Peluse is coming off six innings, allowing one unearned run while striking out six against the Dayton Dragons on the 4th of July (though the Lugnuts ended up falling in 11 innings, 12-8).

Last Night: Lugnuts 4, Loons 2. Reid Birlingmair twirled six fine innings, striking out five, and the Lugnuts survived Loons threats in each of the final four innings to win a fourth straight game and, miracle of miracles, capture their first series victory of the year in their 10th series of 2021. Drew Millas and Jordan Diaz each collected two hits and scored two runs in the win.

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, Lansing moved up to the High-A Central and the ballclub accepted an invitation to affiliate with the Oakland A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Kansas City Royals (1996-98), Chicago Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

A Series Victory! The Lugnuts' series this season - split vs. Lake County, split at Dayton, split at Fort Wayne, series loss vs. Great Lakes, split vs. South Bend, split at West Michigan, split vs. Great Lakes, series loss at Cedar Rapids, split vs. Dayton... and series win at Great Lakes.

Alumni Report: 2017 Lugnut Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., is the youngest player ever to lead Major League Baseball in All-Star voting, elected by the fans to start at first base for the American League All-Star team, his first All-Star nod. Vladdy Jr. currently leads the Majors in batting average (.337), RBIs (73), OBP (.435), OPS (1.102) and total bases (208); and ranks tied for second in home runs (28), third in runs scored (68); third in slugging percentage (.667), tied for third in extra-base hits (46), and tied for fourth in hits (105). Fellow 2017 Lugnut Bo Bichette was named as an A.L. Ali-Star reserve; Bichette is tied for first in the Majors in runs scored (70).

Alumni Report, Part II: Slugging 2019 Lugs outfielder Griffin Conine, traded to the Miami Marlins in 2020 by Toronto and currently playing for the Beloit Snappers, leads the minors with 20 homers. 2015 Lugnuts first baseman/DH Ryan McBroom, playing for Omaha, is tied for 3rd with 17 homers.

Man of Steal: Infielder Max Schuemann (Portage Northern H.S. / Eastern Michigan University) is first in Minor League Baseball with 34 stolen bases, ten more than the Major League leader, Kansas City's Whit Merrifield. Schuemann is tied for third in the Minors with 14 HBPs and third in the High-A Central with 43 runs scored.

Bruised: Lansing leads the High-A Central with 54 HBPs over second-place Great Lakes (53 HBPs). Loons pitchers have hit 16 Lugnuts batters, while Lansing pitchers have hit 14 Loons batters.

Call to Arms: The Lugnuts' pitching staff ranks first in the High-A Central with a 3.61 earned run average and second with a 1.27 WHIP, pitching the third most innings in the league (518 2/3), issuing the second fewest walks (191) and recording tied for the fourth most strikeouts (587).

A Complete Effort: Right-hander Jack Cushing's seven-inning complete game in Game 2 of Friday night's doubleheader was the fourth complete game by a High-A Central pitcher this year. Cushing tossed one complete game while at Georgetown University, a nine-inning CG on April 13, 2019,

Heavy Workload: Lugs lefty Dalton Sawyer, who missed the 2018-2019 seasons due to Tommy John and so did not pitch in a game between the 2017-2018 offseason this year, is making up for lost time. Last night marked his 23rd relief appearance of the season, tying for most in the circuit. He has struck out 40 batters compared to 11 walks in 26 1/3 innings overall.

## JULY 10, NOT TODAY, IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2015:** 20-year-old Juan Kelly's first hit with the Lugnuts was a tiebreaking home run off infielder-turned-emergency-pitcher Jimmy Allen in the 15th inning, and the Lugnuts beat the Great Lakes Loons, 6-5, at Dow Diamond. It was the second time in the season that the Lugnuts had won at Great Lakes in the 15th inning or later on a home run off a Loons position player pitching (Rowdy Tellez off Josmar Cordero, 16th inning, April 16th). Kelly had been 0-for-6 with three strikeouts entering the at-bat.

Root, Root for the Home Team: July 4th's Lugnuts/Dragons series finale drew a season-high attendance of 10,109. That's a larger crowd than any of the Blue Jays' home games this season in Dunedin or Buffalo and it's higher than the average attendance in MLB for the Detroit Tigers (9,717), Baltimore Orioles (8,654), Pittsburgh Pirates (8,237), Tampa Bay Rays (6,783), Oakland Athletics (6,403), Miami Marlins (5,983) and Toronto/Buffalo/Dunedin Blue Jays (3,877). Only eight of the 119 other Minor League teams have drawn a larger crowd to a game this season: Albuquerque, Nashville, Charlotte, Fresno, Indianapolis, Round Rock, Durham and Las Vegas.

