TONIGHT'S FIREWORKS

Round Rock and Sugar Land will play the series opener on Tuesday night from Round Rock. Express RHP Owen White is slated to start against Space Cowboys RHP Misael Tamarez. First pitch at Dell Diamond is scheduled for 6:35 p.m. CT.

LET FREEDOM RING

Tonight's game can be heard live on the flagship home of the Round Rock Express, AM 1300 The Zone or on 91.1 FM from inside Dell Diamond. Online audio is also available at am1300thezone.heart.com and via the iHeart Radio app. Fans can also watch the game with a valid MiLB.tv login or on the Bally Live app. Express Director of Broadcasting Mike Capps will be on the call providing play-by-play coverage.

SERIES SPLIT SECURED

Round Rock closed out their series in Las Vegas with a 10-7 win on Monday. Express RF Elier Hernandez hit a solo shot in the fourth before CF J.P. Martinez homered in the fifth frame, giving the Express a 4-0 lead. In the sixth inning, 3B Dio Arias put Round Rock ahead 7-0 with a bases-loaded triple. LF Bubba Thompson followed with a double to knock Arias home to make it 8-0. Las Vegas scored in the sixth as SS Logan Davidson ripped a solo home run and cut the lead to 8-1. LF Trenton Brooks hit a three-run home run in the sixth, but the Express still held an 8-4 lead. Arias hit a two-run shot in the eighth for a 10-4 advantage. In the home half, Las Vegas 2B Zack Gelof smacked a home run and pulled the Aviators within four. The ninth inning saw Las Vegas 3B Jonah Bride triple before scoring on a Davidson single, making it a 10-7 game. Round Rock held on for the win and the 3-3 series split.

RED, WHITE AND BLUE

Express RHP Owen White is slated to make his third start for the E-Train tonight after lasting just 2.0 against Las Vegas in his last start on June 29. White gave up a career-high three home runs in the outing, which made him the second E-Train pitcher, along with RHP Nick Krauth, to allow three home runs in an outing this season.

A WALKLESS NIGHT

On the night of his 28th birthday, Round Rock RHP Robert Dugger put together his longest outing of the season in Monday's win after throwing 6.2 innings. He was one out shy of clearing the seventh inning with just one run allowed against the Aviators. Monday also marked the second time he has not issued a walk in a start this year. A trio of pitchers also appeared out of the E-Train bullpen and did not walk a batter. The night saw just the fifth time that the pitching staff did not record a walk in a game this season, four of which have been on the road.

PERFECT PAIRING

Express OF Elier Hernandez and J.P. Martinez both launched a home run against the Aviators on Monday. The duo combined for six home runs in the series against Las Vegas, including back-to-back games with a home run for Hernandez and back-to-back-to-back nights with a home run for Martinez. The pair batted 11-for-28 (.393) for Round Rock against Las Vegas and Hernandez now sits at No. 10 in the Pacific Coast League for home runs with 14.

A SERIES TO REMEMBER

After hitting three home runs in Monday night's win against Las Vegas, the E-Train recorded a total of 16 home runs during the six-game series at Las Vegas Ballpark, which is the most that the team has tallied in any series this season. After winning the final two games of the set, the Express split the series 3-3 with the Aviators and avoided their first series loss since May 9-14 against the Oklahoma City Dodgers.

IT'S INDEPENDENCE DAY

Round Rock has played the last two 4th of July competitions at home, with tonight being the team's third straight Independence Day celebration at Dell Diamond. Since joining the ranks of Triple-A in 2005, the E-Train own a 7-10 record when playing on July 4 and are 9-13 overall when including the team's Double-A seasons. Last season, Round Rock defeated Albuquerque by a final score of 5-3 in front of 11,596 fans at Dell Diamond.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2023 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's Pacific Coast League debut. Davis spent the previous two years as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.

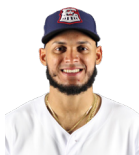
