**SALUTE TO SERVICE SUNDAY:** After earning at least a series split with a walk-off victory last night, the FredNats go for the series win today against the Delmarva Shorebirds in the finale of the six-game series. Today's starting pitching matchup is a rematch of Tuesday's series opener with RHP Xander Meckley going for Fredericksburg aiming to bounce back after taking the loss on Tuesday against Evan Yates, who pitched into the fifth inning and allowed just one run on Sunday.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The FredNats overcame three Shorebird home runs and erased a three-run defict in the sixth inning to steal a walk-off win, 8-7 over Delmarva to secure at least a series split with the Shorebirds. Cristhian Vaquero drove in the final three runs of the game with a sac fly in the 6th, a game-tying double in the 8th, and a walk-off hit in the 10th. The FredNat bullpen pitched 5.1 scoreless innings once again, allowing just two hits and striking out six.

**BULLPEN RESURGENCE**: In this week's series with the Shorebirds, the FredNat bullpen has returned to early season form. In 20 innings this week, the group has allowed just five hits and two earned runs with 24 strikeouts. That's an ERA of 0.90 this week, which is the fifthbest in all of MiLB, but Fredericksburg relievers have more innings pitched this week than the four teams ahead of them on the ERA list. In the month of June, the group's ERA is 1.08, which is the fourth-best in all of Minor League Baseball.

THIS GUY IS AMAZING: Cristhian Vaquero made a huge impact in last night's game, driving in the final three FredNat runs in a walk-off victory. Defensively, Vaquero is now tied for the Minor League Baseball lead in outfield assists with seven. Vaquero has four assists as a center fielder since he's taken over that role on daily basis for Fredericksburg, and also has three assists as right fielder.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The FredNats have made several roster moves over the last few days. After two former FredNat outfielders went on the injured list in High-A Wilmington (Brenner Cox and Elijah Nunez), Sam Petersen and Teo Banks were promoted to replace them. Prior to yesterday's game, RHP Brayan Romero was activated off the injured list, and OF Enmanuel Ramirez was promoted to Fredericksburg from the FCL. Romero started game 1 of the 2024 Carolina League Championship Series for the FredNats.

**THAT'S QUALITY:** Yoel Tejeda Jr. turned in the longest and potentially best start of the season for the FredNats Wednesday night, pitching seven innings of one-run ball with no walks and five strikeouts. Tejeda Jr. only needed 77 pitches to get through seven innings, and against the Shorebirds this year, he's pitched 13 innings of two-run ball with 11 strikeouts and no walks. Tejeda has not allowed more than three earned runs in any of his starts this year in his first professional season.

**USE THE FORCE**: Shortstop Luke Dickerson is off to a strong start for the FredNats since his promotion from the FCL three weeks ago. Washington's 6th-best prospect hit his second home run of the season and first at home Wednesday night, and he's hitting .267 with an OPS of .853. The 19-year-old already has 10 extra-base hits in 21 games played for Fredericksburg. Since his call-up on 5/13, Dickerson has the third-most doubles (9) among all Single-A hitters and leads the FredNats in RBI (13).

**DON'T EVEN TRY IT:** The FredNat catching duo of Kevin Bazzell and Nate Rombach has been prolific at throwing out potential base stealers to start the season. Bazzell is throwing out 39% of base runners this year, which is one of the best rates in MiLB among qualified catchers and he ranks second in all of MiLB with 21 caught stealings. Rombach has 17 caught stealings, a top-10 mark in Single-A, and is throwing out 33% of potential base stealers this year.

**2024 CHAMPIONS**: The 2024 Fredericksburg Nationals won the franchise's sixth total Carolina League championship last September, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to capture the crown. It was the franchise's first since moving to Fredericksburg in 2020, and the first since the Potomac Nationals won the Carolina League in 2014.

**NEW SKIPPER IN TOWN:** After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. Prior to joining the Nationals, he coached for over a decade in the Boston organization, managing at all four full-season levels and also spending three seasons (2016-18) as the organization's base running and outfield coordinator. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024.

**ALEXANDER THE GREAT:** Meckley, the Nationals' 12th round pick (350th overall) in the 2024 MLB Draft, was flawless after being called up to Fredericksburg last year. He made five appearances for the FredNats between the regular season and postseason and did not give up a run. In total, he allowed just four hits in 9.1 IP and got a save in his lone opportunity with two shutout innings against LYN on 9/4.

**START IT UP:** Meckley's five appearances for the FredNats last year during his first year at the professional level were all out of the bullpen, making this his first year as a starter in his professional career.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Meckley got the loss on Tuesday in his first of two starts this week. He allowed seven hits in 4.1 IP and four total runs, three of which scored in a fifth inning that he didn't finish.

**VS DELMARVA:** Meckley has had his two highest strikeout totals this season in his two starts against the Shorebirds. He set his career high with seven on Tuesday after he had six against Delmarva in May.

**BACK IN SCHOOL:** Meckley made 21 appearances at Coastal Carolina in 2024 with nine starts for the Chanticleers, posting a 7.52 ERA in 52.2 IP with 57 K's. He previously pitched two seasons at WVU Potomac State (NJCAA)...made 20 appearances (17 starts) and led the Catamounts with 73 K's and a 2.96 ERA in 2023.

### **BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER**

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.

3rd Season | Previously: Pitching Coach, Double-A Harrisburg

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.



#### MIKE HABAS - HITTING COACH

2nd Season | Previously: Hitting Coach, ACL Brewers

Habas, 34, returns to Fredericksburg from the 2024 championship staff for his second season with Washington after leading the FredNat offense to a highly successful season, finishing in the top third of the league in virtually every meaningful offensive category.

Prior to joining the Nationals, he spent spending the previous four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization, most recently as the Hitting Coach for the ACL Brewers in 2022 and 2023. Prior to joining Milwaukee, he was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats. While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.



#### LUIS ORDAZ - DEVELOPMENT COACH

1st Season | Previously: Manager, FCL Nationals

Ordaz, 49, joins the FredNat coaching staff in the Development Coach role after managing the Florida Complex League Nationals in 2024.

He played parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues, appearing in 206 career games with the St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Royals and Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Ordaz has coached in the Washington organization for over a decade, and was the Hitting Coach for the Potomac Nationals for four seasons from 2016-19. He replaces Carmelo Jaime, who will manage the FCL Nationals in 2025 after three seasons in Fredericksburg.
