FROM THE CROW'S NEST

LAST TIME OUT: On Sunday afternoon in Fort Myers, the Marauders and Mighty Mussels were canceled for the day after less than one full inning as inclement weather approached... In their last completed game Saturday, a late Marauders comeback fell just short in a 5-4 loss... Bradenton led the game, 1-0, after three innings on a **Jase Bowen** RBI-infield single, but a five-hit, four-run rally by Fort Myers in the fourth off **Darvin Garcia**—including a go-ahead two-run homer by Kala'i Rosario—put the home team ahead... Tandem starter **Carlos Jimenez** committed a run-scoring balk in the fifth, stretching the Mussels' lead to 5-1, and manager **Jonathan Johnston** was ejected after arguing the call... The Marauders rallied back with three runs in the eighth on a **Deivis Nadal** RBI-double, a Bowen RBI-single, and a run-scoring wild pitch by Regi Grace Jr., but Bradenton left the tying and go-ahead runs in scoring position at the end of the inning.

THE OPPONENT: The Blue Jays are coming off a four-games-to-two series loss at Jupiter, their second straight series loss... The team's roster currently features five players in *Baseball America's* latest top 30 prospect rankings for the Toronto organization: INF Estiven Machado (#12), INF Adrian Pinto (#13), RHP Dahian Santos (#20), INF Rikelbin de Castro (#27), and OF Gabriel Martinez (#30).

NOT-SO-LUCKY SEVEN: The Marauders' loss Saturday clinched a series win for Fort Myers, meaning that Bradenton has now gone seven straight series without a series win... The Marauders last won a series April 26 through May 1 against Dunedin, taking five of six... The last seven series include four losses and three splits... In total, the Marauders have won three series this season, lost five, and split three.

J.B., JUST BRILLIANT: **Jase Bowen** has hit safely in 14 of his last 15 games, batting .382 with 11 RBI and 11 SB during that stretch... He has also reached base in 19 of his last 20 games and had a 13-game on-base streak prior to going 0-for-4 last Saturday... The on-base streak was his second-longest of the season (16G) and the third-longest by a Marauder this year (Jacob Gonzalez, 24G).

THAT'S SO EXTRA: Three of **Norkis Marcos'** four hits this season have gone for extra bases (one double, two triples)... The 21-year-old from the Dominican Republic is off to an overall slow start, batting .143 in 10 games, but his two triples have already matched his career-high, and Marcos already has three RBI in his 10 games.

TOP PIRATES PROSPECTS: The Marauders roster currently includes two prospects in *Baseball America's* Top 30 ranking for the Pirates organization: LHP **Anthony Solometo** (#11) and OF **Rodolfo Nolasco** (#28)... *Baseball America* lists the Pirates' farm system as the third-best in baseball.

FIELD STAFF: Manager **Jonathan Johnston**, 2021 Low-A Southeast Manager of the Year, is in his second season at the helm for the Marauders... Former major leaguer **Yorman Bazardo** is the club's new pitching coach after spending 2021 as a pitching coach for the FCL Pirates... Former Pirate **Mendy López** joins as hitting coach after serving as the Pirates' Latin American Field Coordinator in 2021... **Casey Harms** is the Marauders' Integrated Baseball Performance Coach after a collegiate coaching career in the Northwoods League (Waterloo Bucks, 2019-20) and at UC Santa Barbara (2013-2018)... **Gustavo Omaña** is the Marauders' Development Coach after serving on staff at Triple-A Indianapolis in 2021.

HITTING TRIPLE DIGITS: The 2022 season marks the 100th year of operation for LECOM Park, known as City Park upon opening in 1923. It has served as a spring training home for six different MLB franchises, including the Pirates since 1969. Baseball hall-of-famers who once called the historic park their spring home include Hank Aaron, Roberto Clemente, Dizzy Dean, Rogers Hornsby, Reggie Jackson, and more.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS/INFO

2022: Making full-season debut this season... In Single-A debut April 10 at Dunedin, pitched a flawless ninth inning in a 13-4 Marauders win (2 K)... April 14 vs Lakeland, stranded two inherited runners from rehabber Luis Oviedo in the second inning, but surrendered a career-high six runs on five hits and two walks in the third... April 21 at Daytona, held Tortugas scoreless over first two innings (one walk), opened the second inning with three straight walks, then after a fielder's choice force-out at home, allowed an RBI-single and an RBI-groundout and was removed... April 28 vs Dunedin: held Blue Jays scoreless in first four innings, benefitting from two double-play grounders and escaping a bases-loaded jam in the fourth (removed after a two-out solo homer by Dasan Brown in the fifth)... May 5 vs Tampa: surrendered a grand slam and a two-run homer while walking 4 batters in 1.2 IP (removed after 54 pitches)... May 11 at Jupiter: allowed just four baserunners across season-high five scoreless innings, striking out a season-high seven (no-decision)... May 18 at Palm Beach: allowed just one unearned run over five innings, striking out six in a Marauders loss (no-decision)... May 25 vs Fort Myers: lasted just 3 innings, allowing a two-run double in the first and a two-run homer in the third... May 31 at Lakeland: first quality start, allowed season-high in hits (7 singles, 1 double) but stranded 8 runners... June 7 vs Clearwater: in piggyback outing behind Aaron Shortridge rehab, allowed just one run (RBI-double) while stranding four baserunners... Last Tuesday at Fort Myers: matched season-high with 7 K in just 3 IP (game was suspended due to lightning and completed the next day)...

2021: Posted a 2.63 ERA and 1.13 WHIP for FCL Pirates Gold, holding opponents to a .188 AVG... Struck out a career-high 10 batters in 5 hitless innings (0 BB) on July 17 vs FCL Pirates Black... Promoted to High-A Greensboro on September 10 and made two starts for the Grasshoppers (9 IP, 8 H, 5 R, 2BB/7K)...

2019: Enjoyed a successful second season with FCL Pirates 1, posting a 2.28 ERA and 1.03 WHIP and holding opponents to a .214 AVG...
