TONIGHT'S GAME: Happy Opening Day and welcome to LoanMart Field for the opening game of a three-game set between the Lake Elsinore Storm (SD) and your Rancho Cucamonga Quakes (LAD). Tonight's opener will feature Magnet Schedule Giveaway and post-game Fireworks, thanks to Tam's Burgers! The Quakes are home through Sunday and hit the road on Tuesday to Stockton before returning on Tuesday, April 15th. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE STORM: Today's game is the first of 24 head-to-head games, with 15 of those taking place here at LoanMart Field. Last season, the Quakes went just 10-20 against the Storm, 7-8 here at home.

LAST SEASON: Rancho finished the second half at 35-31 to end the year at 65-65 overall. The Quakes missed the playoffs last year, while the Modesto Nuts were eventually crowned Cal League Champions, their second consecutive league title, besting the Lake Elsinore Storm 2-1 in the best-of-three Championship Series.

STILL WEARING THE SAME SHOE: The Quakes are excited to welcome back Manager John Shoemaker, who returns to Rancho to guide the Quakes for a fifth straight year, a franchise record. The club is 271-243 in four seasons under "Shoe", having made the playoffs twice, including one appearance in the Championship Series (2023). The Quakes have only one returning coach to this year's club, as pitching coach Ramon Troncoso returns to Rancho, joining Shoemaker for his fifth year as well. New members of the coaching staff include hitting coach Johermyn Chavez, pitching coach Brandon Bailey, Bench Coach Dunior Zerpa, Bullpen Coach and former Quake Marco Hernandez, Athletic Trainer Alfredo Casillas, Performance Coach Jake Taylor and Video Associate Max Delorme.

TEAM LEADERS: With the season coming to an end today, let's look at the team leaders going into the final day of the 2024 season. Cameron Decker's cranked a team-best 12 home runs. Wilman Diaz had 54 RBIs to lead the team, with Decker at 53 and Samuel Munoz at 50. Kendall George was the top base-stealer with 36. Carlos Rojas' .290 average was the highest average on the club, but he technically didn't have enough plate appearances to qualify for the league's top-10. On the pitching side, Sean Paul Linan and reliever Felix Cabrera each had six wins (tied for seventh in the league). Roque Gutierrez led the team in strikeouts with 118 (fifth in the league). Cam Day's ERA of 4.68 was tops on the team and fifth in the league, while his innings pitched of 102.0 was seventh in the league. Noah Ruen's seven saves were fifth in the league.

PROSPECT HEAVY: According to MLB Pipeline's rankings the Dodgers have stocked the Quakes with seven of their top-30 prospects. In order, they are: INF Kellon Lindsey (#8), OF Eduardo Quintero (#9), INF Joendry Vargas (#12), RHP Hyun-Seok Jang (#17), OF Mike Sirota (#21), OF Jaron Elkins and RHP Samuel Sanchez (#28). Of the 29 active players on the Rancho roster, 15 of them saw time in a Quakes' uniform in 2024.

HYUN-SEOK JANG: Right-hander Hyun-Seok Jang makes his first start of the year and his sixth start in a Rancho uniform in his career. Jang went 1-2 with an 8.14 ERA over 13 games (10 starts) and 24.1 innings pitched in the ACL last year, before finishing the year with five starts in Rancho, where he went 0-1 with a 2.19 ERA over 12 innings pitched. Jang, who signed with the Dodgers in August of 2023 out of South Korea, was regarded as the top pitching prospect coming out of Korea in 2023 and is rated by MLB Pipeline as the Dodgers' 17th best prospect.

MAIKEL MIRRALES: Righty Maikel Mirrales makes his 2025 debut and his sixth career start for the Storm. In 2024, he split time between the Arizona Complex League (1-2, 4.20 ERA, 11 G) and the Storm (1-3, 5.30, 16 G, 5 GS). Mirrales signed with San Diego in January of 2023 out of Maracay, Venezuela.
