By the Numbers

Captains pitching boasts a 2.73 ERA since June 1, 2.73 the lowest in Minor League Baseball in that span.

The 2024 Captains already rank 7th in single-season franchise history with 144 stolen bases through just 80 games. The 2009 team, which stole a franchise-best 166 bases, stole 144 in 108 games.

Lake County leads the MWL and ranks 3rd in High-A with 425 425 runs (5.3 per game), its most through 80 games since the 2007 Captains scored 463 in this span.

CAPTAINS LOG

LAST TIME OUT: Lake County blanked Dayton 3-0 on Saturday at Classic Auto Group Park, earning its 7th shutout of the season to take t2 out of 3 games in the series.

HOME SWEET HOME: The Captains are 27-14 with a .659 win percentage at Classic Auto Group Park, 2nd in the MWL and 6th in MiLB. LC has won its last 6 home series with the last loss coming to Lansing on April 16-21

TUGBOAT STEERS A CAPTAINS WINNER: LHP Matt "Tugboat" Wilkinson earned his 2nd High-A victory, pitching 5 shutout innings, allowing 1 hit and striking out 8. Wilkinson still leads full season MiLB in K/9 (14.57) and K rate (41.7%).

JONAH IN JULY: OF Jonah Advincula hit an RBI single in the bottom of the 3rd and went 2-for-4 on Saturday. Advincula batted a team-best .348 (8-for-23) in 6 games against Dayton.

BE LIKE MAICK: 1B Maick Collado hit a 2-run home run, extending his homer streak to 3 games. Collado joins current Double-A Akron 1B/LF C.J. Kayfus (5/7-10) as the only Captains to homer in 3straight games this season.

MAGNUS THE GOOD: RHP Magnus Ellerts earned his 9th save in Saturday's win, tied with Quad Cities RHP Ben Sears for 1st in the MWL. Over his last 13 appearances, Ellerts is 2-0 with 6 saves, 0.64 ERA, 33 strikeouts and an opposing OPS of .328.

MOON LANDING: 3B Alex Mooney, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, is 1 of 2 players in MiLB with 10+ HR, 25+ XBH, and 30+ SB. Former Lansing Lugnut and current Double-A Midland Rockhound Henry Bolte are the only Minor Leaguers to reach that feat in 2024.

NGEL ON THE INFIELD: SS Angel Genao, MLB Pipeline's No. 11 Cleveland prospect, went 2-for-3 with 2 doubles on Saturday, ranking tied for 4th in MiLB with 24 doubles. Genao is 2nd in Single/High-A with 94 hits across ake County and Single-A Lynchburg, and is the only player in Minor League Baseball with a .330+ AVG, 30+ XBH, and 15+ SB this season.

ONE OF THESE NIGHTS: Lake County's 20 runs on July 5 versus Dayton were tied for the most in High-A this season, matched by Eugene's 20 at Tri-City on June 4. Friday night, the Captains tallied 4 franchise records and tied a franchise best with 12 runs in the

TRENDS & NOTABLES

INGLE'S HAT TRICK: C Cooper Ingle went 3-for-4 a solo HR and 4 RBI in Friday's 20-1 win, marking his team-best 8th 3-hit game and 4th 4-RBI game of the year. Ingle's .339 AVG and .956 OPS lead the Midwest League and are the 3rd-highest by a Captain (min. 200 PA) through a team's first 80 team games since 2005.

STARS AND STRIKES: Lake County leads the Midwest League with a 3.52 ERA, surrendering just 310 runs, tied 9th-fewest in MiLB. Captains starters lead the MWL with 395 strikeouts, while the bullpen leads the MWL with a 3.48 ERA.

THE BATTLE OF TRENTON: RHP Trenton Denholm (8-2) ranks tied for 3rd in the Midwest League in quality starts (7), 3rd in WHIP (1.04), 5th in ERA (3.26) and is 1 of 2 Midwest Leaguers to pitch a 7-inning complete game shutout (5/9 vs. Dayton). Denholm is the fastest Captains pitcher to win 8 games since at least 2005.

TRIPLE ENTENTE: INF Alex Mooney, OF Jonah Advincula and OF Guy **_ipscomb** are the 1st Captains trio to steal 20-plus bases in Lake County's irst 74 team games of a season since 2012. 4 Captains that stole 20-plus bags in 74 team games, 1 of them being current New York Mets SS and 4me MLB All-Star Francisco Lindor.

REAL STEAL: The Captains have stolen 144 bases through their first 80 games, their most through the 1st 80 games since at least 2005. *Lake* County ranks tied 2rd in MiLB with an 88.1% stolen base percentage.

