## INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Last night's doubleheader - scheduled after Tuesday night's postponement - between the Indians and Clippers was postponed due to inclement weather. One of the two games will be made up today in a twinbill beginning at $5: 35$ PM. The make up date for the other game has yet to be determined.

ABOUT WEDNESDAY: The Indianapolis Indians stranded the bases loaded in the ninth inning as their comeback attempt against the Columbus Clippers fell short in a 3-1 loss on Wednesday afternoon at Victory Field. Columbus took a lead on a solo home run by Estevan Florial in the third inning before tacking on two insurance runs in the seventh. Indianapolis broke up the shutout bid in the eighth inning when Seth Beer came around to score after roping a ground-rule double. With the Clippers leading 3-1 entering the game's final frame, Andrew Walters labored through the heart of the Indians order. An error by shortstop José Tena allowed Liover Peguero to reach base safely as the leadoff man, and back-to-back one-out walks loaded the bases. A shallow fly out by Matt Gorski and strikeout to Seth Beer ended the threat without a run crossing.

CHOPPIN' WOOD(FORD): Jake Woodford continued his dominant stretch for the Indians since making his Pirates organization debut on June 14 at Jacksonville, tossing 5.0 one-run innings with six strikeouts on Wednesday. In that time, he is $0-2$ with a 2.13 ERA ( $6 \mathrm{er} / 25.1 \mathrm{lip}$ ) and 29 strikeouts in five starts. Prior to throwing just 3.0 innings on July 4 vs. Louisville, he had tossed at least 5.0 innings in nine consecutive starts dating back to April 24 with Charlotte. His 0.91 WHIP with Indianapolis helped lower his season mark to 1.23 , the fourth-best WHIP in the International League this season.

THE BEER KEEPS FLOWING: Seth Beer continued his hot streak on Wednesday, going 1-for-4 with the Indians lone run scored and a double vs. Columbus. He has hit safely in nine of his last 11 games, hitting. 268 (11-for-41) with eight runs, six extra-base hits and 10 RBI. On Sunday, he launched his third home run in a five-game stretch since June 30 at Rochester. All of his hits since joining the Indians on June 18 have come off right-handed pitchers, going $0-f 0 r-8$ with one walk and four strikeouts against southpaws. In addition, his success has largly come on the road. In seven road games, he is hitting . 320 ( 8 -for-25) with two doubles, two home runs and nine RBI. That comes in stark contrast to his . 185 batting average ( 5 -for-27), two extra-base hits and one RBI in seven games at Victory Field.

STREAK SNAPPED: Henry Davis had his 18-game on-base streak snapped on Wednesday. His stretch from May 17-July 6 was tied for the fourth-longest active on-base streak in the International League. In that time, he was hitting . 348 (23-for-66) with 18 runs, eight doubles, six home runs and 15 RBI. He had a major league rehab assignment transferred from Double-A Altoona to Indianapolis on July 4 and was activated and optioned to Indy on Monday. In 26 total games with the Indians this season, he is hitting . 302 ( $29-$ for-96) with 22 runs, nine doubles, seven home runs and 19 RBI.

JUNE PLAYER OF THE MONTH: Andrés Alvarez, who was named Indianapolis' June Player of the Month on Friday, had his 16 -game on base streak since June 8 snapped on Wednesday. In that time, he hit . 314 ( 16 -for-51) with 10 runs, three doubles, one home run, five RBI, nine walks, a 426 on-base percentage and .857 OPS. The stretch, which led to him being named Indianapolis' June Player of the Month on July 5, followed a 20-gamer with Double-A Altoona from June 29-July 24 , 2022, for the second-longest on-base streak of his career.

HELLERBALL: Ben Heller recorded the final out of the game on Wednesday in relief of Connor Sadzeck, who left with an apparent injury. The outing extended his impressive stretch of dominance in the International League out of the bullpen. He has not allowed a run across his last 12 outings (12.1ip) since May 21 at lowa, recording a 0.65 WHIP and .075 batting average against ( 3 -for-40). In addition, he hasn't allowed a hit across his last 7.2 innings (seven appearances). His 12-game shutout streak is tied for the fourth-longest such streak in the IL and is currently the longest active streak after Charlotte's Sammy Peralta's 12-game streak was snapped on July 4.

DOUBLEHEADERS: The Indians are set to play their seventh doubleheader this season tonight after playing just five during the 2023 season. In those seven doubleheaders, they own a 1-3-2 record after being swept in their last two twinbills on May 30 against Omaha and June 27 at Rochester. This season marks the most doubleheaders played in a single season by the Indians since they went 3-1-3 in twinbills during the 2017 season. Indianapolis still has at least two doubleheaders on the docket, on Aug. 28 vs. Louisville to make up for a postponement at Louisville Slugger Field on July 3 and one that has yet to be scheduled after last night's postponement vs. Columbus.

GAME 1: Kicking off the doubleheader for Indianapolis tonight is RHP Domingo Germán (3-4, 5.68), making his second start against the Clippers this season. On June 6, he took the loss with eight runs allowed (seven earned) in 5.0 innings, his third start with Indy. He has faced Columbus three times in his career, going 1-2 with a 5.68 ERA (12er/19.0ip) and 17 strikeouts. Countering for the Clippers will be RHP Triston McKenzie ( $0-0,5.06$ ), who has made two career starts vs. Indy with a 1-0 record, 3.72 ERA (4er/9.2ip) and 10 strikeouts.

GAME 2: In the nightcap, RHP Luis Cessa (3-3,4.26) takes the mound for the Indians. He faced Columbus three times with Omaha this season, logging a 3.27 ERA (4er/11.0ip) and nine strikeouts. Countering for the Clippers will be LHP Joey Cantillo ( $0-1,3.32$ ), who has allowed three earned runs in 11.0 career innings vs. Indy.

THIS DATE IN 1996: A day after playing their first game at new Victory Field in downtown Indianapolis, the Indians won their first game there vs. Oklahoma City, 2-1. Mike Remlinger allowed just one run on two hits over 6.1 innings, and Indy's bullpen backed him by allowing just three hits over the next 2.2 innings. Pokey Reese went 2-for-4 and drove in Roberto Mejia twice.

## TONIEHT'S PITCHER

Domingo Germán: Right-hander Domingo Germán is set to make his tenth Triple-A start of the year against Columbus, tonight at 5:35 PM at Victory Field.

Last Outing: Germán toed the rubber against the Bats on 7/4 for the first time this season as he punched out three batters across 3.2 innings while picking up the no-decison.

Against the Clippers: Germán made one start vs. Columbus on $6 / 6$, pitching 5.0 innings and punching out one hitter while walking away with the loss.

Historic Germán: Domingo Germán spent the 2023 season with the New York Yankees. He made 20 total appearances (19 starts) while tossing the 24th perfect game in major league history on $6 / 28$ at Oakland which was the fourth in Yankees history. He was placed on the restricted list on $8 / 2$ and missed the remainder of the season.

Miscellaneous: Germán was signed by the Florida Marlins as an international free agent on May 27, 2010. On Dec. 19, 2014, he was traded to New York (AL) with RHP Nathan Eovaldi and RF Garrett Jones in exchange for RHP David Phelps and 3B Martin Prado. He had his contract first selected by the Yankees on November 4, 2016 and he made his MLB debut on June 11, 2017 vs. Baltimore. He was signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent on March 16, 2024.
