### Today's Game

The Fightin Phils continue a six-game series at the Chesapeake Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. It is the fourth/fifth-of-12 matchups between the teams this season and fourth and fifth-of-six at Prince George's Stadium in Bowie. Reading went 3-6 against the Baysox in 2024, going 1-2 in Bowie and 2-4 at FirstEnergy Stadium. Chesapeake returns to Reading from Aug. 26-31. Chesapeake leads the season-series 2-1.

### Game 82 Recap

It was another heartbreaking loss for the Fightin Phils on Friday night, as they were walked off for the 10th time this season in a 3-2 defeat to Chesapeake. The Baysox struck first with a run in the bottom of the third inning. But, the R-Phils responded with two runs in the top of the fourth to grab the lead 2-1. Nick Dunn hit his first home run with Reading and two batters later Leandro Pineda clubbed his fifth homer of the season. Chuck King was dominant on the mound, allowing one run on three hits over six innings, with a career-high six strikeouts. Andrew Bechtold followed with a scoreless seventh and eighth innings. Tommy McCollum came in for the ninth and blew his second-straight save, allowing three-straight singles to tie the game at two. With the winning run on third, McCollum struck out three batters in a row to send the game to extra innings. After the R-Phils did not score in the top of the 10th innings, Jack Dallas entered for the bottom of the 10th and allowed a couple hits, including the walk-off to give the Baysox the comeback win.

### More on Friday Night

In the second game of Friday's doubleheader, Reading batted around for the second time this season (first since Apr. 22 at POR) in the fifth, which also tied their season-high in runs in an inning with six (LAST: Apr. 15 vs BNG). Chesapeake committed four errors in game two, which is the most a Reading opponent has committed in a game this season, and three of them came in the six-run fifth inning. The R-Phils pitchers of McGarry, Andrew Walling and Jaydenn Estinista held Chesapeake bats to two hits, which tied a season-best for the Fightin Phils arms on the mound.

### He's Fergalicious

Cade Fergus launched Reading's second grand slam of the season in Thursday night's game two win over Chesapeake. The R-Phils other grand slam in 2025 came from Trent Farquhar on May 10 at Binghamton, which also came in a doubleheader. Fergus' grand slam was the fourth of his pro career (dating back to 2022). Fergus also matched a career-high with four RBI in the game, as he also doubled, a mark that also tied a career-best for runs driven in for a game. Following his grand slam on Thursday night, Fergus is second in the Phillies organization in home runs with 13, trailing Otto Kemp who had 14 with Lehigh-Valley, prior to his big-league call-up in early July.

### It's Miller Time

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Aidan Miller has become a threat on the basepaths this season. Miller is currently tied for first in the Eastern League with 32 stolen bases, a mark that ranks second in the Phillies organization. After his 32nd stolen base on Friday, Miller has stolen the most bases in a season by a R-Phil since Quintin Berry stole 48 in 2009.

### The First for DeMartini

Carson DeMartini launched his first Double-A home run last Sunday at Somerset. He enters play on Saturday riding a Double-A high 16-game on-base streak, dating back to June 20 (.357 OBP). DeMartini's 16-game on-base streak is tied for the second-longest on-base streak by a R-Phil this season, and the longest amongst active Fightin Phils.

### King of the Hill

Chuck King turned in yet another stellar start on Friday night for the Fightin Phils. King matched a season-high with six innings pitched, while allowing just one run on three hits. He also struck out a season, and career-best six batters. King sent the Baysox down 1-2-3 in five-of-six innings on Friday night. Friday marked the fifth quality start for King this season (6+ IP, 3 ER or less) for King this season, all coming in his last nine outings. It also was the ninth-straight outing for King that he surpassed five innings, this comes after not pitching more than 2.0 IP in an appearance in 2024.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

**July 12, 2024:** Phillies No. 3 Prospect Justin Crawford is promoted from High-A Jersey Shore after an impressive season thus far with the BlueClaws. Crawford does not immediately join the Fightin Phils as himself, and No. 2 Prospect Aidan Miller, are both participating in the Futures Game the following day.

### Down by the Bay

Chesapeake enters tonight with a 36-46 overall record and are 5-10 in the second half, which sits in last place in the Southwest Division. The Baysox dropped four-of-six games against Richmond, winning games on Wednesday and Thursday last week. After this week, Chesapeake is at Erie the weekend after the All-Star Break before going to Altoona for six games. Chesapeake's roster features nine of the Orioles' top-30 prospects: Enrique Bradfield Jr. (2), Patrick Reilly (9), Nestor German (10), Creed Williams (11), Trey Gibson (14), Braxton Bragg (15), Juan Nunez (20), Trace Bright (25) and Alex Pham (29).

