### INDY BITS

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT, GAME 1:** In the first contest, Indianapolis used a three-run fifth inning to snag the victory. With two runners aboard, Peguero doubled home Nick Gonzales to cut the deficit to 4-3. Jake Lamb then walked on a wild pitch that plated Gilberto Celestino to tie the game. Following a pitching change, Malcom Nufiez lofted a sacrifice fly to center field. Moisés Gómez put Memphis in front in the first inning with a run-scoring single, but the Indians responded with two in the home half on a Peguero RBI single and McKinney sacrifice fly. Indy's lead held until the fourth when Arquímedes Gamboa singled to right to drive in Gavin Collins. Willy Peralta took over for Quinn Priester in the fifth and surrendered a sacrifice fly to Nick Dunn that put the visitors back on top. Gómez later raced home on a Peralta wild pitch, but the Indians' half of the fifth settled the score.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT, GAME 2:** Game 2 featured another Indians rally that led to victory. The Redbirds again claimed a 1-0 lead in the opening frame on a sacrifice fly by Luken Baker, but McKinney and Gorski's long balls to begin the second pushed the Indians in front, 2-1. Memphis regained the lead momentarily with three runs in the top of the third before the Indians sent 10 batters to the dish, tallied six hits and scored five runs – all with two outs in the bottom half of the third. Joshua Palacios had a run-scoring single, Matt Gorski ripped a two-run double, Grant Koch notched an RBI double and Gonzales singled home a run to finish the frame. The Redbirds inched closer on an RBI groundout by Baker in the fifth, but Brent Honeywell slammed the door with a six-out save.

**DOUBLEHEADERS:** The Indians swept last night's doubleheader with 5-4 and 7-5 wins, marking their first doubleheader sweep since 4/6/23 at Louisville (5-3, 1-0) and their first at Victory Field since 6/4/21 vs. Columbus (10-3, 5-2). Last season, the Indians went 4-6 with a 1-5 record at home in doubleheader games.

**IT'S PEGGY'S WORLD:** After setting a new career-high in hits on Friday night, Liover Peguero continued his hot stretch with a 2-for-3 showing, run, double and two RBI in Game 1 last night. In his past two games, he is 7-for-8 with two runs, two doubles and five RBI. His five-hit game on Friday was the 17th five-hit game by an Indian in the Victory Field era and first since Ryan Vilade on 9/19/23 vs. Rochester. The 23-year-old has been off to a hot start with Indianapolis this season, hitting safely in six of seven games with a .406 batting average (13-for-32), six runs, four doubles and nine RBI.

**THE HOMETOWN HERO:** Matt Gorski was the star in Game 2 for the Indians, going 2-for-3 with two runs, a two-run double and solo home run en route to a doubleheader-sweeping victory. He was one of three Indians batters with multiple hits and the lone slugger with multiple runs driven in. Through five games this season, he is hitting .278 (5-for-18) with three runs, two doubles, one home run and four RBI.

**BACK-TO-BACK:** Billy McKinney and Matt Gorski launched back-to-back home runs in the second inning of Game 2 last night, marking the first set of back-to-back home runs by Indians batters this season. In 2023, Indians sluggers hit eight sets of back-to-back home runs, the team's most dating back to at least 2005. McKinney and Gorski own the first set of back-to-back home runs vs. the Redbirds since beginning their all-time series in 2021 when Memphis joined the International League.

**ALL SORTS OF STREAKS:** Nick Gonzales, Jake Lamb and Gilberto Celestino all own active streaks dating back to Opening Day on 3/29. Gonzales, who entered last night's doubleheader with a six-game hitting streak, went hitless in Game 1 but extended his on-base streak to eight games with two walks in the opener and a two-hit game in the nightcap. Jake Lamb joins Gonzales with an eight-game on-base streak, which is tied with four others for the longest in the International League dating back to the season opener. Gilberto Celestino's hitting streak remains intact at seven games after he singled in each twinbill contest.

**GILBERTO GETS IT:** Gilberto Celestino singled in both Game 1 and Game 2 for the Indians last night, extending his hitting streak to seven games since 3/29 at Louisville. In that time, he owns a .346 batting average (9-for-26) with six runs, three doubles, six RBI, four walks and five strikeouts. Celestino since a phenom with runners in scoring position, going 5-for-6 with two doubles. The 25-year-old spent most of an injury-shortened 2023 season with Triple-A St. Paul, hitting .243 (45-for-185) with 17 extra-base hits and 31 RBI in 55 games. In 113 career Triple-A games, he owns a .281 batting average (36-for-128) with 12 extra-base hits and 49 RBI.

**TODAY:** The Indians will look to extend their winning streak to five games vs. Memphis in today's series finale at 1:35 PM ET. The Indians now lead the all-time series 19-16 after sweeping yesterday's doubleheader. In a rematch of Indy's home opener on Tuesday, LHP Cam Allred (0-1, 6.00) will battle RHP Sem Robberse (1-0, 1.80). The starters were the pitchers of record in that series-opening contest, with Robberse's 5.0 one-run innings besting Allred's 3.0 two-run frames.

**THIS DATE IN 2018:** Tyler Eppler, who would go on to be Indianapolis' Pitcher of the Year Award recipient, fanned 10 batters over 5.2 innings to earn his first of 13 wins on the season. Indy's offense backed Eppler with 10 runs, putting up two-spots in the second and fourth innings before a five-run sixth, led by shortstop Kevin Newman with three RBI and two doubles by catcher Jacob Stallings. Relievers Richard Rodriguez and Tyler Jones kept the shutout intact, recording six of the final 10 outs via strikeout. The pitching staff's combined 16 strikeouts was a high for the season.

**Cam Alldred:** Southpaw Cam Alldred is set to make his season debut in today's series finale vs. Memphis.

**Last Outing:** Alldred took the bump in Indy's home opener on Sunday night and took the loss after allowing two runs in 3.0 innings.

**Against the Redbirds:** Prior to Tuesday's outing, Alldred had appeared in seven games career games vs. the Redbirds with a 6.39 ERA (9er/12.2ip) and 11 strikeouts.

**Cam is the Man:** Cam Alldred spent the 2023 season as the Indians' ultimate go-to man, making 17 starts and 14 appearances out of the bullpen. He recorded his first career quality start on 6/16 at Iowa (6.0ip, 2r) to kick off a stretch of three consecutive such starts and four total on the season. He went 3-7 with a 4.44 ERA (39er/79.0ip) and 74 strikeouts as a starter and 5-1 with a 7.43 ERA (22er/26.2ip) and 24 strikeouts in relief.

**Miscellaneous:** Selected by Pittsburgh in the 24th round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft ... Fanned a career-high eight batters for the first time at Louisville on 6/29/23 ... Made his major league debut on 5/12/22 vs. Cincinnati.
