**LAST TIME OUT:** Brooklyn dropped the opening game of its series to Bowling Green on Wednesday afternoon, 14-5...The 14 runs and 17 hits accumulated by the Hot Rods were the most against Cyclones pitching in 2024...The 14 runs allowed were the most since a 15-3 loss in 7 innings at Wilmington on August 11, 2021...The 17 hits were the most surrendered since an 11-9 defeat vs. Wilmington in 10 innings on July 25, 2023...CF **Nick Morabito** picked up his second-straight three-hit game, adding a double, and a team season-high three stolen bases...2B **Junior Tilién** collected two extra-base hits including a double and a solo home run...1B **Nick Lorusso** added a three-run home run in Brooklyn's four-run fifth.

**DOUBLE DARE:** The Cyclones will play their second doubleheader of the 2024 season on Thursday...Brooklyn swept its first twinbill against Asheville on April 13...The Cyclones captured the lid-lifter, 6-2, and snagged the nightcap, 3-1...It was the first doubleheader sweep for Brooklyn since June 18, 2022, at Wilmington...The Cyclones won the opener that day in eight innings, 1-0, and then, playing as the home team, won the finale, 4-1...Brooklyn was 0-4-2 in doubleheaders last season and 2-10 overall.

**MORABITO FUEL:** OF **Nick Morabito** has reached safely all six games since making his High-A and Cyclones debut last Tuesday night and collected his second consecutive three-hit game on Wednesday...The now 21-year-old leads Minor League Baseball in on-base percentage (.520) and wRC+ (203)...He is also second in batting average (.396) and wOBA (.495)...Morabito is the only player at the full-season MiLB level with an OBP greater than .500 and holds a mark 28 points higher than anyone else...The McLean, Va. native's three stolen bases on Wednesday tied nine others for the franchise mark in a single game...Morabito became the first Cyclone to collect three swipes in a single game since LF **Alex Ramirez** accomplished the feat on July 21, 2023, at Hudson Valley.

**YIPPEE KI-YAY:** TWP **Nolan McLean** has had an incredible start to his Cyclones career...On the mound, McLean had his team-best scoreless inning streak halted at 151 innings in a no-decision last Friday at Rome...Over his last four starts, McLean is 2-0 with a 1.00 ERA (2 ER in 18.0 IP), allowing just 10 hits and five walks (7.81 BB%), adding 21 strikeouts (32.81 K%)...On the year, among pitchers with 24.0+ innings, he is sixth in the South Atlantic League in fewest hits allowed (15) and tied for ninth in WHIP (1.00)...At the plate, the 22-year-old tied a career-high with three hits and collected a pair of extra-base hits with a double and a two-run home run last Wednesday...The Willow Springs, N.C. native has registered 32 fewer plate appearances (65) than any other player with 11+ extra-base knocks in the circuit and eight fewer plate appearances with that total across the minor leagues...Among players with 65+ plate appearances, McLean is fifth in the league in slugging (.541).

**LARRUPIN' LORUSSO:** INF **Nick Lorusso** has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...The Connecticut native's season-long hitting streak was snapped at nine last Saturday, but his on-base streak stands at a team season-high-tying 12...Since April 27, the former Maryland Terrapin has been 13-for-46 at the plate, hitting .283/.346/.478 with an .824 OPS...Lorusso has scored seventh runs, four doubles, a triple, a home run, and 10 RBI in that time...The 23-year-old is tied for second in the South Atlantic League in triples (2), tied for sixth in doubles (8), tied for eighth in extra-base hits (13), and tied for ninth in slugging (.495).

**OMAR-I-GONE:** With a pair of stolen bases off the bench on May 2 vs. Aberdeen, OF **Omar De Los Santos** (58) became the Cyclones' all-time stolen base king, breaking a tie with UT **Jaylen Palmer** (50)...In 2023, the 24-year-old eclipsed INF **Walter Rasquin**'s (32) single-season stolen base record with 37 swipes...Omar is 16 swipes away from tying his previous record and on pace for 82 in 2024...De Los Santos is 21-for-23 stealing bases to start the season...The 21 swipes are second in the South Atlantic League and tied for third-most throughout the minors...Bowling Green's OF **Chandler Simpson** (28) leads the SAL and MiLB...Since the start of 2022, De Los Santos is tied for third across the Minors in steals (128)...Simpson is second in MiLB (130).

**WALK THIS WAY:** INF **William Lugo** has accumulated walks in droves in 2024...Lugo's 28 free passes are the fourth most in the league...Lugo's 22.6% walk rate is also fourth in the league and eighth in all of Minor League Baseball.

**A THOUSAND VICTORIES:** Brooklyn's 2-1 victory at Rome on Saturday afternoon marked the 1,000th in Cyclones' franchise history...Brooklyn has record a mark of 1,000-844 (.542) in 1,844 games since 2001...Tuesday's 6-2 victory in Rome marked the franchise's 200th since joining the South Atlantic League in 2021...The Cyclones are 202-213 (.487) in 415 games...Brooklyn captured its 900th franchise victory with a 6-5 triumph over Wilmington on August 14, 2022...Brooklyn's very first win came in a 3-2 victory on June 19, 2001, at James-town.

