NOT THROWING AWAY HIS SHOT: The Omaha Storm Chasers fell, 15-4, to the St. Paul Saints in Tuesday's series opener, marking the first time Omaha has lost back-to-back games since May 20 and 21. Saints' third basemen Jose Miranda went 5-for-6 with three home runs, including a grand slam, in his Triple-A debut to lead the Saints 15-run, 18-hit output. It was the second-most runs and tied for the most hits Omaha has allowed in a single game this season. Miranda's three homers in a single game were the most by an opposing player since Mike Freeman on April 30, 2018 in a 10-3 loss at Iowa, and his six RBIs were the most by an opposing player since Ruben Gotay drove in six on June 2, 2011, in a 22-6 loss to New Orleans. The Saints hit seven total home runs in the game, a season high, while the Chasers struck out a season-high 16 times. **INF Gabriel Cancel** hit a solo home run in the seventh inning, his 12th home run of the season, as part of a three-hit game. **C Nick Dini** had his fourth multi-hit game in five games played.

OLIVARES' ODYSSEY: **OF Edward Olivares** was recalled on Wednesday, marking the fourth time in the last month that Olivares has been recalled. He was initially recalled on 5/30, then optioned on 6/3, recalled again on 6/6, optioned again on 6/9, recalled once more on 6/14, and optioned back to Omaha on 6/17 before his latest promotion. Olivares currently leads Triple-A East in average (.366), ranks third in on-base percentage (.433), and fifth in slugging percentage (.597). In seven total games with Kansas City, Olivares has gone 6-for-23 (.292) with three runs scored.

GET IZZY WITH IT: **OF Kyle Isbel** went 2-for-5 on Tuesday in his first game this season batting fifth in the Omaha lineup. Isbel, playing his first season at the Triple-A level, has now reached base safely in a season-best 11 straight games (6/16-pres.), posting a .396 on-base percentage in that span. Isbel also stole his 12th base of the season on Tuesday, a mark that leads the team and is tied for third in the league with five players, including former Storm Chasers **OF Terrance Gore**, who is currently playing for Triple-A Gwinnett (ATL).

MEIBRYS MAGIC: **C Meibry Vilorio** leads the active roster and is sixth in Triple-A East with a .411 on-base percentage. Vilorio is currently in the midst of an 18-game on-base streak (5/29-pres.) after beginning the season with a 14-game on-base streak from 5/4-5/27. Overall, Vilorio has reached base in 32 of the 33 games he's played. The only time he was kept off base this season was on 5/28 vs. IND, when he went 0-for-4. Vilorio also leads the team with 20 walks.

McBROOM GOES THE DYNAMITE: **INF/OF Ryan McBroom** hit his 14th home run of the season on 6/20 vs. LOU, a mark that is second in the league behind Worcester's Jarren Duran (15). McBroom hit two home runs in the series against Louisville from 6/15-6/20 after smashing four home runs—including a three-homer game on 6/13 @ STP—during the series in St. Paul from 6/8-6/13. McBroom did not hit a home run in six games played against Iowa from 6/23-6/27, the first series this season McBroom has failed to hit at least one home run. After hitting .218 (19-for-87) with seven home runs in 14 games in May, McBroom is batting .306 (26-for-85) with seven home runs in 20 games in June.

HISTORIC HOMER PACE: The Storm Chasers lead Triple-A East and all of Minor League Baseball with 94 home runs in 48 games, just under two home runs per game. Omaha is on pace to hit 235 home runs in the 120-game season, which would break the franchise record of 231 set in 1999 (141 games). The 1999 team's 231 home runs in a season was a modern Pacific Coast League record until 2019, when El Paso hit 258 home runs in 140 games. If the 2021 season included all 142 initially-scheduled games, Omaha would be on pace for 284 homers. The Sacramento Solons hit 305 home runs in 1974 while playing home games in a converted football stadium with a left-field fence located 233 feet from home plate. Omaha's 94 homers are also more than 14 teams in Major League Baseball. The Chasers have at least one home run in 40 of 48 games this season, notching a 29-11 record when hitting at least one home run. Omaha has recorded 23 multi-homer games, including three four-homer games, five five-homer games, and one seven-homer game.

FOR OMAHA: **RHP Scott Blewett** makes his eighth start (ninth appearance) this season. He allowed seven runs on eight hits in 5.0 innings on 6/23 (2) @ IOW, including a five-run third inning that featured a three-run home run. Blewett has allowed at least one home run in each of his last three starts and nine home runs in 40.2 innings this season. The right-hander has a 4.56 ERA in five games (25.2 IP) in June after a 7.80 ERA in four starts (15.0 IP) in May. Blewett has made two starts against St. Paul, allowing five runs on 12 hits in 10.2 IP with 14 strikeouts and four walks. He last faced the Saints on 6/11 @ STP, allowing three runs on six hits in 5.2 IP with six strikeouts and one walk.

FOR ST. PAUL: **LHP Andrew Albers** makes his seventh start (eighth appearance) of the season and his fourth against Omaha. Albers, who started against the Chasers on Opening Day and made his most recent start against Omaha on 6/12 vs. OMA, has an 8.78 ERA in 13.1 IP (13 ER) against Omaha, allowing 23 hits (including four home runs) while tallying 13 strikeouts and one walk. Albers' last outing came on 6/24 @ COL, when he recorded his second straight quality start with three runs allowed on six hits in 6.0 innings.