NAVAL POWER: LHP Matt Wilkinson eclipsed 100 strikeouts on June 25 versus Great Lakes, and now ranks 3rd in MiLB with 116 strikeouts this season. Among Minor League pitchers with 70+ IP, Wilkinson's 14.57 K/9 are the highest through a team's first 80 games since current San Francisco LHP Kyle Harrison posted 15.01 K/9 with Double-A Richmond in 2022.

THE ATLANTIC CAMPAIGN: Since 2021, 11 of Cleveland's draft picks have come from the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC), including 6 in the 2023 MLB Draft. Of those 11 ACC draftees, 5 have played for the Captains his year (LHP Parker Messick, OF Angel Zarate, 1B/LF C.J. Kayfus, C Cooper Ingle, and INF Alex Mooney), with 5 total '23 draftees being Top 30 Cleveland prospects by MLB Pipeline.

PROSPECTING: Cleveland has experienced a gold rush of prospects, with current Lake County Captains and 6 2023 draftees listed among Cleveland's Top 30 prospects by MLB Pipeline. The latest is C Cooper Ingle, who is MLB Pipeline's No. 30 Cleveland prospect, replacing 2021 Captain and current Triple-A Columbus Clippers SS José Tena, who graduated from prospect status on June 30.

LAST TIME OUT: On July 2 at Dayton, **Zach Jacobs** (4-3) garnered the loss in the 4-0 defeat. Jacobs pitched 3.2 innings, allowing 2 runs on 3 hits, striking out 4 and hitting a batter in 65 pitches (42 strikes). He allowed 2-run triple to Dayton CF Carlos Jorge in the bottom of the 3rd inning, but proceeded to retire his last 3 batters before being replaced by RHP Matt Jachec with 2 outs in the 4th.

AGAINST THE LUGNUTS: Jacobs has fared remarkably well in 4 relief appearances against the Lugnuts so far this season. The right-hander has pitched a combined 10.1 scoreless innings against Lansing, allowing just 4 hits and 3 walks, while throwing 11 strikeouts and posting a 2-0 record with 1

LAST 10 APPEARANCES: Jacobs has posted a 3.12 ERA in 26.0 innings over his last 10 appearances since May 19 at Lansing. He is holding opponents to a .156 AVG during this span, while notching 30 strikeouts to just 8 walks.

MIDWEST LEAGUE RELIEVER RANKS: Among MWL relievers with 30+ innings pitched, Jacobs ranks 1st with a 0.76 WHIP, 8th with a 2.36 ERA, and tied for 9th with 41 strikeouts.

DOUBLE-DIGITS IN '23: Jacobs went 10-4 with Single-A Lynchburg in 2023, leading the Cleveland player development system and ranking tied for 1st in the Carolina League with 10 wins. Jacobs was Lynchburg's 1st 10-game winner since current Triple-A Columbus Clippers RHP Triston McKenzie won 12, and current Milwaukee Brewers RHP Aaron Civale won 11 in 2017.

TIME IN TARTAN: Jacobs pitched 3 seasons at the University of California, Riverside (enrollment 26,809) from 2020-22. He was recruited by then-UCR head coach and 2002 World Series Champion pitcher Troy Percival. Jacobs pitched for the former 4-time All-Star before Percival resigned in 2020. In 3 seasons, made 19 starts, going 3-9 with a 4.47 ERA, 86 strikeouts and 22 walks across 116 innings. Jacobs tossed his 1st complete game shutout in his 3rd career start on February 29, 2020 at St. Mary's, striking out 9 and walking none with 3 hits allowed across 9 innings in the 1-0 win.

WHAT IS A HIGHLANDER?: UC Riverside's mascot is a Highlander, named for the Box Springs Mountains that reside behind the UCR campus, also known as "The Highlands." UC Riverside has the highest elevation among the 10 universities in the University of California system. UC Riverside's mascot is "Scotty Highlander," a kilt-wearing bear.

7 former Lake County Captains have been promoted to MLB during the 2024 season.

INF/OF Jhonkensy Noel: On Wednesday, June 26, INF/OF Jhonkensy Noel made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians on the road against the Baltimore Orioles. He started at first base and batted 9th in the Guardians' order, finishing 1-for-4 with 2 strikeouts. In his 1st MLB at-bat, Noel hit a 413-foot solo home run to center field, becoming the 4th player in Cleveland franchise history to homer in his 1st career MLB at-bat. He was the first to do so since 2004 Captain Kevin Kouzmanoff, who became the 1st player in MLB history to hit a grand slam on his 1st MLB pitch on September 2, 2006. Noel played 88 regular-season games for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, hitting .238 with 78 hits, 12 doubles, 27 home runs, 67 RBI, a .521 SLG, and an .827 OPS.

