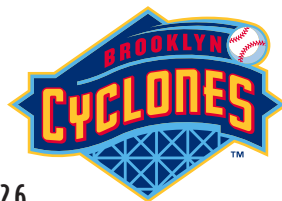

LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn dropped Friday's contest to Greenville, 3-0...All 3 runs for the Drive were scored in the top of the 6th...DH **Bryan González** provided a go-ahead 2-run double and 1B **Tyler Miller** followed with an RBI single...3B **Mateo Gil** provided the Cyclones only extra-base hit on a double...Greenville was 5-for-6 on stolen base attempts, including 3 for RF **Kier Meredith**...RHP **Christian Scott** punched out a career-high 9 over 5.0 shutout innings for Brooklyn...RHP **Paul Gervase** added a career-best 6 strikeouts in 3.0 innings of spotless relief...RHP **Hunter Dobbins** earned his 4th-straight win for the Drive after hoisting 7.0 frames of shutout ball...RHP **Nate Tellier** and RHP **Robert Kwiatkowski** united to complete the 4-hit shutout.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: After Thursday's postponement due to poor air quality, the Cyclones will battle Greenville in a doubleheader on Saturday...Brooklyn was swept in last Saturday's twinbill at Jersey Shore, dropping to 1-7 in doubleheader games in 2023...All 4 doubleheaders Brooklyn has played have been in visiting ballparks...This year, the 'Clones are 22-23 in regularly scheduled 9-inning games.

GREAT SCOTT! RHP **Christian Scott** punched out a career-high 9 batters in a no-decision vs. Greenville on Friday night...This came after the 23-year-old whiffed a then-career-best 8 in his first home start of 2023 vs. Winston-Salem on May 27...Over his last 4 starts dating back to Game 2 of May 21's doubleheader at Hudson Valley, Scott has permitted just 1 run on 6 hits over his last 18.0 innings...The former Florida Gator has walked 3 and punched out 22 (11.0 K/9 & 34.9 K%).

POWER OF PAUL: RHP **Paul Gervase** garnered a career-high 6 strikeouts over 3.0 spotless innings of relief on Friday evening vs. Greenville...The 23-year-old did not allow a hit and walked 1 hitter, tossing 40 pitches and a season-high 28 strikes...Among South Atlantic League relief pitchers with at least 20.0 innings pitched in 2023, Gervase ranks 2nd in ERA (1.46)...Only Rome's RHP **Luis Vargas** (1.11) has registered a better ERA in relief this season...Gervase averages 13.14 strikeouts-per-9-innings and holds a 32.7% strikeout rate.

JEFE JEFFREY: RHP **Jeffrey Colón** tossed another gem last Thursday night, earning his first win in 2023...The 23-year-old also matched a career-best with 9 strikeouts on May 26 vs. Winston-Salem...That equaled his total from last August 28 at Jersey Shore...In his last 3 appearances (2 starts), Colón is 1-0 with a 2.03 ERA (3 ER in 13.1 IP), allowing 10 hits and 5 walks, striking out 17...In his last 2 starts at Maimonides Park, Colón has hurled 13.1 innings, allowing just 3 runs on 9 hits...The Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native has a 2.03 ERA and permitted only 3 walks and punched out 16 in that span.

NOT SO STUART LITTLE: At 6-foot-9, RHP **Tyler Stuart** has been as consistent and imposing as any starting pitcher in the South Atlantic League in 2023...The 23-year-old permitted just 2 earned runs over 25.1 frames (0.71 ERA) in 5 starts during May...Stuart leads the SAL and all of High-A in ERA (1.43)...Only RHP **José Ramírez** (1.24) of Boston's Single-A Salem and LHP **Robby Snelling** (1.30) of San Diego's Single-A Lake Elsinore have a better marks...Stuart is also 9th in the circuit in WHIP (1.20)...The Kankakee, Ill. native leads the league in LOB% (87.2%) and FIP (2.81), 3rd in xFIP (3.41), 5th in strikeout rate (29.1%), and 6th in strikeouts per 9 innings (10.64).

RAMÍ ROCKETS: CF **Alex Ramírez** homered for the second-straight game on Tuesday night vs. Greenville...The 20-year-old pounded a game-tying 3-run home run to left in the 7th inning...Ramírez also tallied a solo blast in the 6th inning of Sunday's 9-3 win at Jersey Shore...It marked the 2nd time this season a Cyclone player has homered in consecutive games...RF **Stanley Consuegra** first accomplished the feat on April 14 and 15 at Winston-Salem...Ramírez is now tied for the team lead in home runs (5) with Consuegra and INF **Mateo Gil**...Alex enters Saturday on a 5-game hitting streak...He is 7-for-his-last-17 (.412) with 6 runs scored, a double, 2 home runs, 6 RBI, 3 walks, and 2 steals in that time...Since joining Brooklyn on July 4 of last year, the Mets' No. 2 prospect per MLB Pipeline leads the South Atlantic League in RBI (63), hits (110), doubles (26), extra-base hits (37), total bases (168)...Ramírez is 3rd in franchise history in RBI (63) trailing only teammate IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** (65), and INF **José Peroza** (69).

