#### Penultimate Home Series

The Fightin Phils return home for their second-to-last home series of the season against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays. It's the final-of-17 matchups between the teams this season, and last-of-six at FirstEnergy Stadium. Reading won the season-series, and leads 10-6.

#### Series Won

The Fightin Phils clinched the series victory with an 8-1 win on Saturday night over New Hampshire. Reading struck early and often starting with two in the first, three in the fifth and three-mroe runs in the seventh. The night was highlighted by three-straight home runs from Gabriel Rincones Jr., Otto Kemp and Trevor Schwecke in the bottom of the fifth inning. Justin Crawford, Rincones, Schwecke and Cade Fergus all had two hits, while Rincones Jr. drove in two runs. Moises Chace started for Reading an earned the win. He allowed five hits, one walk and struck out six. His lone blemish was on a solo home run from Robert Brooks in the top of the fifth inning, Konnor Ash (2 IP), Cristian Hernandez (1 IP) and Andrew Schultz (1 IP) all did not allow a run in relief.

### Like Jordan, Going Back-to-Back-to-Back

The Fightin Phils hit three-straight home runs in the bottom of the fifth inning in Saturday night's game against the Fisher Cats. Gabriel Rincones Jr. (10) launched a solo shot, then Otto Kemp (10) homered and Trevor Schwecke (5) followed with a blast to left. It was the first time Reading homered in three-straight at bats since June 7, 2016 at Akron. It was done by Jorge Alfaro, Dylan Cozens and Rhys Hoskins. Reading also homered for three times in an inning for the third time this season, with all of those instances coming after the All-Star Break.

#### Red-Hot Schwecke

Trevor Schwecke's red-hot week continued with two hits, two runs, a home run and RBI in Saturday night's game. So far this series, Schwecke is slashing .412/.412/.706, with a 1.118 OPS. He's added three runs, two doubles and seven RBI, while striking out just one time. Schwecke drove in multiple runs in three-straight games (8/14-16), as well. Schwecke was the fifth Fightin Phil to have a streak of three-or-more games with multiple RBI this season. It was the first time this season Schwecke has driven in multiple RBI in consecutive contests.

### Rincones Rolling

Gabriel Rincones Jr.'s pwoer surge continued with his 10th homer run of the season on Saturday night. He is now riding a 10-game on-base strea, dating back to Aug. 7. Over that streak, he's slashing .368/.455/.868, with a 1.323 OPS. Rincones has added 11 runs, four doubles, five home runs and 11 RBI over that stretch. Rincones currently owns 10 home runs and 14 stolen bases over 36 games this season, as he missed three months with an injury. Those numbers over a 138-game season would come out to 38 home runs and 54 stolen bases.

### Moises Mowing Down

Moises Chace turned in an impressive Double-A debut on Saturday night against New Hampshire. He earned the win, matching a season-high with five innings pitched, allowing five hits, one walk and six strikeouts. His lone blemish came on a solo home run in the top of the fifth inning. Chace becomes the second Reading pitcher to win their first Double-A start this season, with the other being Eiberson Castellano on July 21 at Portland.

### Streaks on Streak

Otto Kemp extended his season-best on-base streak to 17 games on Saturday night. Over his streak, dating back to July 27, Kemp is slashing .306/.419/.500, with a .919 OPS. Carson Taylor also extended his season-best on-base streak to 14 games on Friday night. Taylor is slashing .304/.450/.928, with a .928 OPS over his streak, which dates back to July 30.

### The Cats

New Hampshire enters tonight after finishing in last place in the Eastern League's Northeast Division for the first half with a 30-38 record. They are last in the Northeast Division with a 14-27 record in the second half of the season. New Hampshire most recently took two-of-five at home against Erie. Following this week, New Hampshire hosts Hartford. New Hampshire's roster features eight players ranked amongst the Toronto Blue Jays' top-30 prospects: Charles McAdoo (9), Adam Macko (10), Eddinson Paulino (19), Dahian Santos (22), Yohendrick Pinango (23), Dasan Brown (25), RJ Schreck (29) and Josh Rivera (30).

### Cat on the Bump

Righty Devereaux Harrison makes the start tonight for New Hampshire. This season, Harrison is 4-6, with a 5.77 ERA over 21 starts. He last pitched on Tuesday and allowed five runs (four-earned) over five-innings pitched in a no-decision at Reading. He walked one and struck out four, while allowing eight hits. Harrison faced Reading this two other times before this week, allowing three runs over five innings in a win on June 18, and allowing four runs over six innings in a no-decision on July 25. Harrison spent all of 2023 with High-A Vancouver, going 5-5, with a 2.95 ERA over 26 appearances and 16 starts. The 23-year old was drafted by Toronto in the ninth round in 2022 out of Long Beach State.
