TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: The Curve play their lone series of the season with the Hartford Yard Goats. Altoona went 3-3 against the Yard Goats in 2024 at Dunkin' Park.

Former future Scranton-Wilkes/Barre RailRider, Ben Shields, takes the hill for the Yard Goats on this fine evening for baseball. Shields began the season on the IL and was activated to Somerset's roster on June 28 and acquired by Colorado with INF Roc Riggio for reliever Jake Bird at the trade deadline. He went 1-2 with a 3.42 ERA in five starts with Somerset and tossed 5 innings of 2-run ball in his team debut on August 2 against Reading. Shields was signed by the Yankees as a non-drafted free agent in 2023 out of Ğeorge Mason University and converted from the bullpen to a starting role last season at High-A Hudson Valley. He finished last season in the Eastern league and recorded a 3.12 ERA in 52.0 IP across 11 games (9 starts). Shields began his collegieate career at UMass where he pitched for three seasons before finishing for two seasons at GMU.

BACK-TO-BACK: Esmerlyn Valdez and Duce Gourson knocked back-to-back homers in the 9th inning of Friday's 3-2 loss in 10 innings to the Hartford Yard Goats. It was the 5th time (out of 55 instances in franchise history) that the Curve hit back-to-back homers in the 8th inning or later of a game that either tied or took the lead. It last occured on May 31, 2024 when Joe Perez hit a go-ahead Grand Slam in the 8th inning of a game against Portland and Carter Bins followed him with a solo shot.

AUGUSTO OMAR: Catcher Omar Alfonzo has picked up two multi-hit games to start the calendar month. Alfonzo is 8-for-22 (.364) with 1 2B, 1 3B and 5 RBI in his last 6 games.

SHRIMPIN': The Curve earned their second 1-0 win on a walk-off walk on Wednesday, August 6 against Hartford. Nick Cimillo drew the bases loaded free pass in the bottom of the ninth to send Altoona to a second straight win over the Yard Goats. The only other time in franchise history that the Curve won a game 1-0 on a walk-off walk was August 1, 2023 when Connor Scott drew the game-winning walk.

TRIPLE SIANI: Outfielder Sammy Siani matched the franchise record with 2 triples on Tuesday, August 5 against the Hartford Yard Goats. It was the second time this season he's picked up 2 triples, first instances since Jared Oliva since July 17, 2019 against Trenton.

SO YOU LIKE PLAYING ALTOONA?: Eight players this season have earned an Eastern League weekly or monthly award immediately after playing the Curve. CJ Kayfus (Akron, 4/13), Brandon Beck (Somerset, 4/20), Blaze Jordan (Portland, May Player of the Month), David Sandlin (Portland, 6/1), Rafael Sanchez (New Hampshire, 6/8), Trey Gibson (Chesapeake, 7/27) and Max Ferguson (Portland, 8/3) have all taken home weekly awards after playing Altoona. Hunter Barco was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week (April 27) and Pitcher of the Month in April to account for Altoona's only honors this season.

BOMBS AWAY: Altoona matched a season-high with 6 extra base hits in an 11-4 win over the Portland Sea Dogs on Sunday, August 3. Nick Cimillo slugged his second career 2-homer game and Termarr Johnson smashed his 9th homer of the season in the victory,

Cimillo is the first Curve batter to reach double figures in home runs this season and one of 11 Pirates minor leaguers to hit at least 11 home runs. Esmerlyn Valdez (20 w/ GBO) and Javier Rivas (18 w/ GBO) have hit the most homers by a Pirates minor leaguer this season.

EZZY: Outfielder Esmerlyn Valdez has gotten his feet underneath of him at Double-A, in his last 11 games, he is 13-for-40 (.325) with his first Double-A homer, and 5 RBI and 6 walks (.888 OPS).

MY VALENTIN: Righty Valentin Linarez has turned in one of the best seasons of his professional career in 2025. In addition to holding opponents to a career-low .188 BAA this season and a 1.15 WHIP, since June 10 he's allowed just 3 runs in 20.2 IP (1.31 ERA) and a 0.82 WHIP with 22 strikeouts.

JUSTIN'S MEIS: Since recording a 4.91 ERA in the month of May, Justin Meis has gone 3-2 with a 1.67 ERA with two saves in 17 games for the Curve. In that time he's recorded a 0.81 WHIP and walked just 4 batters in 27.0 innings with 31 strikeouts. Meis' 57 K's this season are 3rd-most by an Eastern League reliever.

KELLY K'S: Righty Antwone Kelly struck out a career-high 9 batters in 4.2 innings on July 10 at Binghamton. The 21-year-old has struck out 32 batters in 30.1 innings to start July, he holds a 0.98 WHIP which ranks T-6th among qualified minor league pitchers. Kelly's 105 strikeouts this season are 2nd-most in the Pirates minor league system (Bubba Chandler, 113), tied with teammate Wilber Dotel (101).

CLOSE WINS: 18 of Altoona's last 23 wins (since June 18) have all come in a save situation for the bullpen. 51 of the team's 103 games this year (49%) have been decided by two runs or fewer.

HARBIN'S K'S: Righty Ryan Harbin has struck out 29 batters in 18.2 innings with Altoona. Harbin ranks 8th in the Pirates system in strikeouts (75) in 49.0 innings, every other pitcher in the top 14 in the system in strikeouts has throwin at least 60.0 IP. Harbin ranks 5th among MiLB relievers with 75 strikeouts.

ITALIANISSIMO: Righty Alessandro Ercolani has dialed in throughout his first trip through the Eastern League. In 11 of his 20 outings this season, he's allowed 1 run or fewer. Held under an innings count this year, Ercolani is working on the best walk rate of his career, walking only 27 in 78.1 IP. His 2.88 BB/9 innings is the best mark of his career.

Andy Fox Manager (1st Season) Career Record: 45-94

Andy Fox is the 16th manager in Curve history. Fox's coaching career has seen him serve in several roles, including time with the Rangers, Mariners, Marlins, and Red Sox. He spent the last 14 years in Boston's system, serving as the team's infield coordinator and first base coach. Prior to his time in Boston, Fox served as a first base coach for the Marlins and managed the Rangers Single-A Clinton team in 2006. Fox was drafted in the 2nd round of the 1989 Draft by the Yankees and won two World Series in his nineyear Major League career with New York (1996) and the Florida Marlins (2003) as an infielder.

### Matt Ford Pitching Coach 1st season/12th overall

Ford joins the Curve in 2025 after serving as the Pitching Coach for Low-A Bradenton in 2024. This is his 12th season serving as an instructor in the Pirates system, previously serving in the FCL (2022), Greensboro (2021), as the team's Rehab Pitching Coordinator (2019-20), Bradenton (2017-18), both West Virginia clubs (2015-2016) as well as with Bristol (2014). Ford was Toronto's third round pick in 1999 and made his Major League debut with the Brewers in 2003. He pitched in 25 games and made four starts in his lone Major League season. 
