**POWER SURGE:** The Omaha Storm Chasers scored 13 runs on 14 hits—including three home runs—to defeat the Columbus Clippers, 13-10, on Saturday at Huntington Park. **INF Bobby Witt Jr.** put Omaha in front for good with a grand slam in the second inning. **INF/OF Ryan McBroom** followed with a solo home run as part of a three-run third inning, while **C Nick Dini** homered in the fifth for his third home run in as many days. **OF Anderson Miller** drove in a pair in a 3-for-4 game, **OF Kyle Isbel** scored three runs and stole two bases, including home on a double steal with Miller, in a 2-for-4 performance. Miller (2), Isbel (2), and **OF Rudy Martin** combined to steal five bases, tying a season high for Omaha. Columbus scored three runs in the bottom of the ninth to bring the potential tying run to the plate, but **RHP Tyler Zuber** recorded the final out on a sliding grab in shallow left by Witt Jr. to end the game.

**WUNDERKIND WITT:** **INF Bobby Witt Jr.** is 7-for-23 (.304) with four home runs, 11 RBIs and eight runs scored in five games this week against Columbus. He started the week with a three-run homer in the 11th inning of Tuesday's 11-7 (11) win, went 3-for-5 with a solo homer on Wednesday, hit a go-ahead, two-run homer in the eighth inning on Friday, and tied a career-high with five RBIs on Saturday, a game that included his first career grand slam. The 21-year-old's four home runs in the last five games give him seven at the Triple-A level in 17 games and 23 total home runs this season, a mark that's tied for fourth in all of Minor League Baseball. Since joining the Storm Chasers on July 20, Witt Jr., the No. 4 prospect in baseball and the top prospect in the Royals' organization according to *Baseball America*, is batting .295/.353/.628 with five doubles, seven home runs, 16 RBIs, 18 runs scored, and three stolen bases.

**MONDESI ON THE MEND:** **SS Adalberto Mondesi** is 0-for-7 with three strikeouts in three rehab games with Omaha while playing 13.0 defensive innings at shortstop. Friday marked Mondesi's 11th total rehab assignment game of the season between Omaha (six games) and Northwest Arkansas (five games). In 10 games with Kansas City across two stints, Mondesi is 13-for-36 (.361) with five doubles and four home runs.

**McBOOM GOES THE DYNAMITE:** **INF/OF Ryan McBroom** has homered in three of his last five games after going 11 games without a home run from 7/17 (1)-8/1. He currently leads the league with 21 home runs while ranking third in Triple-A East with 57 RBIs. McBroom is also second in runs scored (54), seventh in extra-base hits (31) and ninth in total hits (76). He has hit cleanup in Omaha's lineup in 67 of the team's 81 games. In a team-high 76 games, McBroom is batting .262/.337/.521. His 21 home runs are five shy of tying his career high of 26, which he set in 117 games with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre in 2019 before being traded to Kansas City. McBroom has homered once every 15.

**ROCKY ROAD:** The Omaha Storm Chasers are 24-11 (.686) at Werner Park, but 23-23 (.500) in road games this season. In 46 road games, Omaha is batting .246/.332/.453 with 77 home runs and a league-worst 5.82 road ERA. In 35 home games, the Chasers are batting .278/.347/.488 with 62 home runs and a 4.06 ERA.

**ON THE PODIUM:** The United States fell, 2-0, to Japan in Saturday's Gold Medal Game to earn silver while the Dominican Republic defeated South Korea, 10-6, to earn bronze. **OF Bubba Starling** went 2-for-7 (.286) for Team USA to earn a silver medal while **OF Jack Lopez** ('18) went 2-for-14 (.143). **INF/OF Erick Mejia** went 6-for-21 (.286) for the Dominican Republic and was named to the All-Olympic Baseball Team at third base. The bronze medal for the Dominican Republic is the first medal in baseball in the country's history. The silver medal for the United States is the country's first silver medal in baseball and fourth medal in baseball overall ('96 Bronze, '00 Gold, '08 Bronze).

**FOR OMAHA:** **RHP Eddie Butler** makes his 10th start (and 22nd appearance) with Omaha and his sixth consecutive turn through the rotation after making four spot starts in the first two months of the season. Butler allowed five runs on a season-high-tying nine hits on 8/3 @ COL in the series opener while issuing a season-high four walks. The right-hander has allowed 17 runs on 23 hits in his last 14.1 innings, spanning his last three starts. Following his start on Tuesday, Butler shaved his head, his first haircut since August of 2020.

**FOR COLUMBUS:** **RHP Cody Morris** makes his Triple-A debut with Columbus. After being reinstated from the Injured list (shoulder soreness), he struck out 12 in 4.1 innings in a rehab appearance with ACL Indians on 7/1. In five starts with Double-A Akron since, Morris has a 1.35 ERA in 20.0 innings, striking out 29 and walking seven. Morris was a seventh round pick (223rd overall) by Cleveland in 2018 from South Carolina.

**DOPPLER RADAR:** Omaha (47-34) has the second-best record in the organization, trailing High-A Quad Cities (55-26) which has the third-best record in Minor League Baseball. Northwest Arkansas is 44-39 and Columbia is 38-44.

- Signed with Kansas City as MiLB FA on 5/5
- Made Omaha and Royals organization debut on 5/12 @ COL
- Had recently signed with the independent Southern Maryland Blue Crabs when contract was purchased by Kansas City
- Spent the 2020 season with the independent Chicago Dogs of the American Association, posting a 5.85 ERA in 12 appearances (11 starts), striking out 40 and walking 24 in 65.1 innings
- Pitched for NC Dinos of the Korean Baseball Organization in 2019, making 13 starts and recording a 4.76 ERA in 73.2 innings with 49 strikeouts and 28 walks
- Began the 2018 season making eight relief appearances for the Chicago (NL) before being traded to Texas along with Rollie Lacy and a PTBNL for Cole Hamels
- Made 22 relief appearances for the Rangers in 2018, recording a 6.47 ERA in 32.0 innings
- Has never pitched against Omaha despite spending parts of five seasons pitching in the Pacific Coast League
- Made MLB debut with Colorado on June 6, 2014 vs. Los Angeles (NL)
- Prior to the 2014 season, was the No. 24 prospect in baseball according to Baseball America
- Drafted by Colorado in the 1st round (46th overall) of the 2012 MLB Draft out of Radford University
- Was the second first-round pick for Colorado in 2012, following David Dahl (10th overall)
- Earned Big South Pitcher of the Year honors with Radford in 2012 (shared with Aaron Burke) after posting a school-record 2.20 ERA
- Was initially drafted by Texas in the 35th round of the 2009 MLB Draft but did not sign
