RAMIREZ HOMERS IN JUMBO SHRIMP 6-4 WIN

Thanks to six combined hits from **Agustín Ramirez** and **Forrest Wall**, the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp beat the Toledo Mud Hens 6-3 Thursday night. Jacksonville jumped out to an early lead in the second. **Troy Johnston** and **Deyvison De Los Santos** knocked consecutive singles and **Tristan Gray** walked. Ramirez swatted a two-run double for a 2-0 lead. The Mud Hens plated one run in the bottom of the second but the Jumbo Shrimp sent nine men to the plate in the sixth and scored four runs for a commanding 6-1 lead. Toledo added two in the ninth but the rally ended, 6-3.

ROCKET MAN

At just 21 years old, **Deyvison De Los Santos** has had a monstrous 2024 season between Jacksonville, Triple-A Reno and Double-A Amarillo. Currently, De Los Santos leads all of full season MiLB in home runs (31), RBIs (91) and slugging (.626). He ranks second in both total bases (238) and OPS (1.005), sixth in hits (122) and fourth in extra-base hits (52). Of the top 100 exit velos in the minors in 2024, the Dominican has hit four of them, trailing **Jhonkensy Noel** (6x), **Orelvis Martinez** (6x) and **Pedro León** (5x).

IT'S TEARIN' UP MY START WHEN I'M WITH YOU

In 2005, Jacksonville starting pitchers ranked just 25th in Double-A with 741.0 innings, which represented 60.6 percent of the club's 1223.2 innings. This season, the Jumbo Shrimp's starting rotation has worked 51.3 percent of the club's innings, a total of 487.0 out of 949.2 frames. That figure is the ninth-most in Triple-A. Jacksonville lid-lifters are ranked third in ERA (4.62) while ranking tied for fourth in WHIP (1.39), eighth in BAA (2.59), ninth in OPS against (.781) and ninth in walks (195).

ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp have struggled this season at 121 Financial Ballpark, mustering a meager 24-32 (.429) record. Jacksonville has scored only 236 runs at home (4.2 per game), tied for the fewest in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp are scoring more than a half-run more per game on the road, totaling 253 (4.8 per game). Meanwhile, on the road, Jacksonville has surrendered only 230 runs (4.3 per game), the second-fewest in Triple-A. They've yielded the 12th-fewest runs of any team at home (4.9 per game).

GET PITCH OR DIE TRYIN'

Jacksonville has gone 28-21 (.571) in their last 49 contests, mainly behind some dominant pitching and defense. During this span, the Jumbo Shrimp have ceded four runs or fewer in 31 of those 49 affairs (63.3 percent). Since this run began on June 7, Jacksonville leads all of Triple-A in fewest runs allowed (197) and ERA (3.91) while ranking third in WHIP (1.37), fourth in BAA (.247), sixth in OPS against (.741) and fourth in hits allowed (385), respectively.

SOULJA TROY

Heading into play on May 25, **Troy Johnston**, the reigning Marlins Minor League Player of the Year, was hitting just .240/.294/.316/.610 with only 12 doubles, one home run, 21 RBIs, nine walks and 16 runs scored in 48 games. However, over the last 60 contests, the Puyallup, Wash., native is a sizzling 70-for-226, slashing .310/.378/.491/.869 with 14 doubles, three triples, seven homers, 31 RBIs, 22 walks and 40 runs scored. Johnston has 18 multi-hit games in his last 41 contests and is ranked tied for first in the IL in hits (117) while also ranking third in doubles (26) and 23rd in batting average (.277).

LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, Javier Sanoja was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 65 of his last 76 games, notching 26 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 93-for-297 (.313/.383/.471/.854) with 21 doubles, four triples, six home runs, 43 RBIs, 35 walks and 39 runs scored. On the season, Sanoja ranks ninth in batting average (.295), tied for eighth in doubles (23) and ranked 11th in hits (99).

SHRIMP BITES

The Jumbo Shrimp have scored at least four runs in 13 of the last 16 games after doing so just three times in the previous 10 contests... With his win last night, Adam Oller is 3-0 with a 2.75 ERA with the Jumbo Shrimp. In 19.2 innings, he's struck out 18 and holding opponents to a mere .186 batting average against... Jacksonville has dropped six of their last 10 games. This stretch comes on the heels of seven victories in eight contests.

ABOUT ADAM

-Mazur was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the second round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Iowa. He made his major league debut for the Padres on June 4, 2024, tossing 6.0 innings of one-run ball at the Los Angeles Angels. Mazur was later included in the July 30 trade along with left-hander Robby Snelling and infielders Graham Pauley and Jay Beshears in exchange for left-hander Tanner Scott and right-hander Bryan Hoeing.

-Mazur began his collegiate career at South Dakota State University before transferring to Iowa. He made 15 starts for the Hawkeyes in 2022, going 7-3 with a $3.07\,\mathrm{ERA}$. Over 93.2 innings, he yielded only 60 hits and 30 walks while striking out 98 to earn Big Ten Pitcher of the Year honors. His 98 strikeouts ranks as the fourthmost in a single-season in program history, and he ranked eighth nationally in hits allowed per nine innings (5.8).

-When he made his MLB debut on June 4, 2024, Mazur became the fourth former Hawkeye to pitch in a big league game since 2000, joining Wes Obermueller (2002), Matt Dermody (2016) and Nick Allgeyer (2021).

-As a second-round pick (53rd overall), Mazur was the highest-drafted Hawkeye since Tim Costo was picked eighth overall by Cleveland in 1990.

-Mazur is an alumnus of Woodbury High School in Woodbury, Minn, where he was a finalist for the Minnesota Mr. Baseball Award. He was high school teammates with former Jacksonville and current Miami Marlins right-hander Max Meyer.

In addition to his baseball prowess growing up, Mazur earned four letters in basketball and two in football.

-The youngest of three boys, Adam's older brother Brandon played college baseball at Grand View.

2024 SEASON

-Mazur began the season with Double-A San Antonio before earning a promotion to Triple-A El Paso. He had his contract selected by San Diego on June 4 and made his major league debut that night against the Angels.

2023 SEASON

-In 174 plate appearances, Mazur held right-handed hitters to a .208/.236/.286/.522 line compared to a .298/.332/.418/.750 batting line in 220 plate appearances for left-handed hitters.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-As a senior at Woodbury High School, Mazur compiled a 0.58 ERA with 112 strikeouts and only 12 walks in 72.1 innings. He also played shortstop, batting .377 with five doubles, one home run and 40 RBIs.
