JUMBO SHRIMP WIN ON OPENING DAY

Marty Costes' RBI single in the eighth inning Friday lifted Jacksonville to a 5-4 victory over Gwinnett in front of a sellout crowd on Opening Day. The Stripers took the lead in the first inning on Luis Liberato's RBI double. In the fourth, J.P. Martinez launched a home run to make it 2-0. The Jumbo Shrimp grabbed the lead in the fourth thanks to a Griffin Conine RBI double, Jacob Amaya RBI single and José Devers sacrifice fly. After Gwinnett tied things up in the fifth on Luke Williams' home run, the teams traded runs in the seventh to make it 4-4. Costes RBI single in the eighth put Jacksonville up for good to win the season opener.

GRAND OPENING

Including last night's victory, since 2005, Jacksonville has customarily enjoyed a lot of success on Opening Day. The club is 11-8 (.579) in their season lid-lifters since 2005, collectively outscoring their opponents 82-74. Jacksonville has won on Opening Day in eight of their last 12 season openers dating back to the 2012 season.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?

Daren Brown returns in 2024 as Jacksonville's manager for the third consecutive season. A native of Holdenville, Okla., Brown holds a 1,282-1,269 (.502) record as a minor league manager. In 2022, Brown's first season with Jacksonville, he piloted the Jumbo Shrimp to an 80-69 (.537) record, placing third in the International League East Division. Brown also juggled a franchise-record 79 players in 2022, including a Jacksonville high for starting pitchers (25). The Jumbo Shrimp followed that up with a 70-79 (.470) record in 2023, with Brown utilizing a franchise-record 44 different pitchers on his staff throughout the campaign.

MOVIN' OUT (ANTHONY'S SONG)

Along with Jeff Lindgren, Devin Smeltzer and Eli Villalobos, Anthony Maldonado is returning to the Jumbo Shrimp roster in 2024. The Wellington, Fla., native is coming off a dominate 2023 campaign. Among the 247 pitchers who logged at least 40.0 IP in the International League in 2023, Maldonado ranked first in ERA (1.76), K% (39.4%), K-BB% (27.8%) and SwStr% (21.4%), fourth in xFIP (3.53) and ninth in FIP (3.40). Overall, Maldonado was 7-3 with a 1.76 ERA across 34 games (46.0 IP, 23 H, 21 BB, 71 K).

TROY MEETS WORLD

Jumbo Shrimp first baseman **Troy Johnston** is coming off an extraordinary season that saw him earn Marlins Minor League Player of the Year. Johnston finished the season leading all of Minor League Baseball in RBIs (116) while ranking fourth in extra-base hits (67), ninth in hits (157), tied for 10th in runs (102), 13th in OPS (.948), tied for 15th in doubles (36) and 17th in slugging percentage (.549). Over 134 games between Jacksonville and Double-Pensacola, Johnston slashed .307/.399/.549/.948 with 26 home runs and 24 stolen bases, becoming the first Marlins minor leaguer since 2008 to post a season with at least 20 homers and 20 steals.

DANE TIME

Originally selected by the Detroit Tigers as a pitcher back in 2017, **Dane Myers** converted to a full-time position player in 2021. The Katy, Texas native batted .292/.371/.442/.813 in 45 games in 2021 and then .267/.315/.489/.804 between Double-A Erie and Triple-A Toledo in 2022 before the Marlins selected him in the minor league phase of that winter's Rule 5 draft. In 2023, Myers unlocked a new level, hitting .316/.406/.489/.895 between Jacksonville and Double-A Pensacola while also making his major league debut with Miami. In Spring Training entering this season, Myers hit .412/.474/.735/1.209 with two doubles, three home runs, five RBIs, four stolen bases and seven runs scored in 17 games.

BACK TO WINNING PLEASE?

Thanks to a 75-55 (.577) record in 2021 and an 80-69 (.537) mark in 2022, Jacksonville collected back-to-back winning seasons for the first time since 2013-14. In 2023, though, the Jumbo Shrimp finished just 70-79 (.470) to snap their run of winning records. Jacksonville finished the first half of the season with the International League's worst record at 32-42 (negative-51 run differential) before rebounding with a 38-37 (.507) in the season's second half (negative-23 run differential).

ABOUT YONNY

-A native of Bachaquero, Venezuela, Chirinos signed with the Tampa Bay Rays for \$10,000 as an international free agent from Venezuela in June 2012.

-On March 25, 2018, the Rays announced that Chirinos had made the Opening Day roster. Chirinos made his opening debut in a long relief role against the Boston Red Sox on April 1. He worked four scoreless innings while allowing just one hit. Chirinos set a franchise record by pitching his first 14 2/3 innings without allowing an earned run.

-Chirinos pitched for Tampa Bay on August 16, 2020 against the Blue Jays. His start that night followed a stint on the injured list due to right triceps inflammation. A week later, he underwent Tommy John surgery. Chirinos' rehab and recovery process was stalled in September 2021 when he fractured his elbow while throwing batting practice. The injury required surgery and, as it turned out, set him back another year. He wound up going 752 days between appearances for the Rays, finally returning to the mound on September 8, 2022. Chirinos allowed four hits, one walk and struck out four while blanking the Red Sox during a three-inning stint. When he took the mound in the fourth in relief of Jeffrey Springs, the game was scoreless. When he exited after the sixth, the Rays had a 1-0 lead. That is how the qame finished and Chirinos had his first win since August 4, 2019.

-After more than a decade in the Rays' organization, Chirinos was claimed off waivers on July 23, 2023 by the Atlanta Braves. Atlanta non-tendered Chirinos in November and he signed a minor league deal with the Miami Marlins in February.

-With both Tampa Bay and Atlanta, when pitching with the bases empty, opponents posted an .832 OPS in 224 appearances. In 138 plate appearances with runners on base, that figure dropped to .794. Additionally, in 87 plate appearances with runners in scoring position, opponents compiled a .742 OPS.

-According to Baseball Savant, Chirinos was in the 87th percentile in offspeed run value (+4) while also ranking in the 71st percentile in ground ball percentage $(46.3 \, \mathrm{percent})$.
