LAST GAME

Thursday was a strong first chapter for the Bowie Baysox in 2023, as they walloped the Hartford Yard Goats 8-0 on Opening Day at Dunkin' Park in Hartford. Justin Armbruster and Chayce McDermott combined to hold Hartford to only five hits, while striking out five. Heston Kjerstad was the most pivotal bat for the Baysox on the night, as the first baseman went 2-for-4 with a walk. He opened the scoring for Bowie in the fourth inning with a towering solo home run to center field, and ignited a six-run rally in the sixth inning with a one-out single. Coby Mayo, John Rhodes, Shayne Fontana, and Connor Pavolonyall drove in runs later in the frame.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

Last season, the Yard Goats finished with the second-best record overall in the Northeast Division at 77-60. Despite setting a franchise-record in wins, Hartford missed out on the postseason, finishing just a game behind Somerset in the first half, before ending 10.5 games behind second-half champion Portland. Entering 2023, Hartford's roster is led by three top-10 prospects in the Rockies system, per MLB Pipeline – OF Zac Veen (No. 2 COL, No. 27 overall), C Drew Romo (No. 4 COL, No. 84 overall) and INF Warming Bernabel (No. 7 COL). INF Hunter Goodman is also a potent bat, as his 36 HR across three levels were the third-most in MiLB in 2022, while his 106 RBI were tied for ninth-most.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Hartford sends right-hander Mike Ruff to the mound this evening. Ruff has had, well, a very "rough" go of it so far in Double-A. He made seven starts for the Yard Goats last season and had a 6.75 ERA in 30.2 innings. In total, opponents hit .309 against Ruff at Double-A in 2022. His ERA and opposing average were both second worst on the Yard Goats for pitchers with at least 30 innings. However, Ruff had much more success at Dunkin' Park in 2022, where his ERA was only 4.50 compared to 8.64 on the road. He ended his 2022 campaign with a brief stint on the injured list in early September after getting the initial call-up to Hartford in early August. In total, Ruff had the sixth-most innings and strikeouts across the Rockies' system last season.

HESTON IS BESTON

Heston Kjerstad delivered in his Double-A debut last night for the Baysox, reaching base three times with a pair of hits and RBIs. The former No. 2 overall pick back in 2020 and current top-100 prospect clobbered a solo home run to center field in his second Double-A plate appearance in last night's fourth inning, before adding on an RBI single in the sixth. Homering in his debut was nothing new for Kjerstad, who launched two homers in his Grapefruit League debut just a few months prior in Orioles Spring Training. His 1.219 OPS and four home runs led the Orioles this past spring, leading to a lot of buzz around his name entering the 2023 campaign. Kjerstad also showed off some defensive versatility, making his minor-league debut at first base last night and notching a clean game defensively. Kjerstad is one of three active Baysox to have homered in their first Double-A series, alongside OF Donta Williams and INF Coby Mayo. Williams also homered in his debut at this level, on the first pitch no less, in the final series of last season in Akron.

MEET THE CREW

The Baysox 2023 opening roster is a balanced mix of old and new. Bowie welcomes back seven arms with at least 45 innings in a Baysox uniform (RHP Garrett Stallings, Justin Armbruster, Connor Loerich, Jensen Elliot, Tyler Burch and LHP Antonio Velez, Easton Lucas) in 2022, along with RHP Chayce McDermott and Nolan Hoffman in addition to LHP Cade Povich, who all made significant contributions to Bowie in the second half of last season. The Baysox also roster four position players (INF Coby Mayo, César Prieto and OF Zach Watson, Shayne Fontana) with over 140 plate appearances for the Baysox last season. Highlighting the newcomers is 2020 No. 2 overall pick Heston Kjerstad. The outfielder led the Orioles with four home runs and 34 total bases in Spring Training, along with a 1.219 OPS. In total, six of the Orioles' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline (OF Heston Kjerstad – No. 6 BAL/No. 80 overall, INF Coby Mayo – No. 10 BAL, LHP Cade Povich – No. 13 BAL, INF César Prieto – No. 18 BAL, RHP Chayce McDermott – No. 19 BAL, OF John Rhodes – No. 21 BAL) will begin 2023 with Bowie.

LOCK UP YOUR VALUABLES

The Baysox were not a notable stolen base threat in 2022, sporting the fewest stolen base attempts (99) and second-fewest steals (75). Bowie swiped two bags on Opening Day against Hartford. The Baysox only stole two or more bases in a game 16 times in 2022.

WELL-WORN TRAVELERS

Bowie was forced to get used to heartbreak on the road in 2022. The Baysox were dealt 12 walk-off losses in 2022, tied for the most in MiLB (St. Paul)

COACHING STAFF

Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 41-28 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the helm of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles system. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor league-best 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlantic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (.540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Moore played collegiately at Alabama, before signing with Baltimore as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He currently resides in Sarasota alongside his wife Whitney, and his two daughters, Madilyn and Cameron.

Hitting Coach - Sherman Johnson

Sherman Johnson makes his coaching debut, as he joins the Baysox staff as the hitting coach in 2023. Johnson had a brief stint in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations. Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.

Pitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann

Forrest Herrmann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen IronBirds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Herrmann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts. Prior to joining the Orioles organization, Herrmann spent two seasons as a pitching coach within the Cincinnati Reds organization. Herrmann also served as a pitching strategist in 2019 for the Seattle Mariners organization at their facility in Peoria. Herrmann also worked with current Orioles' left-hander John Means at P3 Premier Pitching Performance center in Missouri. He pitched for three seasons at the University of Evansville prior to his coaching career.

Fundamentals Coach - Tim DeJohn

Tim DeJohn returns to the Baysox in 2023 for a second season as Fundamentals coach. However, DeJohn also received a promotion this season and will also serve as the Minor League Infield Coordinator at all levels. DeJohn has been a part of the Orioles' staff since November 2019.