WALK (OFF) ON THE WILD SIDE: DH **Kevin Parada** delivered Brooklyn's 5th walk-off victory of 2023 with a bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 9th on Wednesday afternoon vs. Greenville...C **José Mena**'s added game-winning single in the bottom of the 9th on May 26...1B **Chase Estep** delivered a game-ending, bases-loaded walk in the 11th on Opening Day vs. Jersey Shore...LF **Alex Ramírez** registered a walk-off RBI single in the 11th vs. Wilmington on April 22 and LF **Omar De Los Santos** provided a game-winning single in the 10th vs. Aberdeen...The Cyclones have at least 1 walk-off win in each home series this year...Brooklyn garnered 4 walk-off wins through the entirety of the 2022 campaign... 20.8% (11-of-53) of Brooklyn's games this season have ended in walk-off fashion.

REMEMBER US?: This week marks the first time a Boston Red Sox affiliate has played at Maimonides Park since the Cyclones captured the final New York-Penn League championship against the Lowell Spinners in Game 3 of the 2019 NYPL Championship Series on September 10, 2019...PH **Alex Erro** — who made the final out for Lowell on a strikeout against LHP **Andrew Edwards** — OF **Nick Decker** and OF **Gilberto Jiménez** appeared in that contest and are currently on Greenville's roster...Jiménez is presently on the 7-day injured list...Current New York Mets 3B **Brett Baty** started in all 3 games of the series for Brooklyn.

vs. GREENVILLE: Brooklyn returns home to open up a 6-game homestand against the Red Sox' High-A affiliate...The Drive posses 6 of Boston's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: SS/3B **Eddinson Paulino** (9), RHP **Wikelman González** (12), 1B/3B **Blaze Jordan** (16), IF **Brainer Bonaci** (18), RHP **Ángel Bastardo** (24), and LHP **Dalton Rogers** (26)...Brooklyn and Greenville are meeting for the first time since the 2021 season...The Drive captured 4-of-6 from the Cyclones at Fluor Field in Greenville from May 11-16, 2021...This is the Drive's first-ever visit to Coney Island and the first by a Red Sox affiliate in the regular season since the Lowell Spinners came to town from June 18-20, 2019, in the New York-Penn League.

GOING, GOING, GIL: INF **Mateo Gil** has reached base safely in 17 of his last 18 games dating back to May 18 at Hudson Valley...The 22-year-old is slashing .271/.368/.576 and he has registered an impressive .944 OPS, 152 wRC+, .418 wOBA, and .305 ISO in that time...Gil is 16-for-59 at the plate (.271) with 11 runs scored, 6 doubles, 4 home runs, and 13 RBI adding 8 walks...Since that date, Gil is tied for 2nd in the league in extra-base hits (10), 3rd in slugging (.576), tied for 3rd in home runs (4), tied for 4th in RBI (13) and doubles (6), and 7th in OPS (.944).

THE BEST AROUND: The Cyclones' pitching staff has been marvelous over the course of the team's last 21 games...Since May 17, Brooklyn has permitted just 52 earned runs (68 total) on 145 hits through the last 187.0 innings...That is good for a 2.50 ERA...That mark is the best in the SAL and the High-A level...It is also the 3rd-best ERA in all of Minor League Baseball in that stretch...Only Kansas City's Single-A Columbia (2.47) and Washington's Single-A Fredericksburg (2.48) have posted lower marks...Cyclones' pitching has walked 82 (10.5 BB%) and struck out 224 in that span (28.7 K%)...The 'Clones have outscored opponents, 95-68, over the 22-game stretch... Brooklyn is 12-10 during that span.

RELIEF READY: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Saturday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.21) in the entire South Atlantic League and among all High-A teams...Hudson Valley (3.41) is 2nd in the circuit and the Twins' High-A Cedar Rapids is 2nd (3.27) at the classification...The Cyclones' relief ERA is also the best in the New York Mets' farm system and 4th best in all of MiLB... Kansas City's Single-A Columbia leads MiLB (3.08).

BLADE CUTS 'EM DOWN: RHP **Blade Tidwell** is in the midst of his best stretch of baseball in 2023...The 21-year-old did not factor into the decision on Sunday, but hurled 2.2 innings without allowing an earned run...Over his last 4 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 2-0 with a 1.10 ERA (2 ER in 16.1 IP) with just 6 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 16 and struck out 23...Tidwell's strikeout rate is 32.4% during the stretch and opponents hold a meager .106 batting average (6-55) against him.

