NOTES AND NUGGETS

DOUBLE TROUBLE

Today, Omaha plays its second doubleheader of the season ... and the first of two doubleheaders this week.

- Last night's rain out will be made up this Friday, June 6, with first pitch for Game 1 at 5:05pm ... today's doubleheader is making up a postponement from March 30 in Des Moines ... today is a "split" doubleheader with separate admission, while Friday will be a single-admission "transitional" doubleheader.
- Omaha's first doubleheader of 2025 was April 26 at Toledo ... the Mud Hens won both games, 3-1 and 4-1.
- Since 2011, Omaha is 68-68 in doubleheaders ... in the Storm Chasers era (since 2011), Omaha has played 66 doubleheaders, with 38 splits ... the Chasers have swept 15 doubleheaders, but also been swept 15 times.
- Today will mark Omaha's 12th doubleheader vs. Iowa (since 2005) and the Storm Chasers are 7-15 in these games ... most recently, the Chasers and Cubs played 2 on May 1, 2024 in Des Moines, with Iowa taking Game 1 6-5 in 8 innings, while Omaha won Game 2, 5-1 in 7 innings.
- The last "split", or Day/Night doubleheader Omaha played, was July 21, 2018 vs. Round Rock ... to make up a rained out game from May 2018, the Storm Chasers and Express played at 12:05 pm and 7:05 p.m. that day, with Omaha winning the day game and Round Rock winning the night game.

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

While the Storm Chasers do not lead the league in stolen bases, Omaha has one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.

- Omaha has successfully stolen 89 bases this year, and only been caught 12 times ... 89 steals rank 4th in the International League and among Triple-A teams.
- 89-for-101 in steal attempts is a 88.1% success rate, the highest stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and 3rd-best among full-season Minor League teams (1st: New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 90.7%, 39-for-43).

U CAN'T TOUCH THIS

The Omaha Storm Chasers pitching staff sits near the top of the International League in strikeouts, with 542 strikeouts this season ... that is 3rd in the league and 4th at the Triple-A level.

- Over 481.2 innings, Omaha pitchers are averaging 10.13 K/9, which ranks 3rd both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.
- With 542 strikeouts through 55 games, an average of 9.85 strikeouts per game has the staff on pace for 1,468 strikeouts this season ... the franchise record is 1,282 strikeouts by the 2023 Storm Chasers.

ROLLER COASTER RIDE

Omaha has held leads in its last 13 games ... but the Storm Chasers are just 4-9 in this stretch

- In this 13-game stretch, since Sunday, May 18, the Chasers have played 118 innings (against Columbus, Salt Lake and St. Paul) ... Omaha has led for 45 of 118 innings, but only won 4 games: back-to-back wins May 25 at Salt Lake and May 27 vs. St. Paul, plus May 31 and June 1 vs St. Paul
- The Storm Chasers have had a lead for multiple innings in 10 of 13 games, including 23 of the final 27 innings in the series ... Omaha has lost the lead in the 7th inning or later 4 times in of the 9 losses in the last 13 games.

SLOW YOUR ROLL

Omaha's offense has seen success this year against both fastballs and offspeed pitches ... but it's been in different ways.

- Against offspeed pitches, the Storm Chasers have a team OPS of .724, the 2nd-best in the International League and 5th among Triple-A teams, though an average exit velocity of 84.8MPH ranks 23rd of 30 Triple-A clubs ... 10 home runs on offspeed pitches are the 2nd-most of any Triple-A club.
- Facing fastballs, Omaha's OPS is .817, which ranks 21st of the 30 Triple-A teams ... however, an average exit velocity of 90.5MPH ranks tied 1st at the Triple-A level.

LET'S OBSERVE MERV

After a slow start at the plate in his return to Triple-A, outfielder MJ Melendez has been one of Omaha's best hitters over the last few weeks.

- Melendez has hits in 13 of his last 15 games, with a .311 average (19-for-61) with a 1.004 OPS since May 16 ... he has 6 homers and 13 RBI in this stretch, with 4 multi-hit games.
- Since May 16, Melendez is 2nd in the International League in total bases (40) and homers (6) ... he is tied for the most steals (9) in that stretch as well.
- Over his first 19 games, Melendez hit just .156 (12-for-77) with a .468 OPS, between April 22 and May 14 ... he had hits in 10 of 19 games in that stretch, with 1 homer, 6 RBI and just 2 multi-hit games.

