- The Blue Jays rallied for a season-high 14 runs on 15 hits to route Clearwater 14-7 on Tuesday night at BayCare Ballpark.
- Dunedin busted the game open with two five-run innings.
- The Blue Jays five run rally in the third inning came against Threshers starter Luke Russo, who struck out six of the first seven batters of the game.
- Jean Joseph went 3-5 with a 3-run homer and six RBIs a career high for the Jays outfielder.
- Joey Votto collected three hits, two of them doubles, for his first multi-hit game of his MiLB rehab assignment.
- Kendry Rojas started the game for Dunedin, on rehab from A+ Vancouver. The lefty finished four innings and allowed three earned runs
- Cristian Feliz belted a two-run home run in the seventh to cap the second five-run rally, his 11th longball of the season.

TWO TOUCHDOWNS AND TWO EXTRA POINTS

The Blue Jays' 14 runs last night set a new season high, beating their previous high of 11 (last achieved on April 14 at Tampa). The outburst marks the first time since April 14 that the Jays scored more than 10 runs in a contest. The team's eight extra base hits (2 home runs, 6 doubles) were also a season high.

EIGHT OR MORE MEANS WINS GALORE

Including Monday and Tuesday night's wins, the Blue Jays are 16-1 when scoring eight runs or more this season.

CRISTIAN CRUSHES

Cristian Feliz's seventh inning two-run home run left the bat at 116 MPH - the hardest hit ball recorded in the Florida State League this season, surpassing Jordan Viars' 114 MPH home run on June 2nd. Feliz has hit three home runs with an exit velocity of 111 MPH or harder this season. Last night's homer was Feliz's first in 46 at bats.

GOOD JEANS

Jean Joseph's six-RBI performance last night marked the second five-plus RBI game by a D-Jay this season. Joseph joins Victor Arias, who collected eight RBIs on June 14. Joseph's 3-run home run in the third inning was his first in 111 at bats (May 19 vs Jupiter).

NICE TO SEE YOU. NIMMALA

In five games since his return to Dunedin from the FCL Blue Jays, Arjun Nimmala is 7-19 (.368) with four extra base hits. Nimmala was placed on Dunedin's development list on May 14, and then was assigned to the FCL Blue Jays on June 3. Nimmala was the Blue Jays first round draft pick last season, and is the organization's third-ranked prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

FERNANDO IS THE FUTURE

It was announced Tuesday that Blue Jays RHP Fernando Perez would represent Toronto in the All-Star Futures game on Saturday July 13 in Arlington. In 13 starts this season, Perez ranks among the Florida State League leaders in ERA (3.60), Ks (76), innings (70), and WHIP (1.04). Perez is the first active member of the Dunedin roster to be selected since Francisco Rios in 2016.

REHAB CITY, USA

Including today's starter, Ricky Tiedemann, Dunedin has hosted 14 MLB/MiLB rehab players this season. Dunedin has sent a rehab starter to the mound in three of the last four games, including tonight. Other notable rehabs include Joey Votto, Alek Manoah, Damiano Palmegiani (AAA), and Riley Tirotta (AAA).

ROAD COOKING

Dunedin's pitching staff has proved to be more effective on the road than at home. At TD Ballpark, the Jays have posted a 4.30 ERA in 343 innings. On the road, the staff's ERA stands at 3.65 in 328 innings - the third best road ERA in the FSL.

THE MONTH THAT WAS

Dunedin finished June with a 12-13 record. The Blue Jays' pitching staff had its best month of the season thus far, posting a 3.35 ERA (the fourth best in the FSL) after struggling with a 4.70 ERA in May (second worst in the league). At the plate, the Blue Jays' .614 OPS in June was their lowest by month this season. After leading the league with 27 home runs in May, Dunedin only hit 13 in June.

SERIES SUCCESS STYMIED

Last week's four-games to two series loss to Lakeland snapped a streak of six straight sets with at least a split for the D-Jays. The team's last series loss came on the road at Fort Myers, May 7-12.