ALL GAS, NO TE-BRAKE: RHP **Dylan Tebrake** has been nearly untouchable since being reinstated from Brooklyn's injured list...Since being activated on May 14, the 23-year-old has made 6 relief appearances...Tebrake has not allowed an earned run (1 total) on 3 hits and 3 walks over 9.1 innings, registering 15 strikeouts...That equates to a 42.9 K% (15/35).

OH YEAH, OMAR: In addition to his 21 stolen bases in 2023, OF **Omar De Los Santos** remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The 23-year-old has accumulated 91 stolen bases in that span, which is 5th most in MiLB...Only Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (97), Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdez** (97), Red Sox prospect INF **David Hamilton** (96), and Mariners prospect OF **Jonathan Clasé** (95) have swiped more...De Los Santos has also snagged 52 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 39...Omar is already 11 swipes shy of matching INF **Walter Rasquin**'s franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

CANARSIE'S CROWN PRINCE: IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** has scattered himself across the Cyclones' all-time leaderboards...Entering Saturday, the 22-year-old is Brooklyn's franchise record holder in games played (187), at-bats (617), plate appearances (738), runs scored (96), walks (101), and stolen bases (46)...Palmer passed INF **Ronny Mauricio** '21 (63) for 2nd place in Cyclones history in RBI (65) on May 23, added an RBI on May 27, and is 4 behind INF **José Peroza** (69) for the all-time mark...The Canarsie, Brooklyn native is 2nd all-time in total bases (192), tied for 5th in home runs (15), and 5th in hits (114).

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn boast the top 2 Mets per MLB Pipeline in C **Kevin Parada** and CF **Alex Ramírez**...They also hold 3 of the Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America* and 5 of the Top 30...They include **Parada** (No. 1 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), **Ramírez** (2/5), and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (5/9)... INF **William Lugo** (23/26) and RHP **Christian Scott** (27/26) also appears on both lists... OF **Stanley Consuegra** ranks as the organization's No. 18 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.

PROSPECT RADAR: Entering the 2023 season, *Baseball America* deemed Colón one of the Mets’ “14 Prospects to Watch Beyond The Top 30”

JEFE JEFFREY: Colón earned his first win in 2023 last Thursday...The 23-year-old also matched a career-best with 9 strikeouts on May 26 vs. Winston-Salem...That equaled his total from last August 28 at Jersey Shore...In his last 3 appearances (2 starts), Colón is 1-0 with a 2.03 ERA (3 ER in 13.1 IP), allowing 10 hits and 5 walks, striking out 17...In his last 2 starts at Maimonides Park, Colón has hurled 13.1 innings, allowing just 3 runs on 9 hits...The Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native has a 2.03 ERA and permitted only 3 walks and punched out 16 in that span.

2022: Assigned to Single-A St. Lucie from extended spring training on June 1...Registered a 3-0 record with a 3.23 ERA (17 ER in 47.1 IP), 2 saves, and 57 strikeouts in 13 appearances (4 starts) with the Mets...Transferred to High-A Brooklyn on August 8...Composed a 1-0 mark with a 1.07 ERA (3 ER in 25.1 IP), 2 saves, and 27 strikeouts in 6 appearances (3 starts) for the Cyclones.

FINISHING STRONG: After joining the Cyclones on August 8, Colón was one of the most dominant pitchers in the South Atlantic League through the remainder of the season...Among pitchers with at least 25.0 innings pitched, the right-hander was 2nd in the circuit in ERA (1.07)...He also yielded the fewest hits (13), tied for the fewest runs allowed (3), and ranked 3rd in WHIP (0.79) and batting average against (.153).

FLORIDA’S FINEST: During his stint with St. Lucie, Colón was among the elite producing arms in the Florida State League...From June 1 until the time of his promotion to Brooklyn, the Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native was 2nd in the circuit in ERA (3.23) and tied for 3rd in strikeouts (57)...He was also 3rd in WHIP (1.10), 4th in innings pitched (47.1), and 5th in batting average against (.227).

2022: Signed with New York for \$220,000...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 11...Tossed 1.0 scoreless inning at FCL Astros Blue before joining Single-A St. Lucie on August 16...Yielded 4 runs on 4 hits, striking out 6, in 2.2 innings over 2 appearances (1 start)...Placed on the 7-day injured list for the remainder of the season on August 30.

NEW ROLE: Despite primarily serving as a relief pitcher in college, Stuart is expected to make his 11th professional start on Saturday...In those outings, he is 1-0 with a 1.55 ERA (8 ER in 46.1 IP), adding 57 strikeouts (11.07 SO/9)...The Kankakee, Ill. native made only 4 starts throughout his collegiate tenure, all coming in his final season during 2022.
