### LAST GAME

The Baysox snapped a three-game skid Friday night with a 4-1 victory over the Richmond Flying Squirrels. Right-handed starter Jean Pinto set the tone for the Baysox. After allowing a first inning solo home run to Vaun Brown, Pinto yielded no further damage on the night, giving up just three total hits, no walks, and striking out five through six stellar frames, tossing just 60 pitches in the process. Right-hander Alex Pham went the remainder of the way for Bowie, pitching the final three innings, striking out five on just two hits and one walk for his first save at the Double-A level. Offensively, Zach Watson led the way with his first three-hit effort of the season, including an RBI single in the top of the first, while Joseph Rosa added a pair of RBI with a single in the fourth and a sacrifice fly in the sixth, before Tim Susnara added a sacrifice fly of his own in the eighth inning.

### TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Richmond Flying Squirrels enter the series with an overall record of 41-38. The Double-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants, Richmond leads the way in the Southwest division second half standings after winning seven of their first eight contests. The Flying Squirrels hold the best ERA as a staff in the Eastern League (3.64) and have made the third-fewest errors defensively (56). Richmond's roster includes nine of the Giants' top 30 prospects (via MLB Pipeline) - INF Marco Luciano (No. 2 SF/No. 18 overall), OF Vaun Brown (No. 5 SF), LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 8 SF), RHP Mason Black (No. 10 SF), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 13 SF), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 17 SF), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 26 SF), RHP Jose Cruz (No. 29 SF), and OF Wade Meckler (No. 30 SF).

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Ryan Murphy is set to get the ball for Richmond. The No. 26 prospect in the Giants' system, per MLB Pipeline, Murphy has pitched to a plethora of contact, allowing 59 hits across 56 innings, including nine home runs - second-most on the staff. Murphy started a pair of games last week in Reading, going four hitless frames on Wednesday with five strikeouts, before allowing a run on three hits through 3.2 innings in Monday's series finale. Murphy has pitched twice against Bowie this season, spanning four innings on both occasions. He allowed a run on two hits with four strikeouts on 4/29, before yielding two runs on three hits with a walk and three strikeouts on 6/15, including a solo home run to Coby Mayo. Murphy pitched collegiately at Division II Le Moyne (NY) alongside MLB arm Josiah Gray in 2018. He features a Low-90s fastball, along with a slider, curveball, and changeup.

### THE A-MAYO-ZING COBY

INF Coby Mayo has been a balanced mix of power, patience, and run production at the plate for the Baysox. Mayo's 49 extra-base hits on the season are the most in Minor League Baseball. The No. 8 Orioles' No. 78 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, also leads the Double-A level in doubles (30), OPS (1.044) and slugging (.616) on the campaign. Mayo has demolished Richmond pitching this season, posting an average of .353 with seven doubles, a triple, and three home runs against the Flying Squirrels. Mayo was named Eastern League Player of the Month on Thursday, after hitting .340 with an 1.178 OPS, 10 doubles, and eight home runs.

### STAY HOT, SERVIDEO

Anthony Servideo is coming off one of his best stretches at the Double-A level thus far. Servideo went 6-for-18 this past week with two doubles and his first career Double-A home run. Servideo has gone 3-for-12 this week, and is now 14 for his last 37 (.378), in addition to 11 walks in his past 13 games after having just five in his first 32 games at the Double-A level. Servideo has also collected eight multi-hit games since the start of June, after having just six-career multi-hit games prior.

### AVOIDING THE TRAFFIC

Bowie's bats bounced back in a big way from a recent rough stretch last night. After going just 2-for-25 (.080) with runners in scoring position and leaving 27 runners on-base through the first three games of the series, the Baysox went 4-for-15 in such situations in Friday night's victory. In total, Bowie is hitting .230 as a team with runners in scoring position - the third-lowest total in the Eastern League, and just .186 as a team with runners in scoring position across its 16 previous games, prior to Friday.

### K'D POVICH

Left-handed starter Cade Povich has accumulated strikeouts with the best of them, leading the Eastern League with 99 on the season - also second in Double-A and fifth in all of Minor League Baseball. Povich has struck out at least seven batters in eight of fifteen starts this season, including double-digits on three occasions. Povich, however, has struggled with inconsistency at points. The left-hander has also failed to pitch into the fifth inning in eight occasions in 2023.

## CAREER NOTES

- Went 2-2 with a 6.94 ERA in 6 appearances (5 starts) for the Baysox last season.
- Had a sensational start to his time in the Orioles' system, winning the organization's Pitcher of the Month honors after 4-0 with a 2.57 ERA with 34 strikeouts to just 7 walks across 28 innings, between Aberdeen and Bowie
- Struggled in September, as he allowed 10 ER in 7.1 IP in the month, including allowing 4 in 1.2 innings against Akron in the season's final game on 9/18, in what would be a loss to eliminate the Baysox from postseason contention.
- Had a 4.08 ERA in 20 appearances (19 starts) for the Twins' organization across two seasons.
- Spent parts of two seasons with the Nebraska Cornhuskers, only full season was 2021, where he finished 6-1 with a 3.11 ERA in 81 innings.

## NOTES BY OUTING\*

- Allowed two early baserunners in the first with none out, but stranded both. Got two quick ground outs in the second inning, but allowed the next four batters to reach, including three hits, needing 28 pitches in the inning. Faced the minimum in the third.
- Struck out five of the first eight batters faced. Allowed two baserunners in the third, only inning to allow multiple runners.
- Allowed three runs in the first inning on two walks and two hits, needing 32 pitches for the frame. Two more runs in the third inning on a single, triple, and passed ball.
- Front end of a doubleheader, struck out seven batters in his first trip through the order. Only hit allowed was a two-out double in the third. **Eastern League Pitcher of the Week**
- Struck out three batters over first two innings, but allowed two runs in the third including a solo home run. Struck out four more batters, but back-to-back two-out base hits in the fifth forced his exit.
- Struck out seven of first 11 batters faced. Faced one over the minimum through four innings, but allowed two singles to start the fifth inning before striking out the side. **Eastern League Pitcher of the Week**
- Allowed each of the first three batters to reach base, and all to score on two sacrifice flies and a double. Allowed two more runners to move into scoring position, but none to third base.
- After Bowie had taken a 2-0 lead in the second, allowed a walk and game-tying two-run home run in the bottom of the frame. Only allowed two baserunners over final three innings.
- Faced the minimum over the first two innings thanks to a double play. Allowed three doubles. First five batters reached safely in the fifth inning.
- Gave up a single and home run to the first two batters. Needed 71 pitches for just the first three innings. Allowed a second two-run home run in the fourth. Career high in hits allowed
- Gave up a two-run home run to second batter of the second inning. Allowed two more runs in the following innings on three-consecutive two-out hits.
- Struck out the first six batters, and seven of the first eight. Carried a perfect game into the seventh inning before allowing a leadoff single. **Eastern League Pitcher of the Week**
- Stranded error at third base in first inning, and threw perfect second. Allowed first five batters of the third inning to reach, including two walks and a hit batter.
- Allowed a leadoff home run in the second inning, and back-to-back home runs to lead off the fourth inning, before walking the next three batters, and failing to escape the frame.
- Allowed three runs on back-to-back home runs with two outs in the first inning. Allowed two more base hits in the second, but picked off one runner, and faced the minimum over the next 13 batters.
