ABOUT LAST NIGHT: RHP **Daison Acosta** earned the save in the ninth inning, stranding the bases loaded, sealing a 2-1 victory over the Wilmington Blue Rocks to push Brooklyn's winning streak to seven games. C **Jose Mena** went 2-for-3 two doubles, including the go-ahead RBI double in Brooklyn's two-run bottom of the fourth inning. Cyclones starter RHP **Junior Santos** allowed an unearned run in the first inning when OF **Justin Connell** scored from first base on an error by OF **Alex Ramirez**. Santos earned the win, finishing with one unearned run over 5 2/3 innings, including seven strikeouts and one walk.

HOW GOOD A WEEK WAS IT?: In the six-game sweep in Lakewood, NJ last week, the Cyclones outscored the BlueClaws 53-18 and finished the head-to-head matchup having won the final 13 matchups.

SHERVYEN FOR PRESIDENT: INF **Shervyen Newton** won the South Atlantic League's Offensive Player of the Week Award for his week in New Jersey against the Phillies High-A farm club, going 9-for-23 (.391) with three doubles, three home runs, 10 RBIs, and eight runs scored in the six-game sweep.

ON THE PLUS SIDE: Brooklyn sits 63-58 which is five games better than .500 for the first time since all season. At Brooklyn's lowest point, the Cyclones were nine games under at 22-31 on June 10.

DIVISION ON THE LINE: Including today, the Cyclones have 11 games remaining and two series: five more games vs. Wilmington, and six games at Winston-Salem. Brooklyn is vying for a playoff spot with a second half division title in the North Division of the South Atlantic League, sitting in second place just a half game behind first place Hudson Valley.

PEROZA PRODUCING: Since July 9, INF **Jose Peroza** has a OPS of .902 over his past 41 games with a 28-game on-base streak. The 22-year-old Vene-

vs. WILMINGTON: The Washington Nationals affiliate comes back to Coney Island for the final meeting of 2022. The Blue Rocks, from Wilmington, DE are 12-10 against the Cyclones in 2022. Wilmington hosts four of Washington's Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline: No. 10 OF Jeremy De La Rosa, No. 27 LHP Mitchell Parker, No. 29 LHP Evan Lee, and No. 30 C Drew Millas. The Blue Rocks enter Tuesday's game eight games behind first place.

BREAKING THROUGH IN YEAR TWO: OF **Alex Ramirez** leads all Mets minor leaguers with 126 hits, sitting 11 hits ahead of 3B **Brett Baty** who has stopped accumulating minor league hits, now playing third base for the New York Mets. Ramirez also leads the organization with seven triples. The No. 4 Mets prospect is having a breakout season with a .784 OPS and 11 of his 16 career home runs and 67 of his 102 RBIs.

JT JOLTING: Since returning from injury on August 17, 1B **JT Schwartz** is hitting .326 with a .885 OPS, going 15-46 with five doubles, a home run in 11 games. Coincidentally, Schwartz's first game back from injury was also the day he fell from the No. 19 spot in MLB Pipeline's Top 30 Mets list to being out of the ranking.

MASTERS OF THEIR DOMAIN: The Cyclones have allowed the fewest runs in the league and the second-fewest in Minor League Baseball, having allowed 478 runs in 121 games (4.0 runs/game).

HELLO: Mets No. 28 prospect Christian Scott makes his second High-A start against the Wilmington Blue Rocks -- the team he made his league debut against.

PITCH COUNT: Scott has not lasted more than four innings per outing with the Cyclones as the Mets have him on a strict pitch count. With Brooklyn, Scott has been capped at no more than 68 pitches (last outing)

GATOR BLUE TO MET BLUE: Scott was drafted by New York in the fifth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Florida, signing for around the slot value of \$350,000. At Florida, pitched as a reliever for his three years on campus, sitting mid-90s while touching 98.

COPYING MAD MAX: Christian Scott emulated New York Mets starter Max Scherzer's slider grip. He uses his repertoire of fastball and slider while trying to incorporate a change-up.

CONTROL FREAK: The Floridian posted a 4% walk rate as a junior at Florida ahead of his draft selection. During his time with St. Lucie, Scott posted a 7% walk rate.

HIGH SCHOOL: Scott went undrafted out of Calvary Christian High School in Fort Lauderdale, FL -- a school that produced current No. 1 Philadelphia prospect Andrew Painter who is on the Jersey Shore roster.
