HAMMOND'S FOUR-HIT NIGHT PROPELS COLUMBIA TO WIN: The Fireflies used a four-hit game from Josh Hammond and scored the final five runs in a 10-8 win over the Myrtle Beach Pelicans Saturday night at Seagra Park. With the win, the Fireflies have taken four of the first five games of the week. This was Hammond's third four-hit game of the season, which gave him 115 hits on the season. The hits are the second-most in a single-season in Fireflies history. He trails only Ronnie Mauricio, who had 126 hits in the 2019 season for Columbia. Yeri Perez (W, 1-0) closed down the game for the Fireflies. He set aside the first six batters he faced and spun three scoreless innings while allowing a single hit. Perez wrung up four opponents to close out the night and earn his first victory of the season.

STERLING STARTERS: The Fireflies starting rotation has the top ERA in Minor League Baseball this season. The group has recorded a 23-22 record combined with a 3.73 ERA over 460.2 innings through the first 105 games of the season. Fireflies starters have 458 strikeouts and have held opponents to a .240 AVG on the season. The Frederick Keys have the second-best mark in MiLB with a 3.84 through 429.1 innings pitched this season.

LUMINOUS LOMBARDI: Michael Lombardi has been a master of the strikeout this season. Wednesday, he etched eight strikeouts over 4.2 innings of work. Lombardi is second in the Carolina League with 109 strikeouts. That's tied with Jose Butto for the fifth-most strikeouts for a Fireflies pitcher in a single season in franchise history. Tony Dibrell owns the Fireflies single-season strikeout record at 147. Kevin Canelon has the fourth-most strikeouts in a single season in franchise history. He wrung up 119 batters during the 2016 season.

THE GAMBLER: After a slow start to the season, Sean Gamble has turned the page and become one of the top hitters in the Fireflies lineup. Since May 21, Gamble is hitting .277 across 57 games. He leads the team in stolen bases (22) and is second in runs scored (41) and OPS (.831) during the stretch and is third in OBP (.395). He is also one of five Fireflies to notch at least five homers since May 21.

'NO' PROBLEM: In game two of Wednesday's doubleheader, Michael Lombardi and Jhon Reyes combined to throw the Fireflies second no-hitter in franchise history. The first came in the team's third game in their inaugural season April 9, 2016 at Charleston. Thomas McIlrath got the start and Alex Palsha and Johnny Magliozzi worked in relief in the nine frame no-no. Lombardi and Reyes faced three more than the minimum in the seven innings. Lombardi walked a pair and allowed one runner to reach on a strikeout wild pitch. Lombardi threw 4.2 innings with eight strikeouts and Reyes worked 2.1 innings with a pair of strikeouts.

HISTORIC HAMMOND: Josh Hammond has the second-most hits in a season in Fireflies franchise history. The infielder has 115 hits over his first 95 games including 22 doubles, three triples and five homers. The 115 hits trails only Ronnie Mauricio for Columbia. The current New York Mets infielder had 126 hits during the 2019 season.

CLOSING THINGS OUT: The Fireflies have won four of their first five games with the Myrtle Beach Pelicans to climb within one game of second place in the South Division standings. Columbia will see Myrtle Beach one more time in a six-game series to end the 2026 season at Myrtle Beach.

2026: After a tough start in April, where the righty held a 12.10 ERA through eight appearances, Basora has quietly turned into one of Columbia's most consistent relievers. He recorded a 4.22 ERA in 10 appearances in May spanning 10.2 innings and is off to a hot start in June. The reliever is 1-0 with a 3.38 ERA in seven appearances over 10.2 innings in the third month of the season so far.

MiLB: After being signed, he made his debut in 2022 in the Dominican Summer league where he appeared in 13 games, logging 27 innings... Allowed one earned run or less in final seven appearances of standout 2023 season. In final season in DSL, the righty decreased his WHIP to 1.12 from 1.38. Went stateside in 2025 and transitioned to a full-time reliever role. He earned his first save in a 3-1 victory over the ACL Brewers June 4. Basora slung 1.1 scoreless frames in the contest.

He also made seven appearances on the mound that season, striking out nine in five innings pitched... Transferred to LSU for his junior season, where he played shortstop and finished as the Tigers third-leading regular season hitter, batting .310. Braswell made the 2024 SEC All-Tournament First Team. Braswell played as an everyday third baseman during the 2025 season as The Tigers won the College Baseball World Series.

MiLB: Moved stateside in 2025 after a pair of seasons in the DSL and then posted career-bests in ERA, strikeouts, innings pitched, walks and WHIP... The 21-year-old had a 38.7% chase rate on pitches out of the zone last year, which was the third best for a pitcher in the ACL who threw at least 25 innings. The high chase-rate is credited to a plus-slider that he uses as a chase pitch. When Reyes is ahead in the count, opponent his just .105 against him in 2025... His best month of 2025 came in June when the righty worked 12.1 innings without surrendering an earned run. He struck out 15 compared to just three walks and held opponents to a .140 average to compliment a 0.73 WHIP on the run...