LHP Raymond Burgos: On Monday, June 24, LHP Raymond Burgos made his MLB debut for the San Francisco Giants at home against the Chicago Cubs. He pitched 1 inning of relief, allowing 3 hits, 1 earned run, and 1 walk, while throwing 1 strikeout. Burgos made 48 regular-season appearances (11 starts) for the Captains across the 2019, 2021, and 2022 seasons, going 10-6 with a 2.83 ERA, 115 strikeouts, a 1.29 WHIP, a .255 opposing batting average, and 8 holds, converting 1 of his 2 save opportunities. He also made 3 postseason relief appearances for Lake County in 2022, tallying a 4.26 ERA, 6 strikeouts, 2 walks, and a .150 opposing batting average, converting his lone save opportunity in Game 2 of the Midwest League East Championship Series.

INF Angel Martínez: On Saturday, June 22, **INF Angel Martínez** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians at home against the Toronto Blue Jays. He started at designated hitter and batted 9th in the Guardians' order, going 0-for-3 with 1 strikeout. **Martínez** played 77 regular-season games for the Captains in 2022, hitting .288 with 81 hits, 17 doubles, 3 triples, 10 home runs, 27 RBI, 10 stolen bases, and an .861 OPS.

INF/OF Daniel Schneemann: On Sunday, June 2, **INF Daniel Schneemann** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians at home against the Washington Nationals. He started at 2nd base and batted 8th in the Guardians' order, going 1-for-3 with a 2-run double on his first MLB pitch and a strikeout. **Schneemann** played 98 regular-season games for the Captains across the 2018, 2019, and 2021 seasons, hitting .267 with 86 hits, 13 doubles, 3 triples, 5 home runs, 43 RBI, 12 stolen bases, and a .711 OPS. He also played 3 postseason games for Lake County in 2019, hitting .182 (2-for-11) with 2 runs, 2 RBI, and 1 walk.

1B/OF Trenton Brooks: On Tuesday, May 28, **1B/OF Trenton Brooks** made his MLB debut for the San Francisco Giants at home against the Philadelphia Phillies. He started at 1st base and batted 9th in the Giants' order, going 0-for-2 with 1 strikeout. **Brooks** played 29 games for the Captains in 2017, hitting .214 with 24 hits, 5 doubles, 1 home run, 8 RBI, 12 walks, and a .588 OPS.

OF Johnathan Rodríguez: On Tuesday, May 21, **OF Johnathan Rodríguez** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians at home against the New York Mets. He started in right field and batted 7th in the Guardians' order, going 0-for-4 with 2 strikeouts. **Rodríguez** played 103 games for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, hitting .275 with 103 hits, 20 doubles, 23 home runs, 70 RBI, and an .862 OPS. In 2022, he led the Midwest League with 21 home runs.

RHP Cade Smith: On Saturday, March 30, RHP Cade Smith made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians on the road against the Oakland Athletics. He pitched 2 scoreless, hitless innings of relief, allowing just 1 walk and throwing 5 strikeouts. Smith made 23 relief appearances for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, going 2-1 with a 2.67 ERA, 48 strikeouts, a 1.11 WHIP, and a .156 opposing batting average, converting 6 of his 7 save opportunities.

On Tuesday, June 25, Los Picantes defeated the Great Lakes Loons at home by a score of 8-3. **SS Angel Genao** went 3-for-5 with a double and a pair of RBI singles, while **LHP Adam Tulloch** (3-0) earned his third win of the season, allowing 1 hit and throwing 2 strikeouts in 2 scoreless innings of relief out of the Lake County bullpen. As a team, Los Picantes recorded a season-high 6 stolen bases, with **CF Jonah Advincula** leading the way by tying his professional career-high of 3 steals. **Advincula** also had 3 stolen bases on April 25 at West Michigan.

On Tuesday, June 11, Los Picantes defeated the Fort Wayne TinCaps at home by a score of 1-0. **3B Jose Devers** broke a scoreless tie in the bottom of the 7th inning with his 5th home run of the season, a 2-out solo shot on an 0-2 pitch. **RHP Austin Peterson** (ND) allowed 4 hits and no walks, while striking out 6 in 5.2 scoreless innings of work. **RHP Jake Miller** (3rd win of the season), **RHP Jay Driver** (H, 3), and **RHP Zane Morehouse** (S, 5) combined to pitch 3.1 scoreless frames of relief out of the Lake County bullpen.

On Sunday, June 9, Los Picantes defeated the Beloit Sky Carp (Las Paletas de Beloit) on the road by a score of 5-3. **SS Angel Genao** hit his 1st career High-A home run on the first pitch of the game for his first career High-A RBI. 4 innings later, **Genao** recorded the 2nd RBI of his High-A career with a 2-out RBI infield single, which tied the game at 2-2. **RHP Trenton Denholm** earned his 7th win of the season, allowing 2 hits, 2 earned runs, and 3 walks, while striking out 6 in 5 innings of work.