Major League Lugnuts: Three former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, bringing the total to 157 all-time - pitcher Ty Tice '18, outfielder Josh Palacios '16-'17, and pitcher Tayler Saucedo '16-'17. Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: Carlos Febles and Carlos Beltrán for the Kansas City Royals. Saucedo most recently debuted, tossing a scoreless inning for the Blue Jays on June 17.

Record-Setting, For Better: On June 15, Max Schuemann broke Samad Taylor's franchise single-game record of four steals in a game (set July 1, 2018) with five stolen bases against the Great Lakes Loons.

Record-Setting, For Worse: On June 20, Stevie Emanuels broke the franchise single game record, tied many times before, of three homers served up in a game, giving up four HRs to the Loons - two apiece by Deacon Liput and Andy Pages.

So Many Starters: The Lugnuts have used 14 different starting pitchers this season, namely Brady Basso, Reid Birlingmair, Jeff Criswell, Jack Cushing, David Leal, Stevie Emanuels, Richard Guasch, Rafael Kelly, Bryce Nightengale, Colin Peluse, Leudeny Pineda, Seth Shuman, Shohei Tomioka and Brock Whittlesey.

Roster Index: With his appearance on July 2, Jack Cushing became the 843rd Lugnut all-time and the 39th player used this year, as well as the 26th different pitcher this season. With that, the 2021 Lugnuts have already surpassed the total number of players used in the 1999 and 2008 seasons (38 apiece). The franchise record for most players used in a single year is 54, set in 2017. Currently, about 18.6% of all Lugnuts are reaching the Major Leagues (157 of 843). If that percentage continues to hold true, at least seven of the 39 players to see time this year with the Nuts will reach MLB.

A Pleasant Peninsula Surrounds You: Max Schuemann (Portage Northern H.S.) is the first Lugnut to hail from Eastern Michigan University in Ypsilanti. Earlier this season, the Nuts featured two Michigan Wolverines in Jeff Criswell (injured) and Jack Weisenburger (promoted).

Finally: Pitchers Jeff Criswell, Stevie Emanuels and Shohei Tomioka, catchers Jared McDonald, Drew Millas and William Simoneit, first baseman Patrick McColl, and outfielder Michael Guldberg have all made their pro debut this season with the Lugnuts.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach Don Schulze was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations Billy Beane was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman Patrick McColl set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

Clubhouse of Higher Learning: The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. First baseman Patrick McColl played for Harvard University, reliever Michael Danielak was drafted from Dartmouth College and catcher William Simoneit spent four years at Cornell University before grad-transferring to Wake Forest. Speaking of outstanding academic institutions, starter Jack Cushing spent four years at Georgetown University.

Power Five Baseball: The Lugnuts also represent the ACC (Michael Guldberg, Georgia Tech); Big 12 (Brady Basso, Oklahoma State); Big Ten (Dalton Sawyer, Minnesota); the SEC (Cobie Vance, Alabama); and the Pac-12 (Stevie Emanuels, Washington).

International Appeal: In addition to 17 different states (Arizona, California, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Louisiana, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Nevada (Connor Hughes), North Carolina, Ohio (Sott Steinmann), Texas, Virginia, Washington) represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, even nations are represented: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa (Anthony Phillips) and Venezuela (Javier Godard).

Representing His Country: 1B/3B Jordan Díaz played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

Last Outing: Started July 4 vs. Dayton: 6 IP, 5 H, 1 UER, 1 BB, 6 K... Lugnuts brought a 2-1 lead to the 7th, but bullpen allowed 11 runs in a 12-8 11-inning loss.

