Last Night: Lugnuts 13, Cubs 9. Lansing knocked out debuting South Bend starter Luis Devers two outs into the game, scoring seven runs in the first inning. But the Cubs ended Lansing starter Mitch Myers' night in the second inning with a six-run rally en route to grabbing a 9-7 lead with nine straight runs. But Max Muncy drilled a three-run oppo go-ahead home run in the seventh inning, jumpstarting a run of six unanswered tallies for the Nuts, leading to the victory. Still, the game was not secured until Tyler Baum fanned Kevin Alcantara with the bases loaded in the ninth.

Starting Matchup: The Lugnuts have a piggyback tandem scheduled for tonight, with lefty Brady Basso, returning from Tommy John surgery, making his sixth start of the year, followed by Opening Day starter Joelvis Del Rosario. The Cubs counter with the seventh overall pick in the 2022 draft, Oklahoma standout Cade Horton.

On the Air: Today's game is available on Bally Live and MiLB TV with Brendan King and Max Thoma, and via StreamGuys with Jesse Goldberg-Strassler on the call.

On Deck: The Lugnuts and Cubs play through Sunday, and then the Nuts return to Lansing to welcome in the Peoria Chiefs for a six-game homestand running from June 13-18.

Lug•Notes

Player Movement: Shortly before yesterday's game, the Lugnuts placed catcher Hansen López and pitcher Hunter Breault on the Injured List, adding infielder Mariano Ricciardi from Single-A Stockton and catcher Carlos Amaya from the Arizona Complex League.

Turnaround: Outfielder Junior Pérez opened the year batting .082 (5-for-60) in his first 20 games, including a streak of 32 consecutive hitless atbats. In 22 games since then, he is hitting an even .300 (24-for-80) and enters tonight on a seven-game hitting streak. In four games in May alone, he is 6-for-15 with three doubles, two walks and two steals. Pérez, acquired via trade from the San Diego Padres in 2020, went 2-for-4 with a walk, a single, a double, a stolen base and three runs scored yesterday.

On a High: Last night's performance marked the Lugnuts' highest single inning run output of the year (seven runs in the 1st) and highest single game run total of the year. Lansing is now up to fourth in the league with a .237 batting average

1st Impression: Second baseman Mariano Ricciardi made his Lugnuts debut yesterday with a 3-for-5 showing, including two hits in his very first inning as Nut. Ricciardi is the 910th all-time player to suit up for the Nuts.

Balance is the Key: Every member of the starting lineup collected at least one hit and scored at least one run last night. Not coincidentally, the Lugnuts finished 7-for-9 with runners in scoring position and only stranded four runners on the bases.

Among the MWL Leaders: Outfielder Jonny Butler is second in the Midwest League with five triples and tied for ninth with 12 stolen bases. Starting pitcher Jack Perkins is second in the league with a .188 batting average allowed, fifth with a 2.89 ERA, third with a 1.03 WHIP and seventh with 46 2/3 innings pitched. Relief pitcher Tyler Baum is tied for eighth with five saves. Catcher Daniel Susac is sixth with 51 base hits, fifth with a .293 batting average, tied for eighth with 77 total bases, tenth with an .802 OPS and tenth with a .443 slugging percentage

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old Max Muncy was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 22-year-old Daniel Susac was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

2014: Five Lugnuts errors (LF Derrick Loveless 2, 3B Mitch Nay 2, 2B Jason Leblebijian 1) led to eight Great Lakes Loons unearned runs in a 12-10 Loons 11-inning win in Lansing. Each team collected 17 hits in the game.

2016: 1B Juan Kelly, OF Andrew Guillotte and P Jon Harris, Dusty Isaacs and Angel Perdomo were all named Eastern Division All-Stars.

Personal: Brady's last name is pronounced "bass-o," with 'bass" like the fish rather than the instrument... got married during the 2020-2021 offseason after spending 2020 hiatus planning his wedding in addition to preparing for the 2021 season... made seven appearances for the Lugnuts in 2021 before suffering ACL tear... 687 days between MiLB appearances, June 15, 2021, and May 3, 2023, in returning from Tommy John.

Raising Expectations: An MLB.com article from Athletics MiLB camp by Jonathan Mayo on April 28, 2021, carried a bit of surprising news on a couple of breakout pitchers, specifically, as Mayo wrote, "Brady Basso's role is changing. A lefty who signed for just \$75,000 as a 16th-round pick in the 2019 Draft out of Oklahoma State, Basso pitched almost exclusively in relief in college and threw well in that role in the Rookie-level Arizona League in 2019. Now that he's up to 95-96 mph with his fastball to go along with a curve that flashes plus and a work-in-progress changeup, he's gong to get the chance to start." Melissa Lockard, writing for The Athletic on May 2, 2021, included Basso in her Lugnuts preview, writing, "Left-hander Brady Basso (2019, 16th round) opened a lot of eyes this spring with his fastball sitting at 95-97 mph."

Pro Debut: Brady pitched for Athletics Gold in the AZL after signing: 15 G, 1 GS, 1.64 ERA, 25 2/3 IP, 0 HR, 8 BB, 38 K... limited right-handed hitters to .194/.257/.313 in 74 PA, while lefties hit .250/.344/.286 in 32 PA... opposing base stealers were nabbed twice out of three attempts... made first professional start on 8/16/19, tossing three innings with 4 K's.

