Leading Off

The Fightin Phils continue a six-game series with the Portland Sea Dogs on Thursday night. It is the 15th-of-21 matchups between the teams this season and ninth-of-12 in Reading. Reading won the season-series over Portland last season 11-9, with a 5-3 record at home, and 6-6 on the road. The teams play next at Portland from July 19-21. Portland currently leads the season-series 11-3.

Comeback Falls Short

Reading's late-comback effort fell short in a 5-4 loss to Portland on Wednesday night. Lachlan Wells took the loss, allowing four runs over six innings pitched. Tristan Garnett and Matt Russell each pitched scoreless frames in relief. Ethan Wilson had three hits and a RBI for Reading, while Marcus Lee Sang, Robert Moore and Otto Kemp all doubled. Caleb Ricketts drove in two runs with a single as well to bring his season-total to 19 RBI on the year.

Carlos De La Cruzin

Carlos De La Cruz continued to stay red-hot on Tuesday night. He had his second two-homer game of the season, along with matching season highs with two runs and three RBI. De La Cruz has been on a roll in June, as he is slashing .351/.467/.757, with a 1.224 OPS in 10 games this month. He's added 10 runs, three doubles, four home runs and 10 RBI. In June, his .351 average ranks eighth in the Eastern League (minimum 20 at bats). He also ranks tied for first with four home runs, fourth with 10 RBI, third with 10 runs and sixth with a 1.224 OPS this month. It was the sixth multi-homer game of the season for Reading.

Bombs Away

The Fightin Phils have been hitting home runs at a much-higher clip as of late. After hitting three home runs Tuesday night, Reading homered in seven-straight games, from June 4-12. Additionally, the Fightin Phils are now third in the Eastern League with 57 home runs hit this season. In June, Reading has hit 15 home runs, which ranks second in the league, behind only Erie, who has 17 this month.

Nice To Meet You

Reading has welcomed a trio of players to Baseballtown over the last few days, all of which played most of the season with High-A Jersey Shore previously. Cade Fergus joined the Fightin Phils last Saturday, while Otto Kemp and Andrick Nava were each called up on Tuesday. Fergus hit his first Double-A home run on Tuesday night, and also scored two runs. Kemp walked twice and scored a run in his Double-A debut on Tuesday night. Kemp then added a double and RBI for his first Double-A hit and run driven in on Wednesday night.

Marsh Madness

Phillies outfielder Brandon Marsh will begin a rehab assignment with the Fightin Phils on Thursday night. Marsh was placed on the 10-day IL by the Phillies on June 3 with a right hamstring strain. Prior to being placed on the IL, Marsh is slashing .265/.344/.426, with a .770 OPS through 52 games with the Phillies. He's added 21 runs, six doubles, one triple, six homers and 26 RBI. Marsh is also eight-for-10 in stolen bases this season. It is Marsh's second-full season with the Phillies after being acquired from the Los Angeles Angels on Aug. 2, 2022. Marsh made his Major League debut with the Angels in 2021 and is in his fourth Major League season. The 26-year old was drafted by the Angels in the second round (60th overall) of the 2016 draft out of Buford High School in Buford, Georgia. This will be Marsh's third rehab assignment since joining the Phillies in 2022. He appeared in games for Triple-A Lehigh Valley in both August of 2022 and '23. In 2022, he was injured with a left-ankle strain and was sidelined with a left knee contusion in 2023.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 13, 2001: At Reading, Adam Walker throws the first nine inning no-hitter in R-Phils history and extends his streak of consecutive no-hit innings to 18 as the Phils blank New Haven, 4-0. Walker also did not walk a batter as the Ravens only baserunners came via a hit batsman and two errors.

Sea Dogs Synopsi

Portland enters tonight in first place in the Eastern League's Northeast Divison with a 33-26 record. Portland most recently split a series at home against the Akron RubberDucks. Following this week, Portland returns home and welcomes Richmond to Hadlock Field. Portland's roster features 10 players ranked amongst the Boston Red Sox top-30 prospects: Marcelo Mayer (1), Roman Anthony (2), Kyle Teel (3), Wikelman Gonzalez (5), Luis Pereles (9), Blaze Jordan (19), Eddinson Paulino (22), Hunter Dobbs (25), Angel Bastardo (26) and Kristian Campbell (30).

Portland Pitcher

Righty CJ Liu makes the start tonight for Portland. This season, Liu is 1-1, with a 4.24 ERA over five games and four starts. He's pitched 17 innings, allowed 13 hits, nine walks and 29 strikeouts. Liu earned a win in his last start, June 7 against Akron, tossing six innings, allowing three hits, two runs, three walks and nine strikeouts. Liu began the season on the injured list and made one-rehab appearance with the FCL-Red Sox. He spent all of 2023 with Portland, going 7-8, with a 5.35 ERA over 26 appearances and 24 starts. Liu split 2022 between High-A Greenville and Portland. He began his pro career in 2021 between the FCL-Red Sox and Single-A Salem. Boston signed Liu as an international free agent in 2019 out of Taiwan.
