PITCHING DAZZELS IN WIN OVER CORPUS:

The Frisco RoughRiders stymied the Corpus Christi Hooks' offense once again on Friday in a 2-1 win, striking out 14 at Whataburger Field. Frisco (22-15, 53-52) has now allowed just three runs over the first four games of the series including two shutouts. The Riders did not allow a run for 23 consecutive innings until Corpus Christi (19-18, 52-54) scored one run in the the ninth inning on Friday. The Riders have not trailed at any point this week against the Hooks. The Riders clinched the series against Corpus Christi by winning the first four games of the six-game series. Frisco is now tied with Amarillo for first place in the South Division second-half standings. Frisco scored its only runs on Friday in the seventh inning. **Keyber Rodriguez** walked with one out, stole second and advanced to third on a wild pitch. **David Garcia** walked and with runners on the corners, **Jayce Easley** scored both teammates on a sacrifice bunt plus an error, earning his first Double-A RBI. Jonathan Sprinkle (3-1) took the loss by allowing one earned run and committing the throwing error. **Dane Acker** went 4.1 scoreless innings in his start for Frisco, allowing five hits with five strikeouts. He stranded two runners in each of his first three innings, then struck out the side in order in the fourth. Acker exited in the fifth inning with the bases loaded and one out. **Aidan Anderson** entered to strike out back-to-back hitrs and leave the bases full. **Michael Brewer** (2-2) kept that string going by striking out the side in order in the sixth inning and was credited with the win. **Florencio Serrano** faced the minimum in the seventh, striking out one batter and finishing the inning on a double play. **Reid Birlingmair** did the exact same in the eighth. Birlingmair came back out for the ninth and struck out the first batter before allowing a solo home run. He struck out the next hitter and gave way to **Antoine Kelly**, who finished the game on a three-pitch strikeout and took the save. Frisco's bullpen has allowed just one run and four h

NEW MONTH, NEW ME

The RoughRiders have struggled on the mound this season, but in the month of August, they have been fantastic. In the 10 games in August, (7-3 record) the RoughRiders lead the Texas League with a 2.11 ERA while allowing a league-low four home runs and .163 BAA. The August ERA is the fourth-lowest in MiLB while the .163 BAA is the second-lowest in the minors. The bullpen has allowed just six earned runs over 51.1 innings, a 1.05 ERA with 71 strikeouts to 14 walks. **Ryan Garcia** was brilliant on Tuesday, allowing just two base runners on walks over six no-hit innings with six strikeouts. **Nick Krauth** then followed up with a second quality start on Wednesday, giving the RoughRiders their first back-to-back quality starts since May 31st and June 1st when **Owen White** and **Jack Leiter** completed the feat.

HAUV YOURSELF A YEAR:

Trevor Hauver has been fantastic recently for the RoughRiders on the offensive side. On June 16th, he was hitting .218/.337/.368/.705, but in the 39 games since, he is batting .315/.429/.527/.956 with 11 doubles, six home runs, 26 RBIs and 30 walks. In those games, he has raised his average 45 points and his OPS 116 points.

CARTER WALKS SO THE ROUGHRIDERS CAN RUN:

Evan Carter has been fantastic at drawing walks and getting on base this season. Carter's 62 walks are second in the Texas League despite only playing in 77 percent of the RoughRiders games this year. His 15.6 percent walk rate this year is sixth-highest in the league as well. He has walked 12 times in his last 12 games. His .406 OBP on the season is 11th in all of Double-A and among all 13 players in Double-A with a .400 OBP or better, Carter is the youngest at 20 years old.

HICKS IS THE CORRECT PICK:

Liam Hicks has been as hot as anyone at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over the last 21 games, Hicks is batting .356 (26-for-73)/.453/.493/.946 with five doubles, a home run, 13 RBIs, 13 walks and 12 runs scored. He is riding a eight-game hitting streak, batting .444 (12-for-27).

K'S BY KELLY

RoughRiders reliever **Antoine Kelly** has been incredible out of the Riders bullpen recently. He has not allowed an earned run over his last 20 outings. During that stretch, he has 25 strikeouts to three walks over 21.2 innings while recording four saves. He has converted on all eight save opportunities this season. He was named Texas Rangers Minor League Reliever of the Month for July.

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Evan Carter** hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of two teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (**Liam Hicks, Luisangel Acuña, Jax Biggers, Dustin Harris, Trevor Hauver, Thomas Saggese** (3) and **Evan Carter**). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

-Nordlin was the highest-drafted pitcher alumni (13th round in 2017) from of Mountain View since Spencer Moran was drafted in the 11th round in 2014 out of Concordia.

-In his sophomore season at GateWay Community College, Nordlin went 4-3 with a 1.91 ERA before being drafted by the Rangers. That season, he had 123 strikeouts to 17 walks in 85.0 innings for Geckos.

2023 SEASON

-Selected in the Minor League Rule 5 draft by the Minnesota Twins in December of 2022 and assigned to Double-A Wichita.

-Released by the Twins on June 4th and signed by the Rangers on June 6th.

2022 SEASON

-Designated as one of two "long relief" pitchers for Frisco, along with **Tai Tiedemann** at the beginning of the year.

-Promoted to Triple-A Round Rock for spot start on July 14th at El Paso, throwing 3.0 innings, allowing two runs on five hits while striking out three and walking one.

-Made first Double-A start on July 27th at Springfield, throwing four shutout innings in a 5-2 win.

2021 SEASON

-Pitched in 20 games with 11 starts for High-A Hickory.

-Struggled as a starter, going 0-5 with a 6.48 ERA, but pitched well in relief: 3-0, 3.27 ERA.

-Nordlin's 83.0 innings were the second-most on the Crawdads, just trailing **Avery Weems** (85.1).
