SOUNDS WALK OFF WITH 5-4 WIN

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Austin Allen hit a go-ahead two-run homer in the top of the ninth on Tuesday, but Nashville walked off with a 5-4 victory on Jacksonville. The Jumbo Shrimp got on the board in the second with RBI singles from Peyton Burdick and Jake Mangum. The Sounds tied the game on a two-run shot by Brian Navarreto in the fifth inning. In the seventh, Abraham Toro's sacrifice fly put Nashville in front before Allen's twoout, two-run bomb in the ninth regained the advantage for Jacksonville. However, in the bottom of the ninth, Navarreto ripped a two-run base hit to win the series opener for the Sounds.

ODDS & ENDS ON 2023

After five straight losing seasons from 2015-2019, Jacksonville earned consecutive winning campaigns in 2021 and 2022. However, with five games remaining in the 2023 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are sitting at a 69-75 (.479) record, unable to record its third straight winning season. The Jumbo Shrimp also finished the 2023 home slate with a 35-39 (.473) record. The last time Jacksonville suffered a losing home record was in 2018, when they went 27-41 (.397).

'PEN PALS

Over the last month-plus, the Jumbo Shrimp have boasted a dominant bullpen. In the 36 games the club has played since August 8, Jacksonville relievers have combined to surrender only 63 runs, 52 earned, on 112 hits (7.9 H/9) in 127.1 innings for a 3.68 ERA. During this stretch, the Jumbo Shrimp relief corps has combined to strike out 149 batters (10.5 K/9) against 82 walks (5.8 BB/9).

BROKEN BATS

Since beginning a series with Charlotte on August 29, the Jumbo Shrimp offense has been mired in a massive slump. Jacksonville has scored three runs or fewer in 14 of their last 19 games, with the club mustering a meager .208/.302/.300/.602 batting line as a team. Not coincidentally, the Jumbo Shrimp's 56 runs (2.9 per game) rank last in Triple-A during this span. Despite getting outscored 72-56, Jacksonville has posted a 9-10 record during this stretch. Eight of those nine victories have been decided by three runs or fewer. From Opening Day through August 15, 61 of Jacksonville's 114 games (53.5 percent) were decided by three runs or fewer. However, in the 30 games since that point, the Jumbo Shrimp have played 21 affairs (70.0 percent) determined by no more three runs. Over these last 30 games, Jacksonville has posted a 9-12 (.429) record in these narrowly decided affairs. In comparison, through August 15, the Shrimp were 30-31 (.492) in contests decided by three runs or fewer.

ROAD RAGE

In Jacksonville's final five Double-A seasons, the club failed to post a winning record on the road in any campaign from from 2015-19, going a combined 137-210 (.395). However, upon joining the Triple-A level in 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp's road fortunes rapidly improved. In 2021 and 2022, the club posted a combined mark of 81-58 (.583) on the road. However, in 2023, Jacksonville has registered a 34-36 (.486) mark away from 121 Financial Ballpark. Interestingly, while the club has posted nearly identical OPS' at home (.749) vs. on the road (.753) in 2023, the Jumbo Shrimp have pitched much better at home. At 121 Financial Ballpark, Jacksonville has allowed the ninth-fewest runs (365) in the International League with a 4.56 ERA. On the road, the club has ceded the fourth-most runs (428) in the league with a 5.79 ERA.

TROY MEETS WORLD

After struggling in Jacksonville to close the 2022 season, **Troy Johnston** has been scorching hot in his return to the Bold City this year. In 47 games with the Jumbo Shrimp this year, Johnston is 58-for-183 (.317/.388/.519/.907) with 11 doubles, one triple, eight home runs and 32 RBIs. Johnston reached base at least once in each of his first 31 games, an on-base streak that marked the longest by a Jacksonville hitter since at least 2010. Including his time with Double-A Pensacola, Johnston has driven in 115 runs in 130 games this season, which leads MiLB. He is the first Marlins' minor leaguer to post a season with at least 20 homers and 20 steals (Johnston has 26 and 22, respectively) since 2008.

-In the summer of 2015, Smeltzer played collegiate summer baseball for the Hyannis Harbor Hawks of the Cape Cod Baseball League, where he was co-MVP of the league's all-star game, and tossed a nine-inning no-hitter in which he missed a perfect game by a single walk.

-The San Diego Padres selected him in the 33rd round of the 2014 MLB draft, but he chose to enroll at Florida Gulf Coast University to play college baseball for the Florida Gulf Coast Eagles rather than sign with the Padres.

-After one year with the Eagles, Smeltzer transferred to San Jacinto College, so that he would become eligible in the 2016 MLB draft. Smeltzer had a 9-3 record and a 1.18 ERA with 128 strikeouts in 91.2 innings pitched for San Jacinto's baseball team.

-Smeltzer committed to transfering to Texas Tech after his sophomore year, but the Los Angeles Dodgers selected Smeltzer in the fifth round of the 2016 MLB draft. He signed with the Dodgers rather than transferring to Texas Tech, and received a \$500,000 signing bonus.

2023 SEASON

-In game two of a doubleheader on September 1 against Charlotte, Smeltzer tossed a seven-inning no-hitter, scattering only three walks with four strikeouts on 98 pitches (61 strikes). Smeltzer's no-hitter is the first in the Jumbo Shrimp era (2017-present) and first for a Jacksonville (63-66, 31-24) player since August 15, 2010 when Elih Villaneuva tossed a rain-shortened five-inning no-hitter against Carolina. It's the first no-hitter of more than five innings since Chad Billingsley and Jonathan Broxton no-hit Birmingham in the postseason on September 6, 2005, and the first regular season no-hitter of at least six innings since Kevin Mobley no-hit the Tennessee Smokies on August 3, 2000.

2022 SEASON

-The Twins promoted Smeltzer back to the major leagues on May 14, 2022. On October 11, Smeltzer was sent outright to Triple-A and chose to elect free agency and landed in Iacksonville.

2021 SEASON

-On July 17, 2021, Smeltzer was placed on the 60-day injured list with left elbow inflammation. Smeltzer made one appearance for the Twins in 2021 and was outrighted off of the 40-man roster on November 19, 2021.

2020 SEASON

-Smeltxer made Twins Opening Day roster, the first of his career.

-Four of six relief appearances were of 2.0 innings or more. Went 0-0, 4.15 ERA (4.1 IP, 2 ER) in one start and 2-0, 7.71 ERA (11.2 IP, 10 ER) in six relief appearances. Held right-handed batters to a .269 average and left-handed batters to a .385 (5-for-13) average.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Smeltzer attended Bishop Eustace Preparatory School in Pennsauken, N.J. before pitching two seasons at San Jacinto College in Houston, Texas.

-Smeltzer had his picture posted on the school's Wall of Legends.
