four of their last six games, outscoring opponents 33-25. During that stretch, Bradenton scored 33 runs (5.5 R/G) and produced a .713 OPS - both the second best in the FSL. Their six homers and 55 hits were the most in the league during that span. As a pitching staff, they also limited opposing hitters to 4.1 runs per game. Last May, Bradenton followed a 5-17 April with a 16-10 May, their winningest month during the 2024 season, which featured a franchise-best 11 game winning streak.

## MANAGER - JIM HORNER

**DOB:** 11/11/1973 (51) **YEAR WITH BRD:** 2nd as Manager  
**HOMETOWN:** Twin Falls, (ID) **PREV.ROLES W/ BRD:** Bench Coach ('21)

- Returns to Bradenton in 2025 for his second season as manager of the club
- Sixth year in the Pirates organization
- Prior to 2024, Horner managed the Florida Complex League Pirates (FCL) in 2023, served as a Minor League Assistant Field Coordinator in 2022 and a bench coach for Bradenton in 2021.
- Previously served as hitting coach at Power 5 programs Texas Tech University and Washington State University.
- Last year's promotion marked his first opportunity to lead a full-season affiliate since 2015, when he managed the Jackson Generals, the then Double-A affiliate of the Seattle Mariners, capping a ten-year coaching career in their farm system.
- Over his nine-year career on the diamond, the former catcher played in 589 minor-league games and reached as high as Triple-A before transitioning to coaching after the 2004 campaign.
