HIGHLIGHTS

AUGUST OF AGUSTIN: Agustin Ramirez will be making his Double-A debut tonight, batting third and starting at DH for the Somerset Patriots. After making his High-A debut on June 29, Ramirez found an immediate spark following the callup, hitting .529 over his first six High-A games. Then, in July, Ramirez was named the South Atlantic League Player of the Month. With the Hudson Valley Renegades during July, Ramirez led the South Atlantic League in AVG (.415), H (34), 2B (10), TB (62), SLG (.756) and OPS (1.223). He homered six times in 20 July games, including in four straight games from July 23-27.

MARTIAN MADNESS: Yankees top prospect Jasson Dominguez enters today on a season-high-matching six-game hit streak, after having hit safely in all six games during Somerset's road trip in Akron (10-for-25 with 3 RBI, 4 R, 4 SB and 4 BB). He also enters today on a season-high 16-game on-base streak (23-for-70, .329 AVG). During Sunday's series finale, Dominguez hit his 13th home run of the series, scored a career-high four runs in a game for the fourth time in his career (last: May 16 vs. POR) and set a new career-high 3 SB in the game. Dominguez enters today with 69 runs scored, which lead the Eastern League. Dominguez also registered his team-leading 25th multi-hit game of the season, including his second straight and third in theseries. The multi-hit performance was also Dominguez's fifth in the last 10 games, in which he is 17-for-43 (.395 AVG) with 10 RBI, 6 R, 5 BB and 7 SB. His 56 RBIs on the season now tie him with Tyler Hardman for the Patriots' team lead. Dominguez enters today batting a season-best .238 on the season.

ARMS RACE: Ahead of this week's series, the Yankees promoted RHPs Drew Thorpe and Jack Neely to Double-A Somerset. Thorpe, the Yankees' top-ranked pitching prospect, leads all Yankees minor leaguers in ERA (2.81), W (10), SO (138) and WHIP (1.07). Neely has posted a 2.03 ERA with 74 K over 48.2 IP with six saves. Of the 11 listed probable starters in this week's series, nine are top-30 ranked Mets or Yankees prospects (MLB Pipeline).

2023: Assigned to the High-A Hudson Valley break camp roster, making his professional debut for the Renegades on April 11 vs. Aberdeen. Went 2-1 with a 2.68 ERA in nine High-A starts before he was promoted to Double-A Somerset on 6/15. At the time of his promotion, Hampton's 77 strikeouts led the Yankees organization and ranked 5th in all of MiLB. Over his final four High-A starts, Hampton posted a 2.31 ERA and struck out 35 batters over a span of 23.1 IP.

Career Notes: Selected by the Yankees in the 6th round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Texas Tech as a draft eligible sophomore, signing for a \$497,500 bonus. Pitched to a 4.29 ERA over 15 total appearances including 11 starts his sophomore year, where he ranked third on the team with 72 K in 56.2 IP. Set a career high with 12 strikeouts in his final collegiate outing in the Statesboro Regional versus Notre Dame, matching the program record for most single game strikeouts in a NCAA tournament game. Posted a 3.84 ERA his freshman season in 18 total appearances with 34 K in 44.1 IP.

Personal Notes: One of three former Texas Tech Red Raiders on the Patriots, joining Clayton Beeter and TJ Rumfield. Attended Kilgore High School in Kilgore, TX. Finished high school career with 284 strikeouts and a 1.94 ERA in 162 innings pitched, earning First Team All-State and District MVP honors his senior year. Was also awarded 2020 Perfect Game Preseason All-American and First Team All-Region honors. Helped Kilgore reach 2019 State Championship game his junior year.

Dominguez begins his 1st season as manager for the Somerset Patriots, 9th overall as a manager and 17th overall coaching in the Yankees organization. He spent the past two seasons (2021-2022) as a defensive coach for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre and was assigned to the same post for 2020, before the minor league season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Dominguez becomes the 5th manager in Patriots franchise history and the 3rd since becoming the Yankees Double-A affiliate. He succeeds 2022 Eastern League Manager of the Year Dan Fiorito. Dominguez also previously served as the defensive coach for Trenton (2018-2019) and Tampa (2017). The Panama City, Panama native has managerial experience with the GCL Yankees East (2016), DSL Yankees 1 (2011-15) and DSL Yankees 2 (2009-10). From 2012-2015, his teams finished at least 10 games over .500, including reaching the DSL semifinals in 2012 and 2015. An outfielder during his playing days, Dominguez signed with the Yankees as an undrafted free agent in 2001 and spread four minor league seasons for New York between the DSL and the GCL.
