TODAY'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field! Tonight, your Quakes host the Lake Elsinore Storm (Padres) in the second game of a six-game series. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE STORM: Today's game is the 14th of 24 head-to-head games and the 11th of 15 here at LoanMart Field. The Quakes are 11-2 against the Storm with the two teams having played the first nine games of the series in Rancho where the Quakes now own a 9-1 record. Last season, the Quakes went just 10-20 against the Storm, 7-8 at home.

LAST GAME: Chase Harlan and Jose Meza both went deep and the Quakes snapped a brief two-game skid, thanks to a 6-1 victory over the Lake Elsinore Storm on Tuesday night at LoanMart Field. Harlan's second homer of the year came with a man aboard in the first, putting the Quakes ahead to stay at 2-0. Meza later added a solo shot (7) off Storm starter Humberto Cruz (0-2), moving Rancho's lead to 5-0 in the third. The Quakes' bullpen was strong throughout the night, as Jesus Tillerio (1-0), Jhonny Jimenez, Justin Chambers and Shawn Oduber worked scoreless baseball after Rancho starter Christian Zazueta was limited to just 33 pitches in his return from injury.

TUESDAY'S TRANSACTIONS: Second-year Quake and RBI leader Samuel Munoz was promoted to High-A Great Lakes of the Midwest League on Tuesday, leaving Rancho with a .248 average, a 355 on-base percentage, 11 homers and a team-best 65 RBIs. Taking his spot on the roster is INF Joendry Vargas, who opened the year with Rancho, but has been rehabbing in Arizona with a right hand injury. MLB Pipeline rates Vargas as the Dodgers' 11th-best prospect. In addition, the Quakes activated yesterday's starting pitcher, Christian Zazueta.

SERIES STUFF: Sunday's loss at Fresno ended Rancho's bid for a third straight series win (2-of-3 at Lake Elsinore and 4-of-6 over Visalia). The Quakes are now 11-7-1 in series this year, but just 2-5-1 against the north.

ELKINS STILL ROLLING: Last week's Cal League Player of the Week had a strong follow-up in Fresno on the recent road trip, as Jaron Elkins went 8-for-24 (.333) with a home run, seven RBIs and six stolen bases over six games last series. Elkins is now batting .273 overall with nine homers and 64 RBIs, one off team-leader Samuel Munoz (65).

DEFENSE STILL SCUFFLING: Sunday was a step forward, as the team played error-free, but the Quakes had another tough series defensively, as they committed a total of nine errors over the first five games of the Fresno series. Despite last night's 6-1 win over the Storm, the defense made two more errors. The Quakes have committed a league-worst 137 errors in 103 games and have a league-low fielding percentage of .963.

AIDAN FOELLER: 23-year-old right-hander Aidan Foeller makes his 19th start and 21st appearance, his fourth start against the Storm. In three games against the Storm, he's 1-0 with a 3.38 ERA, allowing five earned runs on 14 hits over 13.1 innings. In his last outing overall, he allowed just four hits over five scoreless innings in a win at Fresno on July 31. His July ERA of 1.59 is his best month this season. Foeller continues to lead the league in strikeouts, racking up 116 punches in just 78.1 innings. Foeller was an 11th-round selection in last year's draft, out of Southern Illinois.

KASH MAYFIELD: 20-year-old left-hander Kash Mayfield makes his 15th start of the year for the Storm and his second against the Quakes. In his lone outing against Rancho on June 18, he allowed one unearned run on no hits, but with one walk and eight strikeouts in a tough-luck loss. In his last outing overall, he allowed one run on five hits over four innings in a no-decision against Inland Empire on July 30. Mayfield was taken in the first round of the 2024 draft by the Padres out of Elk City High School in Elk City, Oklahoma. He's ranked by MLB Pipeline as San Diego's third-best prospect in their minor league system.
