**TODAY'S GAME:** The Curve open a six-game series with the Richmond Flying Squirrels on Tuesday night at PNG Field.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Jase Bowen blasted a two-run homer, and Tres Gonzalez picked up two hits in Altoona's 5-1 win in the series opener against Richmond.

**NO STRESS FOR TRES:** July has been the hottest month of the season for **Tres Gonzalez**. In 16 games during the calendar month, he's batting .327/.407/.346 with 1 2B and 6 RBI. Since July 23 he's put together a season-long six-game hit streak which includes three two-hit games. After recording six multi-hit games in the first three months of the season, Gonzalez has had six multi-hit games in July.

**HE WILL McADOO:** Infielder **Charles McAdoo** reached base safely in 21-of-27 games since joining the Curve with 7 multi-hit games, batting .269/.347/.490/.837 with 6 2B, 1 3B, 5 HR, 11 RBI, 13 BB, and 29 K before he was traded to Toronto in exchange for Utilityman Isiah Kiner-Falefa. He ranked 1st among PIT MiLB in H (103), 2B (21), RBI (63), T-3rd in SB (17), and 2nd in OPS (.947), min. 150 PA's in minor leagues.

**MORE NEW FACES:** With lefty **Luis Peralta** dealt to Colorado in exchange for LHP Jalen Beeks, Altoona received LHP **Cy Nielson** from High-A Greensboro in his place. Peralta allowed just 2 runs in 9.2 IP with 14 strikeouts with the Curve. Nielson, Pittsburgh's 8th round pick in 2022 out of BYU went 2-2 with a 2.39 ERA in 31 games, 1 start, and earned 7 saves. His 50 strikeouts in 37.2 IP led all 'Hoppers relievers this year.

**A TRIP TO FORGET:** Coming out of the All-Star break, Altoona dropped 8-of-9 games on their road trip to Somerset and Erie. Offense has been the main culprit with the team averaging just 2.3 runs per game and batting .167 with runners in scoring position.

**BUBBA'S BURGERS:** **Bubba Chandler** has hit his stride since returning from the injured list on May 29. Chandler has walked just 8 batters in 48.2 IP with 57 strikeouts, recording a 4-4 record with a 2.96 ERA (16 ER / 48.2 IP) with a 0.86 WHIP. Since June 21, he ranks 2nd in the Eastern League in BAA (.253), 2nd in WHIP (0.70), 7th in IP (33.0) and 3rd in strikeouts (40). Chandler has struck out at least 7 batters in 5 of his last 7 outings with the Curve.

**THOMAS' ENGLISH MUFFINS:** Righty **Thomas Harrington** has emerged as one of Double-A's best pitchers in the month of June before his promotion to Triple-A Indianapolis on July 31. He led all Double-A hurlers in ERA (0.70) and strikeouts (32), and allowed just two runs in 25.2 innings in July. Harrington allowed 2 earned runs or fewer in 11-of-13 outings with Altoona this season and his 57 strikeouts since June 1 were T-2nd-most by a Double-A pitcher.

**I WILL TAKE (AT LEAST) TEN PUNCHIES:** The Curve are one of five teams in the affiliated minors and the only Double-A team to have three different pitchers (**Thomas Harrington**, **Bubba Chandler** and **Braxton Ashcraft**) strike out at least 11 batters in a game. The Curve are one of 10 teams in the affiliated minors, one of two at Double-A (Binghamton) to have at least six 10-K games this season. The six 10-strikeout games this season are the most in a single-season in franchise history (35 total in first 24 years of the franchise).

**THE CHEN CHRONICLES:** Righty **Po-Yu Chen** overcame a difficult month of April (7.93 ERA) and hit his stride as of late. Chen has allowed one run or fewer 7 times in his last 11 outings, and since May 25 he has recorded a 2.13 ERA (16 ER / 67.2 IP) with 55 strikeouts.

**THREE OUTS FOR THE PRICE OF ONE PITCH:** For the third time in Altoona's franchise history, first since 2010 by Chase d'Arnaud, the Curve turned a triple play on Wednesday, July 24 at Erie. With runners on first and second after a walk by **Emmanuel Chapman** and an error committed by **Charles McAdoo**, Erie's Julio Rodriguez hit a hard ground ball to third where McAdoo picked it up, touched third base and then threw to second where **Kervin Pichardo** made the quick turn for the triple play.

**A BIG ADDITION:** Utilityman **Yoyner Fajardo** reached base safely in 23 straight games from June 13-July 13, during which he batted .360/.446/.419 with 5 2B, 6 RBI, 13 BB, 10-11 SB. Since June 1, his .295 batting average is 12th in the Eastern League and his .390 on-base percentage ranks 7th in the circuit. Fajardo's on-base streak was the 3rd-longest by an Eastern League player this season.

**THE SQUIRRELS IN FLIGHT:** Dennis Pelfrey returns for his third season as Manager for Richmond. Pelfrey led Richmond to the postseason in 2023, their first appearance since 2014 and enters this season ranked second on the club's all-time Managerial wins list. The Flying Squirrels are a tough light in the prospect department, but OF Wade Meckler (No. 14) is back in the fold. INF Diego Velasquez is also here (No. 22) along with RHP Eric Silva (No. 25) and C Adrian Sugastey (No. 30).

**THE FIRST IN FLIGHT:** Nick Sinacola, fresh off the injured list, takes the ball for Richmond this afternoon. Sinacola made his Double-A debut against Altoona on June 6 and was tagged with the loss, allowing five runs in 4.1 innings pitched with 5 strikeouts. Sinacola hails from Providence, RI and was drafted in the 7th round by the Giants out of the University of Maine where he struck out at least 10 batters in 11-of-12 starts as a Junior (139 total in 79.1 IP). Sinacola was the 4th-highest drafted player out of the University of Maine in their history, behind INF Jeremy Pena (Houston, 3rd round).
