## Sacramento River Cats (19-16) vs. Reno Aces (19-18)

RHP Blade Tidwell (0-0, 11.25) vs. LHP Kohl Drake (1-3, 8.78)

**RENOED:** Sacramento lost last night's game, 1-2, and they are now 6-5 in one-run games and 4-1 in one-run games at home this season...marked the eighth time they have recorded 10-or-more strikeouts in a game; they are now 6-2 in such games...Carson Whisenhunt was the starter but did not factor into the decision...allowed one run on four hits with two walks and a season-high-tying eight strikeouts in 5.0 innings...Whisenhunt's 43 strikeouts are the most pitch a PCL pitcher, and T-5th most by a Triple-A pitcher...he also is one of five Triple-A pitchers to have at least three games with eight-or-more strikeouts...Wilkin Ramos was dealt the loss, his first of the season and first since August 31, 2025...allowed one run on three hits with one strikeout in 2.0 innings...Jake Holton (2-for-4) knocked his third home run of the season, a solo-shot in the second to put Sacramento first on the board...the ball traveled 418 feet, tied for the fourth-longest by a River Cat this season...marked his fifth multi-hit game of the night.

**THEY'RE LAUGHING DRAWIN' ACES:** The River Cats won Thursday's game, 6-3, collecting their first back-to-back wins since April 23 and 24 vs. Albuquerque...they are now 11-5 at home, 16-7 when scoring first and 6-5 against left-handed starters...recorded double-digit hits for the 17th time this season, they are 12-5 in such games...John Michael Bertrand was the starter and earned his third-consecutive win...allowed three runs on seven hits (1 HR) with one walk and no strikeouts in 6.1 innings of work...6.1 innings marked the most by a Sacramento pitchers this season...was the first time in his career Bertrand has not recorded a strikeout in an outing...he is the only PCL pitcher and one of three Triple-A pitchers to earn three-straight winning decisions...Michael Fulmer earned the save, his fourth of the season, tying him with Alex Hoppe for most in the PCL...is also now T-2nd in Triple-A in saves, behind Eric Cerantola (5)...threw 1.0 scoreless inning, allowing one hit and fanning one batter...see more on the Kitties' four-homer night below. vvv

**KNOCK KNOCK:** River Cats batters hit four total home runs on Thursday, tying their season high (also, April 29 at Salt Lake)...the Cats had four games last season where the knocked four-or-more home runs...the second (Susac, 421 feet), fourth (Kennedy, 418 feet) and fifth (Susac, 409 feet) longest home runs by River Cats batters were all hit last night.

- ▶ Harrison Bader (MLR) (1-for-4) knocked his second home run of the season (also, March 30 with San Francisco), a leadoff solo-shot off the first pitch to left-center field...it was the second leadoff homer for the River Cats this season (also, Nate Furman, April 25 vs. ABQ), as well as Bader's eighth leadoff homer of his career and first since October 2, 2021 with St. Louis...was also the fourth leadoff homer on the first pitch in the PCL this season...was Bader's fourth leadoff blast on the first pitch in his career, with all three others occurring in 2016 with the Double-A Springfield Cardinals, most recently May 10, 2016.
- ▶ Daniel Susac (MLR) (3-for-4) hit his first home run of the year (and first since August 31, 2025), a two-run, 409-foot shot to left center field in the third inning...marked the third-longest homer by a River Cat this season...followed that up with a second homer in the fifth, making him the second River Cat this season to have a multi-homer game (also, Bryce Eldridge, April 29 at Salt Lake)...Susac had two multi-homer games in 2025 with Las Vegas, most recently on June 10 vs. Salt Lake...marked his fifth multi-hit game of the season, and third three-hit game.
- ▶ Buddy Kennedy (2-for-4) hit his third home run of the year directly after Susac, marking the first back-to-back home runs for the River Cats since June 17, 2025 when Bryce Eldridge and Marco Luciano had back-to-back knocks...also was Kennedy's first time homering in back-to-back games since May 14-17, 2025 when he homered in four-consecutive games...also hit an RBI double in the seventh, his third multi-extra-base-hit game of the season...marked his 11th multi-hit game of the year, tying him with Eldridge and Victor Bericoto for most on the team.

**DARTH BADER:** Outfielder Harrison Bader joined the River Cats on a rehab assignment on Tuesday after being placed on the 10-day IL on April 12 due to a left hamstring strain...in three games in Sacramento he has gone 2-for-10 with one home run, one RBI, one walk and three strikeouts...was hit by a pitch on the left arm/wrist in the sixth inning yesterday, his first time being plunked since September 10 with Philadelphia.

**SU-SACRAMENTO:** Catcher Daniel Susac also joined Sacramento on a rehab assignment on Thursday...Susac was placed on the 10-day IL on April 21 (retroactive to April 20) due to right elbow ulnar neuritis...in 11 games with the Giants this season, Susac was batting a team-leading .478 (11-for-23) with two doubles, one triple, five RBI, one walk and a 1.152 OPS.

**SPRING INTO ACTION:** The River Cats batted .282 over 24 games in the month of April...they hit 42 doubles, three triples, 24 home runs, 136 RBI, drew 96 walks, and struck out 175 times...they had a .367 on-base percentage and a .434 slugging percentage, totaling an .801 OPS...last season, the Cats batted .241 in the month of April with a .338 OBP and .363 SLG for a total .701 OPS...below are players who batted particularly well last month:

**CUTTING EDGE:** Right-hander Blade Tidwell will start for the River Cats for the first time since March 29...last pitched 1.1 innings of relief on May 3 at Salt Lake where he allowed five runs on two hits, with two walks and one strikeout...Tidwell gave up five-plus runs in two games in 2025, one being a relief appearance with Triple-A Syracuse...was recalled to San Francisco on April 2...made eight relief appearances with the Giants where he posted a 3.00 ERA (12.0 IP, 4 ER) with three walks, 10 strikeouts and a .233 opponent batting average...was optioned back to Sacramento on April 29...in 21 games (17 starts) in Triple-A last season between Syracuse and Sacramento, he posted a 3.62 ERA (97.0 IP, 39 ER) with 27 walks, 111 strikeouts and a .218 opponent batting average.

**BOYS IN THE BIGS:** Catcher Logan Porter had his contract selected by San Francisco this afternoon...in four games with the Giants last year, Porter batted .143 (1-for-7) with one RBI, one walk and two strikeouts...RHP Trevor McDonald was also recalled for the third time this season...four other Cats batters are currently playing on the major league roster, here is a look at their stats so far this season:
