TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue a six-game set with a doubleheader against the Akron RubberDucks, Altoona is 7-8 against Akron this season.

LAST TIME OUT: Blake Sabol Lifted a game-winning sacrifice fly to give Altoona their fifth "walk-off" win of the season on Friday night, 2-1. **Jared Triolo**'s RBI 3B after a leadoff walk from Grant Koch tied the game before Sabol's heroics.

WINNING LATE: The Curve picked up their fifth walk-off win of the season on Friday, August 5 when Blake Sabol lifted a sacrifice fly to score Jared Triolo and earn a 2-1 win. It was the second time this season that Altoona has walked off on a sac fly after Connor Scott did so on July 16 and ninth time in franchise history.

STOLEN HEARTS: The Curve have stolen 126 bases on the season, on pace to break the franchise record of 159 (2014) with 40 games to play. Altoona is on track to have 3 players, **Liover Peguero** (21), **Jared Triolo** (20), **Andres Alvarez** (18), with 20 stolen bases for the first time since 2014 when Keon Broxton and Alen Hanson each had 25 and Drew Maggi stole 37 bases.

TROUBLE WITH THE LONG BALL: Altoona pitchers have surrendered 110 home runs across 62 of their 99 games played this season. Altoona allowed a home run in a season-high 8 straight games from July 26 - August 3, falling shy of the franchiśe record is 11 (5/19-29, 2013).

ALVY'S POP: Curve infielder Andres Alvarez has already set a career-high with 17 home runs and 41 RBI and on Tuesday, August 2 picked up his first career multi-homer game with two solo shots. Alvarez ranks T-10th in the EL in HR (17), 9th in SLG% (.490), 7th in OPS (.858) and T-3rd in BB (54). Alvarez recorded the 4th multi-homer game of the season on Tuesday.

A FABULOUS START: Since joining the Curve on July 1, Fabricio Macias has made quite an impact in the middle of Altoona's batting order. Macias had a hit in 15-of-17 games to begin his tenure with Altoona and finished July with 18 RBI; 5th-most in the Eastern League. Macias' .291 batting average in the second half, since June 28, is 2nd on the Curve behind Blake Sabol (.293)

SOME GOOD ARMS: Quinn Priester finished July with a 1.69 ERA in July, the second-lowest among all pitchers in the Eastern League with at least 25.0 IP. His 1.69 ERA ranks 7th among Double-A Pitchers in the calendar month. **Tahnaj Thomas** has tossed 10.0 scoreless innings while recording 13 strikeouts, a 0.70 WHIP and .167 batting average against in 7 outings across July.

A TREE-IDENTIFICATION WALK: After drawing just 19 walks in 42 games across April and May, INF Jared Triolo drew 20 walks in 25 games in June. Over his last 34 games (6/21 - Present), Triolo has a .403 on-base percentage which has raised his season OBP mark from .359 to .371. Triolo reached base safely in 19-of-23 games in July.

NO LEAD IS SAFE: Altoona has held a lead after 5 innings in 46 of 99 games played this season and hold a 33-12 record in those games. Since May 17, the Curve are 22-3 when they hold a lead after 5 innings.

THE RUBBERDUCKIES: Managed by Rouglas Odor, the uncle of Baltimore Orioles infielder Rougned Odor, is back in the rubber city as Manager for a third season after previously coaching in Akron with the Aeros from 2011-2013 and later as the Hitting Coach in 2015-17. His roster features several Guardians top prospects including: RHP Daniel Espino (#1), OF George Valera (#2), RHP Gavin Williams (#4), INF Bryan Rocchio (#5), INF Jose Tena (#9), RHP Tanner Burns (#11), INF Jhonkensy Noel (#13), RHP Tanner Bibee (#29) and LHP Joey Cantillo (#30).

he's struck 13 batters in 9.2 IP. Burns flashed first-round stuff as Gatorade's Alabama high school player of the year in 2017, but he was strongly committed to Auburn and followed 2018 No. 1 overall pick Casey Mize as the Tigers' Friday-night starter in his final two College seasons. The Guardians selected him 36th overall in 2020, the highest pick they've spent on a college arm since taking Drew Pomeranz at No. 5 a decade earlier, and signed him for a below-slot \$1.6 million. They handled him carefully in his successful 2021 pro debut, starting him once a week in High-A and giving him two weeks off when he came down with elbow soress in midsummer. MLB.com ranks him as the No. 11 prospect in Cleveland's system.

