OKLAHOMA CITY COMETS (38-28) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (30-35)

RHP Justin Jarvis (3-2, 6.55) vs. RHP Andrew Quezada (0-2, 7.08)

TODAY'S GAME: The Isotopes hold a 2-1 series advantage after a 9-8 walk-off triumph last night ... The club is 11-7 in their last 18 contests ... Andrew Quezada is expected to start for the Isotopes while Justin Jarvis is slated to take the hill for the Comets.

BROADCAST: Tonight's and Saturday's Isotopes game will air on True Crime Network, which can be found on channel 7.3 throughout the state of New Mexico and locally on Xfinity 387 and Sparklight 29.

SERIES: With the win last night, the Isotopes have a 2-1 series advantage for the third-straight series.

WALK-OFF: The walk-off Thursday is Albuquerque's seventh walk-off victory of the year (last: May 17 vs. Tacoma, 7-6, wild pitch) ... It's the second time in Isotopes history the club has recorded seven walk-off wins by June 12 (other: 2011, seven by June 10)

-It's the 11th all-time walk-off against the Comets and first since June 1, 2024, a 10-9 victory after an error.

ONE-RUN GAMES: The Isotopes improved to 12-11 in one-run games and 8-3 at home. The club has won three of their last four one-run games.

VS. OKC: Eight of the nine meetings between the Isotopes and Comets this season have been decided by three runs or fewer with six one-run games.

DINGERS: Albuquerque swatted four dingers last night, the sixth time in 2025 with at least four clouts and the fifth time with four (last: June 6 at El Paso). It's also the fourth time the Isotopes recorded a homer with no doubles or triples (last: May 7 at Oklahoma City.

HITS: The Isotopes have recorded 16 hits in two of their last three games.

SWIPES: Albuquerque stole three bases last night, just the fifth time this year with at least three swipes in a game (last: May 24 at Reno. three).

PUNCHOUTS: The Isotopes struck out 14 times last night, tying the season-high set Wednesday. The club has tallied double-digit strikeouts in four of their last five games.

XBH: Albuquerque allowed seven extra-base hits Thursday, tied for the second-most in a game this season (also: April 16 vs. El BIG MIKE: Michael Toglia connected on two homers yesterday (solo and two-run), the 12th multi-homer game for the Isotopes this season (last: Sterlin Thompson, June 6 at El Paso). It's Toglia's fifth multi-homer game with Albuquerque (others: August 27, 2022, vs. Round Rock, three; June 28, 2023, vs. El Paso; May 8, 2024, at El Paso; and June 1, 2024, vs. Oklahoma City).

-Seventh Isotope to record five-plus multi-homer games (others: Brett Carroll, Joe Dillon, Matt Padget and Jordan Patterson have six while Mike Colangelo and Pat Valaika have five).

-Tallied three hits Thursday, his second three-hit game in his last three contests and fourth multi-hit game on the year (nine games). Has recorded an RBI in five-straight contests (13 total). Has a hit in six of nine games played while reaching base in eight.

STERLIN: Sterlin Thompson registered three knocks last night, including his eighth dinger of the year, for his third game with at least three hits and 14th multi-hit game in 2025 ... Has an eightgame hit streak (13x30 with two double, three homers and six RBI). Has three homers in his last six games.

-Slashing .400/.505/.733 with eight doubles, two triples, six homers and 18 RBI over his last 24 contests, with 11 multi-hit performances ... Has 12 hit-by-pitch this season, second-most in Triple-A

MILLER TIME: Owen Miller recorded his third-straight multi-hit contest last night and 10th on the year ... Extended hit streak to eight games (15x36 with three doubles, two homers and six RBI).

AMADOR: Adael Amador went 3-for-5 Thursday with a three-run homer, his fourth on the year, to extend his hit streak to eight games (13x32 with two doubles, two homers and seven RBI). Tallied first three-hit game of 2025 and seventh multi-hit game of fourth is in the test encoded for the test encoded for the integration. year and fourth in his last six games ... Has at least one hit in 18 of 21 Triple-A contests in 2025.

WARMIN' UP: Warming Bernabel recorded his third three-hit game of the year last night to extend his hit streak to eight games (14x29 with a double, homer and four RBI) ... Last night was his fourth walk-off hit of his career (last: May 29, 2024, two-run single)

-Posted a .397/.449/.551 slash line with six doubles, two homers and 11 RBI in his last 20 contests, raising his batting average from .258 to .312 in the span.

NUCLEI NOTES

SKIPPER: Pedro Lopez enters his 21st year as a minor league manager and third guiding the Isotopes. He is the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1 ... Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his third season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five seasons with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his second year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... The former outfielder played in 33 games for the Isotopes and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

AARON MUNOZ: Takes over as Isotopes hitting coach after Jordan Pacheco was named one of two new hitting coaches for the Colorado Rockies on May 12 ... Began the 2025 season as the hitting coach for the ACL Rockies ... Spent nine seasons (2016-2024) as the Rockies bullpen catcher ... Was Isotopes bullpen catcher in 2015 ... Originally drafted by the Blue Jays in the 34th round of the MLB Draft ... Played parts of four seasons in the Minor Leagues (2011-14), making it to Double-A.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the third-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 22) will host the second half winner (beginning June 24) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, on September 27.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Challenge System, in it's third full year in the PCL, will be used exclusively for every game this season. Under this system, the home plate umpire will call balls or strikes while each team has the opportunity to challenge the umpire's call with two challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
