SPRINGFIELD CARDINALS (10-5, 41-42) vs. TULSA DRILLERS (10-5, 56-28)

SHP JURRANGELO CIJNTJE (3-4, 5.21 ERA) vs. RHP CARSON HOBBS (2-0, 4.34 ERA)

SETTING THE SCENE: The Cardinals and Drillers (Dodgers) play the 4th game of a 6-game set tonight at ONEOK Field ... the Drillers have taken the 2 of the 1st 3 games in the series ... SHP Jurrangelo Cijntje makes his team-leading 17th start opposite RHP Carson Hobbs.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Springfield is tied for 1st place in the 2nd half North Division standings with 1st-half champ Tulsa ... they are 3.0 games ahead of 3rd-place Arkansas ... the 2nd half winner (or 2nd-place finisher if Tulsa finishes 1st) will play Tulsa in the North Division Series ... Springfield is looking to reach the postseason for a 5th-straight season.

DRILL-VILLAINS: The Cardinals are 6-9 against the Drillers this season ... are 1-5 at home and 5-4 in Tulsa ... tonight's game is the 16th of 18 in the season series ... this week's series is the last of the regular season between the clubs.

SWITCH ON 'EM: SHP Jurrangelo Cijntje makes his 17th start of the season and his 3rd against the Drillers ... in his last start on 7/4 vs. Arkansas (his former team) he allowed only 3 hits over 6.0 shutout innings with 9 strikeouts and 3 walks ... was the 3rd time he'd gone 6.0 innings in a start to tie his season-high ... has an 11.05 ERA in 2 starts vs. Tulsa after giving up 10 runs (9 ER) in 7.1 innings with 14 strikeouts and 8 walks ... in his last start against them on 5/16 at Tulsa he struck out a season-high 10 batters over 4.1 innings while allowing 4 runs (3 ER) on 4 hits with 3 walks ... gave up a season-high 6 runs to Tulsa in his 2nd start of the season on 4/9.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Each Cardinal player recorded a hit in a 12-6 win over Tulsa ... Springfield had 15 hits including 9 extra-base hits ... scored 6 runs in 2nd, 3 in the 3rd, and built an 11-1 lead before Tulsa started chipping away.

THIS IS THE WEI: RHP Chen-Wei Lin evened his record at 3-3 after allowing 3 runs in 5.1 innings on Thursday night ... struck out 5 and walked 1.

THE CHO SHOW: OF Won-Bin Cho hit 2 home runs on Thursday night ... was his 2nd multi-homer game since joining Springfield ... in 12 Double-A games has hit 9 home runs (has 12 total hits).

BYE BYE BAEZ: IF Jesus Baez hit his 6th home run in his 13th game since joining Springfield on Thursday night ... has hit 20 homers combined between High-A and Double-A this season.

JUST LIKE HONEY: OF Travis Honeyman went 2x5 with a triple and 2 RBI Wednesday ... extended his hit streak to 8 games ... batting .343 (12x35) with 2 homers during the streak.

THE FUTURE IS HERE: C Rainiel Rodriguez and LHP Liam Doyle will represent the Cardinals in the All-Star Futures Game on Sunday at Citizens Bank Park in Philadelphia.

- Entered 2026 season ranked as the No. 6 prospect in Cardinals organization according to *Baseball America* and the No. 91 overall prospect in baseball according to *MLB Pipeline*
- Is designated as a switch-pitcher and will pitch both right-handed and left-handed with the Cardinals
- Drafted by Seattle in the 1st round (15th overall) in 2024 MLB Draft
- Originally drafted by Milwaukee in 18th round in 2022 MLB Draft, but did not sign
- Born in Gravenhague, Netherlands ... grew up primarily in Willemstad, Curaçao
- Played collegiately at Mississippi State ... went 11-7 with a 5.25 ERA over two seasons
- Graduated from Champagnat Catholic School in Hialeah, FL ... was rated No. 1 switch-pitcher in the nation and the No. 34 pitcher overall by Perfect Game
