The Fightin Phils begin their final home series, and penultimate series, of the 2024 season against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. It's the only meetings between the teams this season. Reading and Erie did not face off in 2023, and this is the first meeting between them since July 26-31, 2022, at Erie (Erie won series 5-1). It's the first time the SeaWolves come to FirstEnergy Stadium since May 4-9, 2021 (Erie won series 4-2) to open the 2021 season.

R-Phils.

The Fightin Phils fell in the series finale at Somerset 15-5 on Sunday. With the defeat, the Fightin Phils went 2-4 at Somerset last week and finished the season-long 12-game road trip with a 3-9 record. The Fightin Phils broke out with three runs in the top of the first thanks to a two-run single from Josh Breaux and a RBI triple from Otto Kemp. But, the Patriots responded with 15-unanswered runs from the second to eighth innings. The Fightin Phils tacked on two runs in the top of the ninth, thanks to a two-run home run from Ethan Wilson. Eiberson Castellano was roughed up for six runs over just 2.1 innings pitched.

Eastern League Honors for Chace

Moises Chace was nothing short of dominant in his third Double-A start on Saturday, which led to his selection as Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on Monday. After setting a then-career high with 10 strikeouts over 4.2 innings last week at Binghamton, he followed that with a new career-high 13 strikeouts over a career-best six-innings pitched last Saturday. His 13 strikeouts are the most by a Reading pitcher this season, with the previous high being 11, done three times. The last Reading pitcher with exactly 13 strikeouts in a game was Adam Walker on May 10, 2001, at Portland. His 13 strikeouts were also the most in a game by a Fightin Phil sine Spencer Howard had 12 on Sept. 4, 2019, against Trenton. In total, Chace retired 18-of-19 hitters and the final 16 he faced. 13 of his 18 outs were via a strikeout (72%). He collected 19 swing and missed on the night, with 13 of those coming against his fastball. Since his Double-A debut (August 17), Chace leads the Eastern League with 29 strikeouts.

It's Miller Time

The Philadelphia Phillies announced on Tuesday that No. 1 prospect (according to MLB Pipeline) Aidan Miller was promoted to Reading from High-A Jersey Shore. Miller was the Phillies first round draft pick in the 2023 draft. He began the season with Single-A Clearwater and after a strong start with the Threshers, Miller was promoted to Jersey Shore on June 11. Miller had a slower start to his time with Jersey Shore, but turned it up in the month of August. He slahed .299/.370/.536 (.906 OPS) in August. Miller finished his time in Jersey Shore with a five-hit performance on Sunday. Miller joins Crawford as the last two Phillies first round picks prior to 2024 to play for the Fightin Phils. It's the first time the Phillies top prospect has played in Reading sine Andrew Painter in 2022 and the first time consecutive first round picks are suiting up for the R-Phils since Mick Abel (2020) and Andrew Painter (2021) during the 2022 season.

Ethan Wilson launched his ninth home run of the season in Sunday's loss at Somerset. Wilson had three hits last week at Somerset, with all three being home runs. Wilson's home run on Sunday was his second in as many games, as he also went deep on Saturday. It marked the third instance this season that Wilson has homered in back-to-back games (6/27-28, 8/1-2 and 8/31-9/1).

Taylor on a Roll

Carson Taylor turned in another strong week at Somerset. In the series, he slashed .368/.520/.368 (.888 OPS). Taylor turned in two multi-hit games and walked six times in 25 plate appearances. Taylor is tied for second in the Eastern League in walks (62) entering Tuesday's game. First place is Bowie's Dylan Beavers

This Day in Baseballtown History

September 3, 1973: The Phillies clinch the Eastern League regular season title with a 6-2 win over Waterbury as Dane Iorg goes 5-for-5 with two RBIs. The win capped a stretch that saw the Phils rally from last place (5.0 games back on August 12) to win 22 of their final 29 games.

Erie enters tonight with a 32-24 record in the second half, which is second-best in the Southwest division. They went 38-29 in the first half and won the division. The SeaWolves will play Akron in the Southwest division finals in two weeks. Their roster has four players on the Tigers' top-30 prosepcts list, accoding to MLB Pipeline: Jackson Jobe (2), Hao-Yu Lee (8), Troy Melton (12) and Eric Silva (29). Hao-Yu Lee formerly spent 2021-23 in the Phillies organization and was traded to the Tigers last season at the trade deadline for Michael Lorenzon.

On the Mound for Erie

Righty Austin Bergner makes the start tonight for Erie. So far this season, Bergner is 3-1, with a 2.45 ERA over eight starts (40.1 IP, 25 H, 15 BB, 57 SO). He's also made 10 appearances (9.68 ERA) for Triple-A Toledo and three (1.00 ERA) with High-A West Michigan. He last pitched with Toledo on Aug. 28 at Worcester and allowed four runs over three innings, with five strikeouts. Tuesday will be his first start with Erie since June 16 at Altoona. Bergner has one-career start against Reading on July 30, 2022, at home. He allowed one run on three hits over five innings, with seven strikeouts. Bergner split 2023 between Erie and Toledo, going 7-5, with a 5.62 ERA over 37 games (six starts). The Tigers drafted the 27-year old in the ninth round in 2019 out of North Carolina.
