Rivas had two hits and **Matt Lloyd** drove in a pair as the Cardinals defeated the Wichita Wind Surge 5-2 in the series finale on Sunday afternoon at Riverfront Stadium. **Benito Garcia** fired 4.0 innings of one-hit ball for Springfield to earn his 3rd win of the season and **Jack Ralston** pitched a scoreless bottom of the 9th inning for his 3rd save of the season. With the win the Cardinals earned a series split and snapped a two-game losing streak. Springfield has not lost 3 straight games in over two months (June 27-29).

The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

ON PACE ...: With 12 games remaining in the 2024 regular season, the Cardinals are on pace for several team and individual franchise records:

- Springfield is on pace to win 80 games this season, which would eclipse the franchise record of 77 (2012 & 2017).
- The Cardinals set a new franchise record with their 39th road win on Sunday afternoon at Wichita, eclipsing the 38 road wins in 2008.
- The current strikeout pace for the Cardinals pitching staff is 1,280, which » would surpass the 2019 franchise record of 1,263.
- With an average of .328, Bryan Torres is 4 points ahead of the Spring-» field record held by Tyler Minges who hit .324 in 2005
- With 24 saves, Matt Svanson is within 3 of the franchise record of 27 (Mark Worrell, 2006 & Chris Perez, 2007)

LONG, HOT SUMMER: The Cardinals are 34-17 since July 1, the best record in the Texas League during that time and tied for the 2nd-best in Double-A behind with the Akron Rubber Ducks (CLE) the Tennessee Smokies (CHC) who are 35-14. Springfield since the calendar flipped to July is 5-1-3 in series and has the best batting average below Triple-A at .269. The Cardinals have an ERA during that time of 3.76, which is 3rd-best in the Texas League. Through the end of June Springfield sported a 4.75 ERA.

ROAD WARRIORS: For the duration of the 2024 season to this point, the Cardinals have been the best road team in Double-A. Springfield is 38-23 (.623) away from Hammons Field this season, a half-game better than the Binghamton Rumble Ponies (NYM) who are 37-23. The Cards have the best road mark in the Texas League by a wide margin; Frisco is 2nd-best with a record of 35-28 away from Riders Field.

CARDIAC CARDS: Over their last 18 games, the Cardinals have saved their best work for late in games. Despite trailing in the 7th inning or later in 9 out of 18 of those contests, Springfield is 13-5 during that time. The Cards have outscored their opponents 37-12 in the 8th inning or later.

HOLDING 'EM DOWN: The later into the 2024 season, the better numbers the Cardinal pitching staff has put up. Since the beginning of August the Cardinals are 3rd-best in the Texas League with a 3.32 ERA. After registering a 4.67 ERA in teh 1st half of Texas League play, the Cardinal staff has bounced back in a big way to put together a 3.96 ERA in the 2nd half.

FOR STARTERS: Springfield's starters since August 1 have the 2nd-best ERA in the Texas League at 2.62, trailing only Midland (2.24). Over their last 12 games since the series opener against the Drillers on August 19 at Hammons Field the Cardinals' rotation leads the circuit with a 2.26 ERA.

LOOKING FOR THE BIG HIT: Despite going 4-for-11 in the series finale in Wichita on Sunday afternoon, the Cardinals have scuffled with runners in scoring position over their last 7 games. The Cards are 14-for-77 (.182) since last Sunday and have scored just 21 runs (3 runs/game) during that time and have a record of 3-4. Starting C Jimmy Crooks has been unavailable for Springfield during that stretch, placed on the IL on Tuesday, August 27 with a finger injury.

MONTH OF TORRES: Among qualified hitters in the Texas League, nobody had a better month of August than Cardinals INF/OF Bryan Torres. Despite going 0-for-7 in his last two games, Torres is batted .418 in 23 games in the month with 8 2B, a home run and 12 RBI while compiling a .491 OBP and 1.029 OPS. He recorded multiple hits in 11 of his last 16 games and is a scorching-hot .471 (32-for-68) since August 10. The Texas League Player of the Week for August 12-18, Torres leads the league in hitting (.328), OBP (.416), and hits (135).

SLAM THE DOOR: Cardinals closer Matt Svanson has been lights out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. Svanson is a perfect 24-for-24 and his 46 appearances lead all of Double-A while his 24 saves is 2nd in MiLB. So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer has allowed just three earned runs in 25.2 IP (1.05 ERA) and is 14-for-14 in save opportunities. Svanson had a run of 19 apperances without allowing an earned run snapped on Sunday afternoon in Wichita when he allowed 2 ER on 4 H in the 8th inning of Springfield's 5-2 win. The Cardinals are 53-1 when leading after 8 innings this season.
