SUNDAY: The Amarillo Sod Poodles (24-21, 60-53) fell to the Midland RockHounds (22-23, 54-59), 14-0, on Sunday afternoon at HODGETOWN. Casey Yamauchi belted the first pitch of the game from **Brian Curley** over the left field fence for a solo homer. Yamauchi struck again with a three-run blast to extend the visitor's advantage to four. Midland added insult to injury in the third with a six-run inning that featured two-run homers from Clark Elliott and Justin Riemer pushing Midland's run total for the afternoon to double digits. Devin Taylor and Nankil added solo home runs in the fifth and Cameron Leary checked in with Midland's seventh home run of the day in the eighth, extending the lead to 14 runs. **Ben McLaughlin** roped a one-out double as a last-ditch effort to break the goose egg, but Midland pulled away with a 14-0 win in the series finale.

AOA-OK: Kicking off his Sod Poodles career on a six-game hit streak (8/11-c) is **Avery Owusu-Asiedu**...he is slashing .522/.586/1.304 over his first six games as a Soddie, posting a 1.890 OPS so far with the club...his five home runs last week were matched only by Jordan Lawlar (5) and Midland's Luke Mann (6) for most in the Texas League.

GRAN TORIN-O: Since August 11, **Cristofer Torin** is batting .500 (11x22) with 7 runs scored, a double, 2 home runs, 6 RBI and a 1.340 OPS...his performance on Saturday night made him the second Sod Poodle to collect five hits in a game this year, matching Manuel Pena's output on April 16 against Frisco...Amarillo and Northwest Arkansas are the only two teams in the Texas League to have two separate five-hit performances this season.

I'M McLAUGHLIN IT: Over 13 August games, **Ben McLaughlin** is batting .296 (16x54) with 5 doubles, a home run, and a .789 OPS...he ranks 3rd on the team in hits (98) and RBI (56) this season.

HERE'S THE DRILL: Among active Sod Poodles, **Drew Jones** enters play with the most hits against the Drillers this season (6), batting .333 against Tulsa over the six-game series at HODGETOWN in early June.

HOMERING IS CONTAGIOUS: Since 2005, Amarillo is the only team in the Texas League to have gone deep three or more times in five consecutive games, doing so from 8/11-8/15 last week...38 total homers were hit between Midland and Amarillo over the six-game set, the most in any series the Soddies have been part of this year.

FOREVER YOUNGBLOOD: Over his most recent eight games (8/8-c), **Trent Youngblood** is batting .313 (10x32) with an .884 OPS...he collected an inside-the-park home run on Saturday night, the first ITP homer by a Sod Poodle since Jordan Lawlar (7/3/23 vs. TUL).

LUIS YOURSELF: Despite a hitless effort on Sunday, **Jansel Luis** still leads Sod Poodles in hits this season (110), a mark that currently ranks tied for 5th in the Texas League...he is pacing to finish the year with 133 knocks which would rank as the 5th-most by a Sod Poodle in a single season in club history.

WINNING WAYS: Since July 5, the Sod Poodles are 20-14, topping the Texas League over that span...the record also ranks tied for 4th in Double-A baseball over this timeframe.

DOWN IN THE DESERT: Former Soddie Yu-Min Lin tossed five one-hit innings in Triple-A Reno's 4-3 loss on Sunday afternoon...he has struck out at least four batters in each of his most recent five starts.

SUMMARY

- ▶ Is currently ranked the No. 15 Diamondbacks prospect by MLB Pipeline.
- ▶ Was traded along with RHP Kade Strowd and 2B José Mejía to the Diamondbacks from Baltimore on February 5, 2026.
- ▶ Was traded along with RHP Cameron foster to the Orioles in exchange for LHP Gregory Soto on July 25, 2025.
- ▶ Signed with the New York Mets as an international free agent on January 15, 2022... agreed to at \$70,000 signing bonus... named a DSL Mid-Season All-Star during the 2023 season while pitching for the club.

LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ Aracena made his Double-A debut as the starting pitcher, but was not helped by his defense in his second time through the RockHounds order...after a leadoff double by nine-hitter Cameron Leary in the third inning, an errant throw by Cristofer Torin put runners on the corners with none out...an RBI single by Devin Taylor and sacrifice fly by Euriel Angeles to tie the game followed...Davis Diaz laced another extra-base hit over the head of Drew Jones in right field for two bases, which allowed Nate Nankil to put the RockHounds ahead with a base hit to left field to plate Diaz.
- ▶ Aracena's struggles would continue in his first taste of Double-A action, as Leary hit a two-run homer to tie the game at 5-5 in the top of the fourth...it was the first home run hit by a left-handed hitter off him this season.
- ▶ More damage continued to be done as a sequence of a walk, wild pitch, and bloop single off the bat of Angeles put the RockHounds back in front.
- ▶ Took home a no decision as the Soddiess tied the game in the bottom of the eighth but ultimately lost 11-10 in extra innings.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Was a two-time NWL Pitcher of the Week this season, most recently winning the award on August 9...his first award came on June 14.
- ▶ Struck out a season-high nine batters on June 11 vs. Tri-City...turned in his first quality start and earned his first win with the Hops after tossing 6.0 shutout innings.
- ▶ Tossed his second quality start of the season on July 18 while visiting the Dust Devils...took the loss in despite allowing just three runs across six full frames.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Aracena did not allow a home run for the entire 2025 season, leading all minor league pitchers who did not surrender a long ball in innings pitched with (92.0)... became just the sixth pitcher since 2015 pitching in either Single-A or High-A to not allow a home run while logging at least 90.0 innings pitched in a season.
- ▶ Was the Florida State League Pitcher of the Month for June 2025 after going 1-1 with a 1.13 ERA in 24.0 IP...won FSL Pitcher of the Week awards twice that month, first on June 1 and later on June 22.
- ▶ Named an FSL Post-Season All-Star.