#### 2021 in Lansing:

- left-handed batters are hitting .189/.221/.256, right-handers a far better .372/.430/.615.
- 5 G / 4 GS at home: 1.90 ERA / .236 avg. in 23 2/3 IP... 4 G / 3 GS on the road: 7.58 ERA / .316 avg. in 19 IP.
- Made 2021 debut by piggybacking Jeff Criswell and Shohei Tomioka on the fifth day of the season, Saturday, May 8th vs. Lake County: 3 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 3 BB, 3 K... worked with catcher William Simoneit, a fellow Demon Deacon, to form an all-Wake Forest battery... picked Bryan Lavastida off 1st base in the 6th inning... opened the ninth with two walks and was taken out in favor of Aiden McIntyre, who sewed up the 2-0 win.
- Relieved at Dayton, Saturday, May 15th: 5 IP, 2 H, 1 R, 1 BB, 7 K... entered in 3rd inning, following Seth Shuman... gave up a Brian Rey solo homer for only run... departed with a 2-1 lead, but Michael Danielak gave up a two-run homer to Bren Spillane in the 8th, leading to a 3-2 Lugnuts loss.
- Made first start May 22nd at Fort Wayne, suffering loss: 3 1/3 IP, 10 H, 8 R, 2 BB, 3 K... allowed a Jonny Homza solo home run in the 3rd... departed in the 4th with one out, one run in and the bases loaded, and Bryce Nightengale allowed all three inherited runners to score... Lugnuts fell, 12-7.
- Started May 29 vs. Great Lakes, earning win: 5 IP, 5 H, 2 R (1 ER), 0 BB, 3 K... gave up solo HR to Andy Pages in the 1st... exited after allowing first two batters to reach base in the 6th, one of whom scored against Bryce Nightengale... Lugnuts won, 7-3.
- Domination on June 5 vs. South Bend: 5 2/3 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 1 BB, 10 K... allowed only run in the 2nd inning on a Bryce Windham RBI single... relievers Bryce Nightengale (2 1/3) and Aiden McIntyre (1 IP) combined for six more strikeouts in a 9-3 Lugnuts win.
- Starfed June 12 at West Michigan, charged with loss: 4 2/3 IP, 7 H, 5 R, 2 BB, 3 K... Lugnuts lost, 9-0... held the Whitecaps scoreless for the first four innings before allowing five hits and five runs in the 5th.
- Started June 19 vs. Great Lakes: 4 IP, 6 H, 4 R (3 ER), 1 BB, 3 K... allowed two runs in the 3rd on a Leonel Valera RBI triple and a Jared McDonald passed ball... gave up a Deacon Liput two-run HR in the 4th... Lugnuts rallied from 2-0, 4-2, and 5-4 deficits to win 6-5 in 10 innings on Elvis Peralta, Jr.'s walk-off single.
- Started June 26 at Cedar Rapids: 6 IP, 6 H, 2 R, 1 BB, 7 K... sat 94-95 mph on the stadium gun... exited with 3-2 lead, in line for the win, but Leudeny Pineda gave up two runs in the 7th... Lugnuts rallied for 5-4 victory in 11 innings.

Prospecting: Rated Baseball America's No. 26 A's prospect... "Not assigned to the alternate training site, Peluse committed to an at-home workout plan tailored to increase his leg strength and added 10 pounds of muscle. He arrived at instructional league showing significant velocity gains, much to the A's surprise... Peluse's fastball sat 96 mph and touched 98 at instructs, a marked increase from his low-90s readings in college. His slider was already a plus pitch, showing late life and more drop than a typical slider"... MLB Pipeline's No. 28 A's prospect, grading his fastball at 55, slider at 55, change-up at 50 and control at 45, writing about Peluse, "A ninth-round pick in 2019, Peluse has put himself on the prospect radar for the A's after showing up to the instructional league that consistently hit 97-98. Now carrying a power fastball, Peluse also brings a strong slider that flashes plus, as well as a changeup that is still developing. His command has always been solid going back to his days at Wake Forest, and it showed up in his debut season in the Class A Short Season New York-Penn League, walking just six batters across 24 innings. Approaching his first full season in the Minors in 2021, Peluse will get a chance to show what he can do with his improved repertoire. His repeatable delivery projects him to stick as a starter."

**Draft Day:** Taken 284th overall in the 9th round, 2019, and signed for \$149,300... highest of five Wake Forest players drafted in 2019... only one Demon Deacon was drafted in 2020, but it was Braves first-rounder Jared Shuster, taken 25th overall... one of 10 Lugnuts drafted in 2019, including the 6th round (Seth Shuman), 7th round (Drew Millas), 10th round (Patrick McColl), 16th round (Brady Basso), 19th round (Jared McDonald), 20th round (Jack Weisenburger), 21st round (Shane Selman), 26th round (Elvis Peralta, Jr.) and 33rd round (Charles Hall)... college teammates with 2019 Lugnuts third baseman Johnny Aiello.

Life as a Pro: Debuted with SS-A Vermont on June 28th, 2019... made four straight starts, not throwing more than three innings in any of them, and then moved to the pen, with five scoreless innings in relief July 27th... in final outing, struck out six in 3 2/3 at Lowell on August 8th.

College: Spent three years at Wake Forest University... began as a Tuesday starter as a freshman before moving to bullpen and pitching effectively (3.54 ERA, 20 G, 7 GS, 40 2/3 IP, 12 BB, 37 K), with three NCAA shutout Super Regional appearances at Florida... served as Sunday starter as sophomore and was Wake Forest's top starter statistically (3.87 ERA, 16 G, 14 GS, 83 2/3 IP, 26 BB, 63 K)... Friday starter as a junior (5.74 ERA, 15 GS, 80.0 IP, 12 HR, 36 BB, 71 K)... in total at Wake: 4.54 ERA, 51 G, 36 GS, 204 1/3 IP, 200 H, 21 HR, 74 BB, 171 K... pitched in summer ball for the Baltimore Redbirds in 2017 (6 G, 3 GS, 1.37 ERA, 26 1/3 IP, 4 ER, 7 BB, 21 K) and for the Chatham Anglers in 2018 (2.57 ERA, 2 G, 7.0 IP, 3 H, 2 ER, 4 BB, 10 K).
