**Tonight's Game:** The Nashville Sounds and Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp begin a six-game series tonight at First Horizon Park. The two teams have played 12 games in 2022 with Nashville leading the season series 8-4. Right-hander Marcus Walden starts for Nashville against right-hander Jeff Lindgren for Jacksonville.

**Marcus Walden:** 34-year-old Marcus Walden starts for the Sounds tonight on his 34th birthday. The right-hander is 0-3 with a 5.12 ERA (45.2 IP/26 ER) in 13 appearances (7 starts) for Nashville in 2022. He began the season with the Gastonia Honey Hunters of the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. Walden last pitched on September 6 in a road start at Charlotte where he took the loss (5.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 3 BB, 1 K). He threw 43 of his 70 pitches for strikes in the setback. Walden pitched with Triple-A Worcester and Iowa in 2021. He pitched for the Red Sox for three seasons in the bullpen from 2018-20. Walden was signed by Milwaukee on June 22. He was originally drafted by Toronto in the ninth round of the 2007 draft out of Fresno Community College.

**Jeff Lindgren:** 25-year-old Jeff Lindgren starts for the Jumbo Shrimp four days before his 26th birthday. The right-hander is 3-2 with a 5.40 ERA (48.1 IP/29 ER) in 11 starts for Jacksonville this year. He made 12 starts for Pensacola (4-1, 3.15 ERA) from May 8 - July 27. Lindgren last pitched on September 8 in a home start against Iowa and went one inning. He allowed one hit, one walk and had two strikeouts. He started against Nashville on August 21 and was tagged with a loss (4.1 IP, 6 H, 7 R, 5 ER, 3 BB, 5 K). The Illinois State University product was drafted in the 24th round of the 2019 MLB First-Year Player Draft by the Marlins.

**2022 Standings:** The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in 2022: First: 137, Second: 11, Third: 3, Fourth: 2, Fifth: 1, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

**Superlatives:** Sunday night's loss dropped the Sounds to 71-2 when leading after 8 innings...13-10 in series finales...15-4-4 in series play...39-29 in road games...37-9 when hitting 2+ home runs...14-23 when allowing 2+ home runs...59-10 when outpitching the opponent.

**Welcome to Nashville:** The Sounds welcome the Jumbo Shrimp to Nashville for the first time in franchise history. The two teams have played 12 games this year and played six games last year, all in Jacksonville. Nashville is hitting .304 (123-for-404) with an .825 OPS against the Jumbo Shrimp this year.

**Vs. Lindgren:** The following active Sounds have faced Jeff Lindgren throughout their careers: Cam Devanney: 2-for-10, BB; Brice Turang: 4-for-8, HR; Sal Frelick: 1-for-5, 2B, BB, K; Esteyru Ruiz: 1-for-3, 2 K; Jon Singleton: 1-for-3, 2B, 2 BB; Patrick Dorrian: 0-for-1, BB; Brian Navarrete: 0-for-2, K; Pablo Reyes: 1-for-2, K; Joey Wiemer: 0-for-2, K.

**Home Sweet Home:** The Sounds return home to First Horizon Park where they have a 42-24 record. The team will play nine of the final 15 games at home to finish the regular season. The 42 wins at home is the most by any team in the International League, leading both Columbus (41) and Toledo (41).

**Turang's 30:** Infielder Brice Turang swiped his team-high 30th base of the season Saturday night. It's the second time in Turang's career he has notched 30 steals in a single season. He has 30 in 2019 with Single-A Wisconsin (21) and Advanced-A Carolina (9).

**The Long Ball:** Outfielder Esteyru Ruiz has homered in back-to-back games after not hitting any in a 59-game stretch from June 15 - September 4. Ruiz has 15 home runs this year and two with Nashville.

**Frelick On-Base:** Outfielder Sal Frelick has reached base safely in 29 consecutive games, the 2nd-longest active streak in the International League and the longest by a Sound this season. During the streak, Frelick is hitting .348 (39-for-112) with 26 runs, 5 doubles, 2 triples, 10 RBI, 15 walks and 5 stolen bases. Since joining Nashville on August 2, Frelick leads the IL with 48 hits. Frelick's 29-game streak is tied for the 6th-longest streak in the IL this year.

**Among League Leaders:** Shortstop Brice Turang continues to pace among the best hitters in the International League. Amongst all IL hitters, Turang is 2nd in runs (82), 3rd in hits (140), tied for 7th in stolen bases (30), 8th in total bases (199) and 10th in walks (59). Jon Singleton is 1st in walks (106), tied for 5th in home runs (24), tied for 6th in RBI (81), tied for 6th in runs (75), 7th in on-base percentage (.374) and tied for 8th in extra-base hits (47).

**It's in the Pipeline:** MLB Pipeline announced its new Top 100 rankings, complete with three Milwaukee Brewers prospects. OF Jackson Chourio ranks #11, OF Sal Frelick ranks #49 and OF Joey Wiemer ranks #89. The Sounds have six players ranked in the Brewers Top 30, including Frelick (#2), Wiemer (#3), Brice Turang (#4), Esteyru Ruiz (#8), Robert Gasser (#11), Ethan Small (#12) and Cam Robinson (#27).
