Syracuse Mets News and Notes

Pitch Perfect: Since May 10th, the Syracuse Mets pitching staff leads the International League with a 2.90 ERA in seven games: 3-4, 2.90 ERA, 59 IP, 46 H, 25 R, 19 ER, 18 BB, 54 K.

From the beginning of the season to May 8th, the Mets had a league-worst 5.91 ERA and a 10-19 record.

Power Surge: Mark Vientos has four home runs in his last seven games. From the beginning of the season to May 1st, Vientos was hitting .164 (9-for-55) with seven RBIs, a home run, four doubles, a triple, nine walks, 22 strikeouts, and a .288 on-base percentage in 18

Since then, Vientos is hitting .300 (9-for-30), with seven RBIs, four home runs, a double, four walks, 11 strikeouts, and a .382 on-base percentage in seven games.

Additionally, Vientos walked just four times in 15 games from the beginning of the season to April 24th, but in his last 13 games, Vientos has walked nine times.

Newcomers: Gosuke Katoh was claimed by the New York Mets off waivers from the Toronto Blue Jays on May 7th and optioned to Syracuse. The 27-year-old was originally drafted by the Yankees in the second round of the 2013 draft and was in the Yankees organization through the 2019 season. Katoh singed a minor league contract with Toronto this past offseason, had his contract selected by Toronto on April 7th, and made his MLB debut with Toronto this season, going 1-for-7 from the plate with three walks and a strikeout. Tzu-Wei Lin signed a minor league deal with New York during the offseason but is just now joining Syracuse. Lin was born in Taiwan and signed with Boston as an international free agent in June 2012. Lin was with the Red Sox organization through 2020 and played - Record: 25-14 | Today: 1:10 vs. St. Louis parts of four seasons (2017-2020) in the Majors with Boston. Lin played for Syracuse manager Kevin Boles with Pawtucket in 2017 and 2018.

> Turnaround?: In his last seven games, Quinn Brodey is hitting .269 (7-for-26) with three RBIs, a home run, double, triple, three runs, one walk, seven strikeouts, and a .296 on-base percentage.

In his first 16 games, Brodey hit .104 with six RBIs, two home runs, a double, four walks, 16 strikeouts, and a .173 on-base percentage.

Do the Palka: Daniel Palka has been a man possessed at the plate so far this season. The former Chicago White Sox leads the Mets with 23 RBIs, 14 extra-base hits, and nine home runs. Palka is tied for fourth in the International League with his nine homers, tied for 18th with 23 RBIs, is 12th with a .544 slugging percentage, and is 21st with a .886 on-base plus slugging percentage.

Untimely Hitting: The Syracuse Mets are hitting a league-worst .195 with runners in scoring position. This week, Syracuse is 1-for-7 (.143). Last series, Syracuse went 7-for-34 (.206) with runners in scoring position.