**DOUBLE-DIGIT DOUGLAS:** RHP **Douglas Orellana** set a personal and team season-high with 10 strikeouts last Saturday afternoon at Rome...The

**vs. BOWLING GREEN:** Brooklyn continues its only two-week road trip of the season against the Rays' High-A affiliate...The Hot Rods possess eight of Tampa Bay's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: 1B **Xavier Isaac** (3), INF **Brayden Taylor** (4), OF **Chandler Simpson** (10), INF **Tre' Morgan** (13), OF **Colton Ledbetter** (14), RHP **Yoniel Curet** (16), RHP **Trevor Martin** (19), and INF **Cooper Kinney** (22)...This marks the third-ever series between Bowling Green and Brooklyn franchises since the Cyclones entered the South Atlantic League in 2021...Brooklyn dropped 4-of-6 in their first visit to Bowling Green Ballpark in 2022...The Cyclones are 5-7 against Hot Rods in 12 all-time meetings.

22-year-old did not allow a run on two hits and walked just one...It was the second double-digit strikeout game of Orellana's career...The Caracas, Venezuela native punched out a career-high 11 over four frames in Game 2 of a doubleheader for the Florida Complex League Mets on July 14, 2022...Orellana is the first Cyclone to strike out 10+ hitters in a single game since RHP **Robert Colina** punched out 10 in six innings in a win at Greenville on September 2, 2023...Among South Atlantic League pitchers with 24.0+ innings of work, Orellana ranks third in ERA (1.11) and fourth in WHIP (0.95).

**JONAH'S WHALE OF A START:** RHP **Jonah Tong**'s stretch of innings to start the year without allowing an earned run came to a close last Wednesday night at 26.0 frames...In eight appearances (six starts) between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, the 20-year-old is 1-0 with a 0.86 ERA (3 ER in 31.1 IP)...Tong is third among qualifiers in Minor League Baseball in ERA (0.86)...The Markham, Ont. native is also fourth among qualifiers in MiLB in strikeout rate (39.5%)...Tong's 51 strikeouts are tied for eighth-most in the minors.

**EXTRA! EXTRA!** Brooklyn's 6-3 win over Rome on Friday night marked the Cyclones' first win in extra innings in 2024...The Cyclones had started the season 0-2, dropping contests on April 7 at Wilmington and May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Friday was Brooklyn's first win in added frames since a 13-12 triumph in 10 innings at Asheville on August 24, 2023...Since the start of 2023, the Cyclones are 7-10 in extra-inning contests.

**ATOP THE HEJ-ES:** RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 51 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-1 record with a 2.58 ERA (23 ER in 80.1 IP) and 4 saves, walking just 19 and striking out 70.

**KING STANLEY:** OF **Stanley Consuegra** is Brooklyn's all-time leader in several categories, including 67 extra-base hits, 29 home runs, and 101 RBI...The 23-year-old is also nine hits away (155) from matching OF **Alex Ramirez**'s (164) franchise record for base knocks...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C **Francisco Alvarez** for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021.

**SEVENTH HEAVEN:** The Cyclones' offense exploded for seven runs in the bottom of the first in April 30's 9-2 win vs. Aberdeen...They also accomplished the feat in the bottom of the third in a 13-3 win vs. Wilmington on April 24...Brooklyn had 10 consecutive batters reach base with one out in the inning...The seven-run frames are the largest for the Cyclones since they erupted for nine in the bottom of the second inning on July 27, 2023, vs. Wilmington, in an 11-7 triumph...The 13 runs for Brooklyn set a new season high...The Cyclones had not tallied that many in a single contest since a 13-12 win at Asheville in 10 innings on August 24, 2023...It was the first time Brooklyn scored 13+ in a nine-inning game dating back to an 18-1 thrashing at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022...Since 2005, the Cyclones' highwater mark for runs in a single inning is 10 in the top of the sixth of a 20-6 romp at Bowling Green on May 27, 2022...The 20 runs were also a franchise record.

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have three of the Top 30 per BA: **Nolan McLean** (No. 11), **Jonah Tong** (22), and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: McLean (19), Tong (20), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Received a no-decision last Friday at Rome...Allowed two runs on a season-high four hits over a career-high-tying five innings...Walked two and struck out five...Tossed 70 pitches and 44 strikes (62.86%)...Relieved by RHP **Jordany Ventura** to start the bottom of the sixth inning with the game tied at two...Cyclones scored three runs in the top of the 10th and ultimately defeated the Emperors, 6-3, in 10 innings.