Thomas Ponticelli takes the ball in game two as he swings back into Akron's rotation. Ponticelli was Drafted by the Indians in the 12th Round in 2018 out of the University of San Francisco, Ponticelli hails from Newbury Park, California and majored in Business Administration.He earned the Jesse Foppert Fireman of the Year Award as the team's top pitcher as a sophomore in 2017.

## **CAREER NOTES**

2022: Was a non-roster invitee to Pirates Spring Training... Ranked by Baseball America as the No. 22 right-handed pitching prospect in all of minor league baseball entering the season... Suffered an oblique injury at the end of spring training and missed all of April and May before returning for a rehab assignment beginning on Thursday, June 9 with Bradenton vs. Clearwater in which the Marauders threw a combined no-hitter (Priester 3.0 IP, Anthony Solometo 4.0 IP, Jake Sullivan 1.0 IP, Yunior Thaibo 1.0 IP), game was caught by rehabbing Curve C Henry Davis... Bradenton's no-hitter was the first he's ever been part of in his life... Completed his rehab assignment on 6/14 with Greensboro: allowed five runs on six hits in 2.2 innings...EL Ranks in July: 5th in ERA (1.69), 6th in IP (26.2), 9th in WHIP (1.05), 10th in BAA (.216)... His 1.69 ERA in July ranked 8th among Double-A Pitchers...

2021: Entered the season ranked by Baseball America and MLB Pipeline as the fourth-best prospect in the Pirates system...Was also ranked by Baseball America as the No. 58 prospect in all of baseball and the No. 17 right-handed pitching prospect... Was listed as having the "Best Curveball" in the Pirates minor leagues system by Baseball America entering the 2021 campaign... Was a non-roster invitee to Pirates Spring Training where he made two appearances and allowed one earned run in 1.1 innings pitched... Spent the entire season in Greensboro's rotation, went 7-4 with a 3.04 ERA was the second-best mark among Pirates minor leaguers (minimum 90.0 IP) behind Bradenton's Adrian Florencio (2.46)... Picked up his first two wins of the season in back-to-back starts on May 18 and May 25 by throwing 5.0 scoreless innings... Completed 5.0 innings in each of his four starts in the month of July, going 1-0 with a 2.63 ERA (7 ER / 24.0 IP)... Was selected to appear in the Sirius/XM Futures Game at Coors Field, worked 0.2 of an inning and struck out one batter... Finished a career-best 7.0 innings for the second time on August 13 against Winston-Salem, struck out a career-high 10 and did not allow a run... CURVE CUTS: Charles Quinn Priester... Was committed to play collegiately at Texas Christian University before his selection in the 2019 draft... Signed for a bonus of \$3,400,000 by Pirates scout Anthony Wycklendt... Is a 2019 graduate of Cary-Grove (IL) High School, where he posted an 8-2 record and 1.00 ERA as a senior... Was named the 2018-19 Gatorade Illinois Player-of-the-Year... Was a two-sport athlete in high school; also played wide receiver and defensive back on the high school's football team that went 14-0 and won a Class 6A state championship in 2018 where he caught a 3-yard touchdown pass in the championship game against Crete-Monee HS... Played quarterback as an underclassmen before moving to receiver during his senior year of high school... Turned down an offer of a dual scholorship from Northwestern University to play football and baseball for the Wildcats... Was named a 2019 Rawlings Perfect Game pre-season All-American...
