ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Two costly two-out errors by Indianapolis turned an early lead into a deficit, and the St. Paul Saints ran away from the Indians with a 12-4 triumph on Saturday night at Victory Field. It was Indianapolis' first loss after compiling four consecutive wins during the homestand. Indianapolis led by a run heading into the fourth, but the floodgates opened for St. Paul on consecutive throwing errors by third baseman Malcom Nuñez and Matt Gorski that gave the visitors a 2-1 advantage. The Saints tacked on two more runs in the fifth, five in the sixth and three in the eighth to build a 12-1 lead. Yoyner Faiardo blasted his third homer of the year to finish the Saints' scoring. The Indians plated three runs in the bottom of the ninth – two coming on a Carter Bins line-drive double – but a double play erased any further threat.

NO DOUBTING THE DOUBLES: The Indians' 49 doubles are tied with Albuquerque for the most among all 30 Triple-A teams this season. In addition to leading the International League, Nick Gonzales is currently leading the pack among all Triple-A teams with two more doubles than anyone else. The Indians as a team are also hitting .277 (180-for-649), good for the third-best batting average in all of Triple-A behind Durham (.290, 205-for-707) and Reno (.282, 191-for-677), and rank eighth among teams in hits.

THE SIX-GAME SET: Since converting to the new six-game series format in 2021, the Indians have never swept their opponent. Friday marked the first time they had won the first four games of any series, home or away. The closest they have gotten to going 4-0 to start a series was when they went 3-0 from 6/15-17/21 vs. Memphis. The Indians have gone 5-1 six times since 2021, never against St. Paul. All of those instances are listed below:

PLASSMEYER & PAUL: Paul Skenes (2nd, 27) and Michael Plassmeyer (T-3rd, 26) represent Indians pitching on the International League strikeout leaderboard after their respective starts this week. Last night, Plassmeyer fanned five across 4.0 innings, with both his unearned runs allowed coming following consecutive costly errors in the fourth inning. Plassmeyer fanned 14 runs in his first two starts (9.0ip) and has struck out 12 in his last three (10.2ip). On Thursday, Skenes logged his second outing of a career-high eight strikeouts.

NUÑEZ'S KNOCKS: Malcom Nuñez had his five-game hitting streak snapped last night, but walked in the seventh and was hit by a pitch in the ninth to score a late run for the Indians in the final frame. His RBI streak of four games was also snapped one game shy of tying his team-leading five-game RBI streak from 3/31-4/6 (1). Entering last night, he had hit safely in his last five games with five extra-base hits and six RBI. In April, he has reached base safely in 13 of 15 games with a .327 batting average (16-for-49), six doubles, two homers and 11 RBI.

NO. 28 FOR TWO: Carter Bins has joined Nick Gonzales in the doubles parade as of late, roping two-baggers in three of his last four games. Last night, he doubled in the ninth to score a pair in the Indians three-run frame. In his last four games, he is 6-for-15 with three doubles and three RBI. Bins has appeared in 12 April games for the Indians, hitting .294 (10-for-34) with two runs, four doubles and five RBI.

NICKY G LEADS THE LEAGUE: Nick Gonzales went 2-for-5 with a run and RBI double on Saturday night to extend his league-leading on-base streak to a career-high 18 games dating back to Opening Day on 3/29. His current 18-gamer narrowly beats his previous career-high of 15 games from 4/9-30/22 with Double-A Altoona. His fifth-inning double not only extends his hitting streak to 11 games dating back to 4/6, but was his 11th in just 18 games this season to extend his lead over the International League. Gonzales has been on fire with two more doubles than anyone else. Nine of his 18 games have featured multi-hit performances, and he currently leads IL leaders in hits (T-1st, 29) and doubles while also ranking in extra-base hits (T-4th, 13), batting average (2nd, .387), runs (2nd, 19) and total bases (6th, 45).

TODAY: The Indianapolis Indians will look to win their fifth game of the six-game series vs. the St. Paul Saints this week. It is their first of three of three head-to-head series this season, two of which come at Victory Field (also: 8/13-18). Last season, the Saints narrowly edged the Indians, 10 wins to eight, with four wins coming in six games in Indianapolis. In a rematch of the series-opener in which Indianapolis emerged victorious, 10-6, RHP Eric Lauer (1-0, 3.21) will take the mound against RHP Randy Dobnak (1-2, 5.51). The Indians tagged Dobnak for five runs on six hits on Tuesday, handing him his third career loss against Indianapolis.

THIS DATE IN 2019: Indianapolis and Louisville were both held scoreless through the first nine innings before the teams traded runs in the 10th and the Indians plated one in the 11th for the 2-1 win. Right-hander Mitch Keller got the nod for the Indians and tossed 6.0 two-hit innings with eight strikeouts, while Bats starting pitcher Keury Mella tossed 7.0 four-hit innings and fanned seven. With no outs in the 11th and the bases loaded with the automatic runner and back-to-back walks, Eric Wood knocked a single through the infield for the walk-off win. It was the second consecutive extra-inning game of the series and Indianapolis' second walk-off in its last four games.

Eric Lauer: Right-hander Eric Lauer is set to make his second start of the week vs. St. Paul after leading the Indians to a series-opening victory on Tuesday.

Last Outing / Against the Saints: Lauer took the bump for the Indians on Tuesday in his only career outing vs. St. Paul and allowed four runs (two earned) in 3.2 innings. The game was tied, 4-4, through the top of the fourth before Indy took a lead it would not relinquish in the bottom half.

Lauer Power: Eric Lauer split the 2023 season between the Milwaukee Brewers, Triple-A Nashville Sounds and the ACL Brewers. ... He made 23 total appearances (19 starts) while having his season shortened by right-shoulder impingement.

Miscellaneous: Lauer was selected by San Diego in the 1st round (25th overall) of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Kent State. ... He had his contract first selected by the Padres on April 24, 2018 and made his MLB debut that night at Colorado. ... He was signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent on March 22, 2024.