**YIPPEE KI-YAY:** On the mound, McLean had his team-best scoreless inning streak halted at 15.1 innings in a no-decision last Friday at Rome...Over his last four starts, McLean is 2-0 with a 1.00 ERA (2 ER in 18.0 IP), allowing just 10 hits and five walks (7.81 BB%), adding 21 strikeouts (32.81 K%)...On the year, among pitchers with 24.0+ innings, he is sixth in the South Atlantic League in fewest hits allowed (15) and tied for ninth in WHIP (1.00)...At the plate, the 22-year-old tied a career-high with three hits and collected a pair of extra-base hits with a double and a two-run home run last Wednesday...The Willow Springs, N.C. native has registered 32 fewer plate appearances (65) than any other player with 11+ extra-base knocks in the circuit and eight fewer plate appearances with that total across the minor leagues...Among players with 65+ plate appearances, McLean is fifth in the league in slugging (.541).

**PROSPECT RADAR:** McLean enters the 2024 campaign as one of the top prospects in the New York Mets farm system...The 22-year-old is considered New York's No. 11 prospect per *Baseball America* and No. 19 by MLB Pipeline.

**SPRING BREAKOUT:** The Willow Springs, N.C. native earned the win pitching in relief for the New York Mets prospects in their contest against the Washington Nationals' farmhands on Friday, March 15...McLean came on in support of former Cyclone RHP **Blade Tidwell** in the top of the fifth...The right-hander did not allow a run on one hit, did not walk a batter, and struck out a batter...Tossed only 10 pitches (7 strikes)...Relieved by RHP **Brandon Sproat** to start the sixth in the Mets' 4-2 win.

**COWBOY UP:** The second-year pro had a tremendous career at Oklahoma State before departing...In 2023, McLean served predominantly as a relief pitcher, posting a 1-2 record with a 3.30 ERA (11 ER in 30.0 IP) and six saves, tallying 34 strikeouts...As a hitter, he collected a .250/.379/.532 line with a .911 OPS, nine home runs and 29 RBI...McLean was a Perfect Game/Rawlings Second Team All-American in 2022 and was a member of the Oklahoma State football team as a quarterback in 2020.

**TWO TIMES:** McLean was drafted for the second time last summer, as the New York Mets chose him with the 91st-overall pick...The right-hander was also selected by the Baltimore Orioles in the third round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Oklahoma State University, but did not sign...Joined teammate RHP **Brandon Sproat** as two of three players selected in the top 10 rounds that did not sign.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor into the decision pitching in relief last Friday at Rome...Entered in support of RHP **Nolan McLean** to start the bottom of the sixth with the game tied at two...Allowed one run on two hits over 3.1 innings...Walked one and struck out four...Tossed 48 pitches and 31 strikes (64.58%)...Relieved by RHP **Victor Castañeda** with runners at the corners and one out in the bottom of the ninth and Brooklyn leading, 3-2...One of two bequeathed runners scored to force extra innings...Cyclones scored three in the top of the 10th and defeated the Emperors, 6-3, in 10 frames.

**VAMOS VENTURA:** The 23-year-old makes his first start of the 2024 season on Thursday after dominating in relief...Ventura had a 10.1-inning scoreless streak halted last Friday and, among South Atlantic League relief arms, he is eighth in strikeouts (25)...When narrowed down to arms with 18.0+ innings of work, the right-hander is third in fewest walks allowed (5) and strikeout-to-walk rate (5.00) and tied for fourth in ERA (2.41).

**WHAT A DIFFERENCE A YEAR MAKES:** One of the biggest changes for Ventura in the 2024 campaign has been a significant decrease in walks, in addition to an uptick in strikeouts...In 10 starts for the Cyclones in 2023, the Santo Domingo, D.R. native held a strikeout rate of 21.70% and a walk rate of 15.57%...So far this season, Ventura has raised his strikeout rate by 11.63% (33.33%) and lowered his walk rate by 8.90% (6.67%).

**PROSPECT RADAR:** Ventura enters the 2024 ranked as the Mets' No. 38 prospect according to *Baseball America*...The publication considered him the franchise's No. 16 prospect in 2023, No. 19 in 2022, and No. 20 in 2021...MLB Pipeline considered the 23-year-old New York's No. 20 farmhand going into the 2023 season.

**2023:** The Santo Domingo, D.R. native began the campaign with Single-A St. Lucie...Posted a 4-3 record with a 5.67 ERA (34 ER in 54.0 IP), 50 walks, and 60 strikeouts in 15 appearances (13 starts)...Transferred to Brooklyn on July 14...Collected a 3-2 mark with a 3.86 ERA (21 ER in 49.0 IP), 33 walks, and 46 strikeouts in 10 starts for the Cyclones.

**COMEBACK TRAIL:** Ventura missed the entire 2021 season after undergoing Tommy John surgery...The right-hander returned in 2022 and made four starts between the Florida Complex League Mets and Single-A St. Lucie...However, Ventura suffered a pectoral muscle injury and was shut down for the remainder of the season.
