Today: It's Page Fence Giants Night, as the Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the second game in a six-game home-and-home series against the Fort Wayne TinCaps, the High-A affiliate of the San Diego Padres. LAFCU Fireworks will follow tonight's game. This is part of a nine-game homestand for the Lugnuts, who are home through Wednesday, July 3. On July 4, the Nuts leave town... but Dark Side of the Diamond, with Echoes of Pink Floyd playing to Wizard of Oz, will take over Jackson Field for a special Independence Day evening at the park.

About the Page Fence Giants: One of the first dominant Black professional baseball teams, the Giants played over two decades before the founding of the Negro National League in 1920. Based in Adrian and sponsored by the Page Woven Wire Fence Company, founded by Black baseball pioneer Bud Fowler, Grant "Home Run" Johnson, former mayor Len Hoch and brothers Howard and Rolla Taylor, and they steamrolled all opposition from 1895-1898 while traveling across the Midwest and Canada in their own private railroad touring car. In their four years in existence, the Giants won over 87 percent of their games, with over 100 victories each season. The Lugnuts' Page Fence Giants uniforms will be auctioned off during and after the game, with all proceeds to benefit the restoration of historic Hamtramck Stadium, built in 1930 and one of five major Negro League ballparks remaining in the United States.

Last Night: Lugnuts 7, TinCaps 1. Luke Mann homered, former TinCap **Euribiel Angeles** went 3-for-4 with an RBI single and a double, and **Jake Garland** (5 IP, 1 R) combined with relievers **Jack Owen** and **Hunter Breault** to lead the Lugnuts to the series-opening win.

LUG•NOTES

Congratulations! Tomorrow's starting pitcher, **Luis Morales**, will represent the Oakland Athletics in the 2024 All-Star Futures Game on July 13 at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas. Morales, the Athletics' No. 1 pitching prospect and No. 2 overall prospect, becomes the fifth active Lugnut in team history to participate in the Futures Game, joining **Denzel Clarke** (2022), **Bo Bichette** and **Vladimir Guerrero Jr.** (2017) and **Ángel Perdomo** (2016). The 21-year-old native of Antilla, Cuba, leads the Lugnuts with 11 starts, striking out 41 while walking only 16 in 38 1/3 innings and allowing a .236 batting average against. He is one of seven current Midwest Leaguers to be part of the Futures Game roster, along with **Ethan Salas** (Fort Wayne), **Ben Kudrna** (Quad Cities), **Noble Meyer** and **Thomas White** (Beloit), **Thayron Liranzo** (Great Lakes) and **Cam Collier** (Dayton).

To the Show: **Leo Jimenez** played two games for the Nuts (at Fort Wayne!) to end 2019; he was 18. Today, five years later, the Toronto Blue Jays called Jimenez up. He will become the 188th Lugnut to reach MLB all-time and the fourth this year, joining **Max Schuemann**, **Brett Harris** and **Brady Basso**. Harris, by the way, was just recalled to the Majors today by the A's.

Team Effort: The Nuts' offense ranks 1st in the Midwest League in total bases (984), triples (32) and OPS (.743), and 2nd in batting average (.255), runs scored (393), base hits (635), doubles (129), RBIs (358) and slugging percentage (.396).

Transactions: The Lugnuts have added two new players to the ballclub in infielder **Sahid Valenzuela** (coming in from Midland to replace promoted outfielder **Henry Bolte**) and relief pitcher **Diego Barrera** (coming up from Stockton to replace IL'ed reliever **Yehizon Sanchez**).

Prospecting: Lansing has four MLB Pipeline Top 30 Athletics prospects: pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 24), southpaw **Will Johnston** (No. 27) and outfielder **Brayan Buelvas** (No. 29).

History: **Jake Garland** (5 innings), **Grant Judkins** (2 2/3 innings) and **Colton Johnson** (1 1/3 innings) tossed the 4th no-hitter in franchise history on June 13, blanking Cedar Rapids, 8-0, the first no-hitter in Lansing since April 21, 2003, a 15-0 rout of Dayton in which **Donnie Hood** hit for the cycle.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2015: The Toronto Blue Jays traded Lugnuts 2B Tim Locastro (.310 in 70 games, leading the MWL with 30 SB and 21 HBPs) and former Lugnuts pitcher Chase De Jong to the Los Angeles Dodgers in exchange for three international signing slots, allowing the Jays to sign 16-year-old Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. The Jays also promoted Sean Reid-Foley, Conner Greene and Richard Ureña to A-Adv. Dunedin, sending 20-year-old Dawel Lugo back to Lansing from Dunedin.

2019: Trailing 3-0 entering the seventh at Great Lakes, the Lugnuts rallied for a 4-3 victory on DJ Neal's two-run ninth-inning double. It's the Nuts' only win all season when trailing after eight innings: 1-59. The game also featured the Lugnuts debut of 18-year-old Eric Pardo, the Jays' No. 4 prospect, who gave up a two-run homer to Jacob Amaya, the third batter he faced, but those were the only runs he allowed in four innings, striking out four.

History: On June 13, relieved Jake Garland beginning in the 6th inning and tossed 2 2/3 hitless innings, walking one and striking out three, as part of the Lugnuts' 8-0 no-hitter of the Cedar Rapids Kernels, the 4th no-hitter in franchise history and the first home no-hitter since 2003.

Family of Athletes: Father, Rob, played college baseball at Central College of Iowa, located in his hometown of Pella, as did both of his brothers, Jordan and Blake; his mother, Shannon, played golf in college.

At Pella High School: 2016 Iowa Gatorade Player of the Year as a senior... Des Moines Register's All-Iowa Baseball Player of the Year as both a junior and a senior, 2015 and 2016... 2015 Perfect Game Underclass High Honorable Mention... as a senior: 10-1, 0.64 ERA, 123 K, batting .421 with six homers and 12 steals... as a junior: 11-1, 0.56 ERA, 74 IP, 112 K, 10 BB, batting .520 with 14 doubles, nine triples, 13 homers, 57 RBIs, 51 runs, 15 steals... in his high school career, won 28 career games and totaled 337 career strikeouts.

Onward to Des Moines: Entered the Big Ten ranked by Baseball America as the No. 8 freshman... two-way player in 2017, hitting .270 in 31 starts as a DH (and three starts as a pitcher hitting for himself)... 2018 Academic All-Big Ten... No. 3 starter in 2019; 2019 Collegiate Baseball Player National Pitcher of the Week (Feb. 18), tossing six no-hit innings with 11 strikeouts; ranked 7th in the Big Ten in ERA (2.72)... No. 2 starter in 2020 before season was halted early due to the pandemic: 2-0, 3.00, 4 GS, 21 IP, 24 K, 5 BB... signed with the Athletics following the shortened five-round draft.

International Stage: With Iowa, took part in the 2017 World University Games in Taipei City, winning a silver medal (fell to Japan in the gold medal contest)... part of the first American team to ever advance to the gold medal game as well as the first American team to ever medal, period... team finished 5-2, losing only to Japan... started five games, four at first base, one at pitcher.

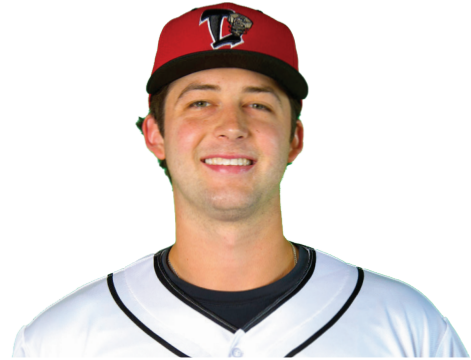