Draft Day: Basso was selected 494th overall in the 16th round of the 2019 draft from Oklahoma State... scout: Chris Reilly... signed for \$75,000... in the same round, two all-name players were drafted: the Tigers selected Kona Quiggle and the Blue Jays took Jackxarel Lebron... one of eight OSU Cowboys to be drafted in 2019... joins 2022 ninth-rounder Caeden Trenkle as Oklahoma State Cowboys on the current Lugnuts roster.

College Days: Brady was primarily a reliever at Oklahoma State (12 G, 2 GS as freshman; 18 G, 5 GS as sophomore; 14 G, 0 GS as a junior)... after a rough sophomore season (8.27 ERA), rebounded as a junior (1.64 ERA, 11.0 IP, 6 H, 16 K)... majored in finance in Stillwater with the intention of becoming a financial advisor after his playing career ends.

Let Your Babies Grow Up to be Cowboys: Oklahoma State players in MLB have included Allie Reynolds, Robin Ventura, Jeromy Burnitz, Pete Incaviglia, Mickey Tettleton, Mike Henneman, Doug Dascenzo, Andrew Heaney, Matt Hague and Jordy Mercer.

Baseball Runs in the Family: Brady's father, Mike, played in the minors for nine seasons in the San Diego Padres system, 1986-1994, rising as high as Triple-A... after retiring as a player, immediately began managing in 1995 at age 30, and managed in the Padres' org. from 1995-2000... joined the Toronto Blue Jays and managed in the Jays system in 2003-2006 and 2009... spent the next decade as an MLB scout before being let go by the Pittsburgh Pirates in 2020.

Hometown: Hails from Pearland ("PAIR-land"), Texas, south of Houston... during senior year at Pearland H.S., posted 0.48 ERA, with 101 strikeouts in 57 innings... named All-District in football, averaging 29.9 yards per catch as a receiver with one primary route: go deep... also from Pearland H.S.: Kirk Dressendorfer, Clay Hensley and Robbie Weinhardt; Megan Thee Stallion spent her teen years living in Pearland.

The King: First name is pronounced "yo-elvis," with the emphasis on the middle syllable... one other Joelvis played professional baseball, Joelvis Gonzalez, a Twins prospect from Venezuela in 2006-07 who hit .270 in 79 games but never made it higher than rookie ball... making his fourth consecutive relief appearance.

Lugnuts Lineage: Del Rosario tossed 4 2/3 scoreless innings as the Opening Day starter, April 7 at Great Lakes... he joined such other Opening Day Lugnuts starters as: Blaine Mull (1996), Steve Hueston (1997), Justin Pederson (1998), Mike Wuertz (1999), Matt Bruback (2000), Wilton Chavez (2001), Angel Guzman (2002), Andrew Sisco (2003), Sean Marshall (2004), Casey Janssen (2005), Chi-Hung Cheng (2006), Zach Dials (2007), Trystan Magnuson (2008), Henderson Alvarez (2009), Ryan Shopshire (2010), Misaul Diaz (2011), Noah Syndergaard (2012), Javier Avendano (2013), Jairo Labourt (2014), Chase De Jong (2015), Jon Harris (2016), Justin Maese (2017), Yennsy Diaz (2018), Josh Winckowski (2019), Seth Shuman (2021) and Grant Holman (2022).

Home Cooking: Also from Santiago: Jose Lima, Santiago Espinal, Joaquin Benoit, Willy Adames, Julian Tavarez, Jhonny Peralta and Jose Reyes.

Path Through the Pros: After signing at age 16, Del Rosario debuted as a reliever in 2018 in the Dominican Summer League before converting to a starter in the DSL in 2019, tossing 5 2/3 innings at most... made United States debut in 2021 in Florida Complex League; twirled five hitless innings in second start, July 5, striking out seven Orioles and walking one... made full-season debut with Bradenton in 2022, posting three six-inning starts in a four-start span in June; allowed .248 avg. to right-handers compared to .299 to lefties; runners stole six bases in 10 attempts; outstanding in the first inning, limiting opposition to .191/.295/.353 splits; far better on the road (2.95 ERA in 55 IP) than at home (4.74 in 38 IP).

Joining the Athletics: Del Rosario was the first overall selection of the 2022 MiLB portion of the Rule 5 Draft... in the Major League portion, the A's had selected 2018 Lugnut Ryan Noda from the Dodgers with the second overall pick; Noda debuted in the Majors on his birthday on March 30th and has already launched his first MLB home run... Del Rosario was one of a staggering 11 Pittsburgh Pirates prospects to be selected in the Rule 5 MiLB portion after two Pirates prospects, Jose Hernandez and Blake Sabol, were taken consecutively (3rd and 4th) in the MLB portion.

A Taste of the Cactus League: Del Rosario appeared in one Spring Training game for the A's, pitching well initially before bowing out having allowed four runs on four hits and three walks in 2 2/3 innings, striking out four, hitting one and tossing a wild pitch.