TODAY'S START

- Gant is making his **3rd start with Omaha** this season ... in May, the Royals purchased his contract from the independent Atlantic League's Long Island Ducks, where he began the season.
- Playing his 13th professional season this year ... Royals are Gant's 5th MLB organization, has previously spent time with the Mets, Braves, Cardinals and Twins, as well as in Japan and Indy Ball ... has appeared in 173 Major League games from 2016 to 2021, debuting with Atlanta but pitching for St. Louis and Minnesota too.
- Originally drafted by the New York Mets out of high school in 2011, was traded twice over the span of 17 months to the Braves and then Cardinals and has spent more time with the Cardinals than any other franchise.
- Prior to signing with Omaha, Gant pitched in the Minor Leagues on June 15, 2018, making a quality start for the Memphis Redbirds on the road against the Albuquerque Isotopes ... last pitched in the Majors on October 1, 2021 for the Minnesota Twins.

LAST OUTING: TUESDAY, MAY 27 vs. St. PAUL

After not making it out of the 1st inning in his Omaha debut (May 23 @ Salt Lake), started on 3 days' rest and worked into the 5th inning ... allowed a leadoff homer in the 1st to Matt Wallner ... allowed a solo homer in the 2nd to Jefferson Morales ... a walk, 2 doubles and a sac fly scored 2 runs in the 3rd ... pitched a scoreless 4th ... got the first 2 outs of the 5th, but walked a batter and exited with a runner on base, a runner that came around to score.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- Signed with the Long Island Ducks (independent Atlantic League) in March 2025 ... over 4 starts with the Ducks, pitched to a 1.71 ERA (4 ER in 21.0 IP) with 27 strikeouts, to just 5 walks ... last 2 starts were quality starts.
- On May 17, the Long Island Ducks announced his contract has been purchased by the Royals organization ... joined the Storm Chasers this week for the road trip in Salt Lake City.

CAREER NOTES

SINCE 2022

- Was outrighted off of the Twins' 40-man roster following the 2021 season and elected free agency ... signed with the Hokkaido Nippon-Ham Fighters of Nippon Professional Baseball in Japan on December 10, 2021.
- Dealt with injuries and did not pitch with the Fighters in 2022, but re-signed a one-year contract extension in November 2022 ... only made 3 appearances for the farm team in 2023, with 11 strikeouts in 9.2 innings.
- Released by the Japanese team on July 1, 2023 and did not pitch in a professional game again until April 2025 with the Long Island Ducks.

MAJOR LEAGUE CAREER

- After being traded from the Braves to the Mets in the summer of 2015, Made Atlanta's 2016 Opening Day roster, despite never having pitched above Double-A ... threw a scoreless inning in his MLB debut on April 6, 2016 against the Washington Nationals, in the second game of the 2016 season.
- After making his MLB debut in 2016, made just 39 Minor League appearances (36 starts) between 2016 and 2018 ... exclusively pitched in the big leagues from June 2018 through the end of the 2021 season (139 games).
- Led all MLB relief pitchers with 11 wins in 2019 ... was the most wins by a relief pitcher in the National League since Tyler Clippard had 11 for the Nationals in 2010.
- In 2019, was just the 5th pitcher in MLB history with a perfect record and at least 7 wins prior to the All-Star Break, while making all relief appearances.
- A starting pitcher coming up through the Minors, opened the 2019 season in the Cardinals' bullpen and made 81 consecutive relief appearances between 2019 and 2020, before moving back to the rotation to open 2021.
- Has 2 hits in the Major Leagues ... both were home runs and came in a 4-start span, the only pitcher in MLB to hit multiple home runs in the month of August 2018.

- July 24, 2015:** Acquired by the Atlanta Braves with RHP Rob Whalen from the New York Mets in exchange for INF Juan Uribe and INF/OF Kelly Johnson.
- December 1, 2016:** Acquired by the St. Louis Cardinals with RHP Chris Ellis and INF Luke Dykstra from the Atlanta Braves in exchange for LHP Jaime Garcia.
- July 30, 2021:** Acquired by the Minnesota Twins with LHP Evan Sisk from the St. Louis Cardinals in exchange for LHP J.A. Happ ... Sisk has pitched 128 games for Omaha and is currently in the Royals' Major League bullpen.
