#### Clean Slate

The Fightin Phils continue the first week of the season's second half with game three of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox at home. It is the sixth-of-nine matchups between the teams this season and third-of-six in Reading. The teams saw each other the first weekend of the season from Apr. 5-7 in Bowie. Reading won the first game, then dropped the final two contests at Prince George's Stadium. Bowie leads the season-series 3-2.

#### Quiet Night Offensively

The Fightin Phils saw their season-best four-game win streak snapped with a 3-2 loss on Wednesday night. Reading struck first with a two-run home run from Otto Kemp in the bottom of the first. But, that was all the offense the R-Phils could garner. Bowie tied the game with a run in the second and another in the third. Then, took the lead for good with a tally in the top of the sixth. Matt Osterberg took the loss, allowing three runs on seven hits over 5.1 innings, with three strikeouts. Konnor Ash struck out three over 1.2 innings. Zach Haake and Andrew Schultz each tossed scoreless innings of relief out of the bullpen.

#### Carson Crushing It

Carson Taylor stayed red-hot with two hits, a run, a home run and three RBI on Tuesday night. Since June 18, Taylor is slashing .346/.393/.500, with an .893 OPS. He added five runs, one double, one home run and seven RBI. Last week was highlighted by a four-hit perfommace on Friday night, which was the second four-hit game of Taylor's career, with the last coming on June 22, 2021, when he was with Great Lakes in the Dodgers' organization. Taylor's 53 RBI on the season lead the Eastern League and all of Double-A. His other Eastern League ranks are: 5th AVG (.298), 5th OBP (.388), 3rd SLG (.515) and 2nd OPS (.903).

#### Carlos De La Crushed

Carlos De La Cruz continued his mid-season turnaround with two hits and a run scored in Tuesday's win. After hitting just a combined .213 through April and May, De La Cruz has been impressive in June. For the month, he is slashing .298/.385/.571, with a .956 OPS. De La Cruz has added 20 runs, five doubles, six home runs and 15 RBI on the month. He's struck out just 26 times in 96 plate appearances, after striking out 36 times in 89 plate appearances in May. He sits third on Reading in home runs at eight on the season.

#### Bombs Away

After hitting another home run on Wednesday night, Reading has set a season-high with home runs in 11 games in a row. This comes after also hitting home runs in seven-straight games from June 4-11. The only game since June 4 Reading has not hit a home run in was June 12, so they have homered in 18-of-19 games. The 11-game home run streak is Reading's longest such streak since homering in 11-straight games from July 30-August 11 of last season. The last time Reading homered in 12-straight games was from Aug. 10-23, of the 2018 season.

#### **Pitching Powers**

Last week, was a strong week for Fightin Phils pitching, as they posted a 3.20 ERA for the week, which was tied for fourth in the Eastern League. Much of the success came via control, as Reading pitchers have issued just eight walks, dating back to June 18. That mark is not just the lowest in the Eastern League and Double-A, but in all of Minor League baseball for that span.

#### This Day in Baseballtown History

June 27, 2004: At Harrisburg, Ryan Howard goes 3-for-5 with two HR and five RBI for the second straight game, but Reading falls to the Senators, 12-11, in 11 innings. It is Howard's sixth multi-HR game of the year and third in four days. Kevin Barker has his second five-hit game in six days, going 5-for-6 with three doubles, a home run, three RBI and three runs.

#### The Book on Bowie

Bowie enters tonight after finishing in fifth place in the Eastern League's Southwest Divison for the first half with a 32-36 record. They are tied for second in the Southwest Division with a 1-1 record in the second half of the season. Bowie most recently dropped five-of-six at home against the Altoona Curve. Following this week, Bowie heads home for three against Richmond, then three at the Flying Squirrels. Bowie's roster features nine players ranked amongst the Baltimore Orioles' top-30 prospects: Samuel Basallo (2), Dylan Beavers (7), Seth Johnson (10), Jud Fabian (12), Max Wagner (14), Trace Bright (16), John Rhodes (23), Alex Pham (24) and Frederick Benscome (27).

#### On the Mound for Bowie

Righty, and Orioles' No. 10 Prospect, Seth Johnson makes the start tonight for Bowie. This season, Johnson is 0-5, with a 3.07 ERA over 13 starts (44 IP, 36 H, 30 BB, 48 BB). Johnson last started against Altoona on June 21, and lasted just 0.2 innings, in a loss. He allowed two runs and walked four batters, while facing just six batters. Johnson did not face Reading when the teams played in early April. Johnson made just five starts in 2023 between four levels in the Orioles' system, going 0-1, with a 4.35 ERA. Johnson was limited to five starts in 2022 as he had Tommy John Surgery in August of 2022. Johnson was drafted by the Tampa Bay Rays in the CB-A Round in 2019 and was traded to the Orioles in August of 2022.
