

MENDDZA'S BLAST CAPS CARDS COMEBACK: Ramon Mendoza hit a three-run homer with two outs in the bottom of the 8th inning to break a 3-3 tie and the Cardinals overcame a 3-1 deficit going into the 7th inning to defeat the NW Arkansas Naturals 6-3 on Saturday night at Hammons Field. **Mike Antico** also delivered in the clutch for Springfield with a pinch-hit two-run single with two outs in the bottom of the 7th to tie the game at three. **Jimmy Crooks** extended his hitting streak to 6 games with an RBI single in the 3rd inning and the Springfield bullpen duo of **Andrew Marrero** and **Matt Svanson** combined to fire 3.1 scoreless frames in relief of **Quinn Mathews**.



DPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Zebby Matthews** makes his 9th start (10th appearance) of the season for the Wind Surge in the series opener...Last pitched on Wednesday, July 3 against the Drillers and did not factor in the decision, allowing 2 ER on 4 H with 6 K and 0 BB over 6.0 IP...Has not allowed more than 3 ER in any start this season and is averaging 5.2 IP per appearance...Holds a K:BB ration of 87:4... Took the loss against the Cardinals on May 28 at Riverfront Stadium allowing 2 ER on 5 H over 5.0 IP... Began the season at High-A Cedar Rapids where he went 3-0 with a 1.59 ERA in 4 starts (22.0 IP), striking out 28 without walking a batter before his promotion the 2nd week of May...Spent his first full season in 2023 split between Low-A Fort Myers and Cedar Rapids going 7-3 wiht a 3.84 ERA in 22 appearances (20 starts), registering a 112:15 K:BB in 105.1 IP...Selected by the Twins in the 8th round of the 2022 draft out of Western Carolina and signed for a below-slot \$125,000...Fastball has ticked up to the mid-to-upper 90's after entering Twins system...Pitched in both a starting and relief role as a junior at WCU and led the Southern Conference with 122 K to just 21 BB...Began college career at Walters State...24 years old

CARDS, SURGE SQUARE OFF FOR FINAL TIME AT HAMMONS FIELD: The Cardinals head into the All-Star break with a six-game series at home against the Wichita Wind Surge (Double-A, Minnesota Twins), the final regular season meeting between the two in Springfield. The Cardinals swept a six-game series from Wichita in April at Hammons and come into the series 11-1 in the season sereis.

CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD



The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

CARDS' RADIO HOME

For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

EDMAN REHABBING IN SPRINGFIELD: Cardinals utilityman Tommy Edman begins a rehab stint in Springfield tonight. The 5-year veteran is recovering from right wrist surgery last October and has not played in a game yet this season. In 137 games with St. Louis in 2023, Edman batted .248 with 13 HR and 47 RBIs while going 27-for-31 in SB playing 2B, SS, CF and RF. He won a Gold Glove Award at 2B in 2021. Edman and the Cardinals agreed to a 2-year, \$16.5 million deal in January.

IT'S GETTING HOT IN HERE: After dropping 4 of their first 5 games to start the 2nd half, the Cardinals have won 6 of their last 7 to run their 2nd-half record to 7-5. Springfield had a 5-game winning streak snapped by NW Arkansas on Friday night, their longest since winning 9 in a row to start the season.

HOME COOKING TASTING BETTER: With wins in 3 of their last 4 games at Hammons Field, the Cardinals are doing their best to reverse their fortunes at home. Over their last four home games, during which the Cardinals have outscored their opponent 24-10, Springfield has lowered its home ERA from 6.07 to 5.64. Going into Sunday's game against the Travelers the Cards had dropped 11 of their last 12 and 22 of 28 at Hammons Field after an 8-0 start to the season. The Cards are now 17-23 (.425) at home this season.

On the road, the Cardinals have a league-best 27-14 record on the road this season and have the 2nd-best road ERA at 3.55, just 0.10 behind Frisco and tops in the North Division.

PITCHING LEADING THE WAY: The Cardinals pitching staff has been the backbone for the club winning 6 of their last 7. The Cards have the best mark in the North Division and are 3rd in the Texas League, behind Frisco and San Antiono, with a 2.29 ERA since June 30.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER: The Cardinals bullpen has especially been up to the task, going 5-1 during this most recent stretch with a 2.01 ERA. Matt Svanson and Jack Ralston have combined to convert all 3 save opportunities. Birds relievers have thrown 31.1 innings over the Cards last 7 games for an average of 4.1 per game and have allowed just 7 ER.

CROOKS CRUSHING: Springfield C Jimmy Crooks has been filling up the box score recently. Over his last 11 games since June 23, the last day of the first half, Crooks is batting .432 (16-for-37) with 2 2B, a 3B, 2 HR, 10 RBIs and a 1.203 OPS. Crooks has hit safely and driven in at least one run in each of his last 5 games.

Crooks is now tied with Bryan Torres for the Texas League lead in batting at .312, while also leading the circuit in OBP among gualified hitters (.422). The Cardinals' catcher leads all active, gualified hitters in the league with an OPS of .868, trailing only Midland's Colby Thomas (.908) who is now playing in Triple-A.

RED-HOT RIVAS: Cardinals SS Jeremy Rivas is enjoying a breakout campaign at the plate in 2024, and has been swinging it well recently. Rivas is batting .367 (18-for-49) over his last 14 games with 3 2B, a HR, and is 4-for-4 in SB. For the season Rivas is batting .304/.384/.363, a drastic improvement over his line at High-A Peoria last season (.209/.293/.277). He has also cut his strikeout rate from 22.3% to 16.1% while raising his BB rate from 9.9% to 11.1%.

THE FUTURE IS BRIGHT: Major League Baseball announced the AL and NL rosters for the 25th annual All-Star Futures Game, and two Cardinals pitchers were honored with a nod. RHP Tink Hence will be taking part in the event for the 2nd straight season, and LHP Quinn Mathews also received the honor in his first full season of professional baseball. The game will take place Saturday, July 13 at Globe Life Field in Arlington, TX.

REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY: With his

go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger Chandler Redmond tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with Xavier Scruggs (2010-13). Redmond already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 220.

Since tying the record, however, Redmond has gone 42 straight games without a home run.