SCOUTING REPORT

- ▶ His fastball grades as his best pitch, sitting 96-99 mph with his four-seam fastball and topping out at 101.
- ▶ Throws a cutter at 92-94 mph with significant glove-side run while also offering an upper-80s slider.
- ▶ The repertoire can include as many as six pitches, with him also developing a curveball while sparingly throwing a two-seam fastball and changeup.

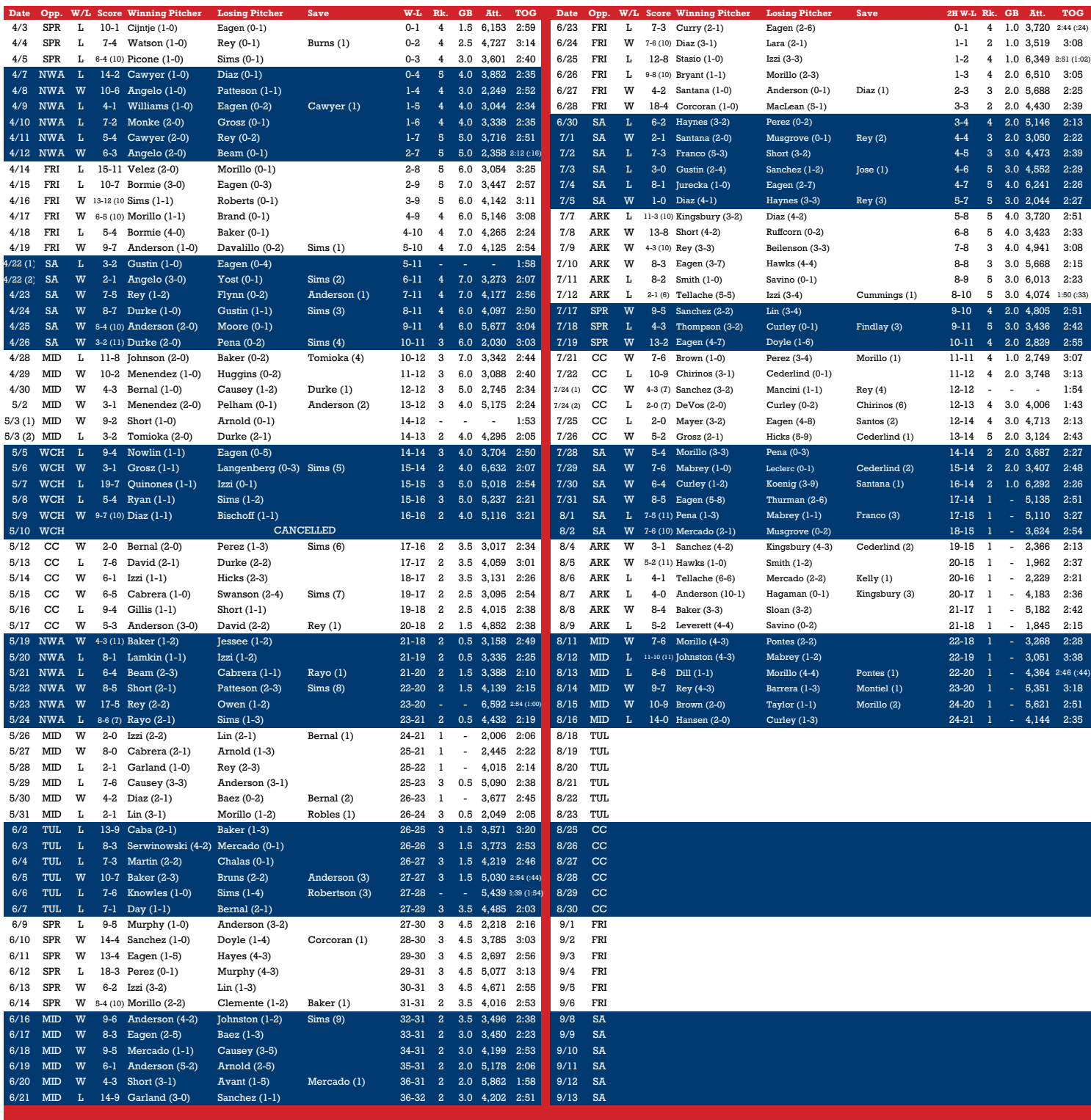
