

Who it's for: Groups wanting an easy, allinclusive meal + game experience. For groups of 25 to over 4000 guests!

Pricing: Picnics include two costs, group tickets + catering. Tickets are \$11 for 200-level and \$16 for 100-level. Meal packages range from \$23-\$28 per person. There is no rental fee for the picnic venue.



Step 1: Select a Game and Picnic Venue and Contact your Group Sales Rep

Please call or email your group sales rep to check availability and choose a venue.



Step 2: Provide Ticket Deposit Payment

Tickets and catering are paid in two separate bills. For events of 50-250 guests, there is a non-refundable \$500 deposit required. For events above 250 guests, 50% of the cost of the tickets is due upon booking. The minimum deposit for the Jack Daniels 10th Inning Bar is \$250. The easiest way to pay is with a credit card over the phone. The remaining balance will automatically charge **10 days prior** to the game.



Step 3: Catering

Once the event is booked, expect correspondence from our catering team to discuss menu selection and any add-ons/substitutions. Questions regarding catering should be directed to Megan Ridings at mridings@redwingsbaseball.com or 454-1001 ext. 3034.



Step 4: Finalize Numbers and Payment

Contact Megan with your final headcount and catering payment **no later than 10 business days (2 weeks) prior** to your event. Once Megan has the final headcount, the remaining balance for your tickets will be charged as well.



Step 5: Ticket Distribution

Tickets and picnic passes can be picked up at the box office once they are paid for. Other options include mail delivery (for an extra fee), or the Red Wings will provide a Will Call table, which must be staffed by your group, for guests to pick up tickets.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When is the picnic area available?

Picnics are available when gates open. Gates typically open at 5:00pm for a 6:05pm start, 5:30pm for a 6:45pm start, and 12:00pm for a 1:05pm start. Check redwingsbaseball.com for gate times to ensure there is not an exception on the day of your event. For special arrangements, contact Megan Ridings at mridings@redwingsbaseball.com

What if it rains?

All picnics are rain or shine. If the game is rained out before 5 complete innings, guests can use their game ticket as a rain check for another game. Rain tickets must be redeemed at the box office.

Can I buy parking passes for our guests?

Yes, contact your group sales rep to purchase physical parking passes. Please note: parking passes are not digital, and must be distributed.

Can I bring in outside food/beverages?

Outside food and beverages are not allowed.

Can I buy more game tickets than picnic passes?

The number of picnic passes must equal the number of game tickets.

Is this eligible for Red Wings Rewards points?

Yes. Contact your group sales rep for details.

Is catering required?

Yes, you would need to purchase a picnic pass/menu for each of your guests. A catering representative will go over minimums, menu selections, and additional information.

Are there discounts for kids?

Children **3 and under** do not need a game ticket, unless they require their own seat. Everyone 4 and older needs a game ticket. Picnic passes are 50% off for kids 4-12, while those 3 and under eat free.