### Baysox Arm

Righties Trace Bright and Ryan Long start today for the Baysox, Bright (game one) is 1-6, with a 5.50 ERA (32 ER, 52.1 IP) over 13 starts this season and allowed one-earned run over 2.1 IP in a loss last Saturday against Richmond. The 24-year old was a fifth round pick by Baltimore out of Auburn in 2022. Long (game two) is 2-5, with a 4.70 ERA (36 ER, 69.0 IP) over 15 appearances this season. He went six innings in relief last Saturday against Richmond, allowing one run on four hits, with six strikeouts. The 25-year old was a 17th round by the Orioles in the 2021 draft out of Pomona-Pitzer in California.

**LAST START:** 7/5 at SOM: ND, 6.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 0 HR, 2 BB, 6 SO, 96 pitches (53 strikes)... The Fightin Phils lost to Somerset, 4-3, at TD Bank Ballpark. Cabrera turned in perhaps his best start of the season last time out, allowing one run over six innings of work. He set a new season-high with 96 pitches thrown as well. He allowed a run in the bottom of the first inning, then was lock down from there, posting a zero in each of the next five innings he pitched before finishing with a quality start after six-excellent innings. Cabrera was relieved by Jaydenn Estenista in the bottom of the seventh inning.

### 2025 Season:

- Prior to the 2025 season, Cabrera was added to the Phillies 40-man roster (on 11/19/24) to protect him from the Rule-5 Draft; optioned to Reading (AA) on March 8
- Appeared in relief for the Phillies in the Spring Breakout Game (3/14 vs PIT) and tossed two innings following Moises Chace, who started the game
- Opened the season ranked as the Phillies No. 11 Prospect (MLB Pipeline)
- Tabbed as Reading's Opening Day starter Apr. 4 vs Portland (ND, 4.2 IP, 2 H, ER, 4 BB, 3 SO)
- First win of season Apr. 16 vs Binghamton (5.0 IP, 4 H, 1 ER, 2 BB, 7 SO)
- May 8 at BNG: 6.0 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 8 SO; eight strikeouts was season-high
- Walked season (and career-high) five batters twice: May 1 vs HBG and May 20 at POR
- Posted seven strikeouts June 6 at Harrisburg, which was tied for his second-most in a game this season
- Matched season-high with eight strikeouts June 18 vs Hartford, also allowed season-high seven hits and ultimately suffered loss, but surrendered just three runs
- Picked up second win in another quality start June 24 at Richmond (6.0 IP, 6 H, 2 ER, 1 BB, 3 SO)
- Earned second-straight win June 29 vs Richmond, allowing one run over five innings and did not allow a hit through first four innings
- Tossed quality start July 5 at Somerset, allowing one run on four hits over six innings; ultimately took a no-decision as Reading surrendered lead in ninth
- Over last three starts: 2-0, 17.0 IP, 4 ER, 4 BB, 12 SO (2.11 ERA)
- Holding RHH to .172/.271/.239 (.510 OPS) slash line
- Wish RISP, opposing hitters are slashing .159/.240/.239 (.479 OPS)
- Entering play on Saturday, Cabrera is T-6th in the Eastern League in strikeouts (79), T-2nd in IP (84.2) and third in average against (.203); also 8th in ERA (3.61) and 8th in WHIP (1.23)
- Entering play on Saturday, is tied for the second-most walks in the Eastern League (41)
- Since May 25 (eight starts/43.1 IP) has allowed 47th most walks in the league (11)

### 2024 Season:

- Began season with Jersey Shore (A+), where he made 14 starts prior to promotion to Reading (AA) on July 9
- Limited LHH to a .190/.261/.286 (.547 OPS) slash line
- Fanned a career-high 14 batters on July 12 vs Wilmington, which was the second-most strikeouts in BlueClaws history
- Collected first Double-A win on Aug. 23 at Binghamton, in his final start of the season
- Over five April starts, posted a 2.25 ERA (7 ER, 28.0 IP)

- Spent 2023 with Clearwater (A), where he ranked second in the FSL with 3.91 SO/BB ratio

Neunborn turned in a solid effort in a spot start for his Triple-A debut last Sunday with Lehigh Valley. He set a new season-high with 4.1 innings pitched and he was incredibly efficient, throwing strikes on 69% of pitches. He did not allow a run over the first four innings then allowed two base runners in the fifth before being lifted and having both inherited runners to score. Neunborn was relieved Michael Mercado in the bottom of the fifth inning.

### 2025 Season:

- Started season with Reading (AA)
- First two starts this season have come against Harrisburg (June 5 and May 4), third and fourth came against New Hampshire on June 10 and 15
- Has pitched three-plus innings on eight occasions this season
- Set season-high in strikeouts (5) May 18 vs New Hampshire over three innings of work; matched season-high June 15 also vs New Hampshire
- Has gone two innings or more in 15-of-20 appearances this season
- All three wins this season have some in three-plus inning relief outings
- Surrendered a season-high four hits (2.2 IP) May 4 vs Harrisburg
- Season-high four runs and career-high three home runs in 0.2 IP vs Erie on May 31
